FROM THE CROWS NEST

CONTROLLING THE ZONE: The Bradenton Marauders allowed just two hits in a dominant 6-1 victory over the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels last night. Last night's performance marked the 49th time in franchise history that Bradenton has allowed two hits or fewer - last season they did so on three occasions. Through seven innings, Bradenton carried a no-hitter, led by starter Matt Ager and reliever Victor Cabreja. Ager finished his professional debut, tossing three scoreless innings while fanning three hitters. Cabreja earned his first Single-A victory, tossing four scoreless innings with a season-high four strikeouts. Derek Berg launched his first homer of the season, and finished with three hits.

CHANGING THE TIDE: In 2024, the Marauders finished 1-8 versus the Mussels at Hammond Stadium. After dropping their first two games at the venue this year, their losing streak in Fort Myers stretched to nine consecutive games which was snapped after their win on Thursday night. Their two consecutive wins entering Saturday marks their first such streak at Hammond Stadium since 9/9-9/10 in 2023.

STUMBO SATURDAY: Right hander Peyton Stumbo will make his third appearance and second start versus Fort Myers tonight. Last time out, the right hander tossed two innings in relief of minor-league rehabber Connor Wietgrefe on Sunday's series finale versus Palm Beach. His fastball sat between 92-94 miles per hour and his curveball was his strongest secondary offering. The pitch has recorded a 40 percent whiff rate through two outings this season. Stumbo's first start was stellar, as he fanned five over four hitless and scoreless innings.

COMEBACK KIDS: After Thursday night's victory, three of Bradenton's five wins have come while trailing. Despite dropping four of their six games with the Palm Beach Cardinals last week, the Marauders rallied late for two comeback victories. On Wednesday, Bradenton trailed 5-0 through the top of the fourth, but began to chip away, eventually scoring nine runs during their final three trips to the plate en route to a 12-6 win. On Friday night, they entered the bottom of the fifth trailing 4-1. However, timely hitting from **Komor Griffin** led the way to their second comeback win of the week.

TEENAGE TITAN: MLB.com's No. 42 prospect and 2024 first-round pick **Konnor Griffin** has registered elite-level exit velocities early on in his first pro season. Of his first eight hits this year, four have left the bat at 104 mph, 111 mph, 114.2 mph and 104.6 mph respectively. The top mark is the highest recorded by a Single-A player this season and would place 22nd in all of MLB. The only players to hit a ball harder at the big-league level this season include: Riley Greene, Pete Alonso, **Oneil Cruz**, Aaron Judge, Ketel Marte, Ryan Mountcastle, Corbin Carroll, and Kyle Schwarber among others.

ROUND OF A. PLAZ: Pirates No. 28 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Axiel Plaz** is off to a hot start in 2025. Through the first two series of the season, he leads Bradenton in hits hitting (.375 - 3rd in FSL) and with 11 RBI (T-5th in FSL), nine of which came in a three-game stretch last week versus Palm Beach. He enters Wednesday with hits in eight of his ten games played, including six multi-hit contests.

SCOUTING THE MUSSELS: This week, the Marauders face a division mate for the first time this season. The Mighty Mussels enter play tied for third in the FSL West with a record of 4-5 after they split their six-game series with the Tampa Tarpons last week. Their pitching was stellar, limiting Tampa to 18 runs over six games. Their 3.62 team ERA is good for second in the FSL this season. Dameury Pena had a strong series, finishing 6-for-16 with 5 RBI. On the pitching side, Dylan Questad was tremendous last Tuesday, tossing five shutout innings while fanning eight hitters on one hit. Their Opening Day roster featued four ranked prospects in the Twins organization: Dasan Hill (No. 13), Yasser Mercedes (No. 19), Dameury Pena (No. 24), and Michael Carptenter (No. 30).

TOP PROSPECTS & SPRING BREAKOUT: The 2025 roster features seven of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline: Konnor Griffin (No. 2), Zander Mueth [IL] (No. 10), Jhonny Severino (No. 12), Yordany De Los Santos (No. 16), Tony Blanco Jr. [IL] (No. 21), Matt Ager (No. 22) and Axiel Plaz (No.28). All six players played for the Pirates Spring Breakout Team on 3/14 in a 3-5 loss to the Philadelphia Phillies Prospects.

IT ALL BEGINS IN BRADENTON: Seven former Marauders were named to the Pirates Opening Day Roster (excluding rehab assignments), including four in the season's first starting lineup: Oneil Cruz (2019), Adam Frazier (2014), Ke'Bryan Hayes (2017), Jared Jones (IL-2021), Mitch Keller (2016-18), Endy Rodriguez (2021), and Paul Skenes (2023). Thomas Harrington (2023) also made his Major League debut on 4/1 vs Tampa Bay, and INF Tsung-Che Cheng (2022) was called up on 4/7 making them the IO7th and 108th former Marauders to appear in the big leagues.
