LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats pulled ahead late with a 12-3 victory over the Reading Fightin' Phils on Saturday night. Trailing 3-2 entering the seventh, New Hampshire scored three runs with two outs to take the lead. **Miguel Hiraldo** tied the game on an RBI double before **Rainer Nunez** launched his second home run of the game, a go-ahead two-run shot to put New Hampshire ahead 5-3. In the ninth, the Fisher Cats plated home seven runs on three hits to break the game open. **Riley Tirotta** cleared the bases with a stand-up triple to center, only his second triple of the season, to make it 12-3 New Hampshire. It's Tirotta's third three-RBI game at Double-A. **Jeffrey Wehler** drove in a run with a triple in the fourth to collect his first Double-A hit and RBI in his debut. Right-hander **Troy Watson** picked up his second win this week after going 2.1 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit and striking out two.

RUNNING ALL OVER READING: With the win last night, New Hampshire has swept the season series against Reading and has won 16 of 23 total meetings, by far the best results against one team this year. 17 is the most wins New Hampshire has ever had against one team in a season. The Fisher Cats went 17-5 against Hartford in 2018. Since the start of the new schedule in 2021, the Fisher Cats have not won five games in a series on the road. They did win five of six to close the season at home against Harrisburg last year.

STRIKEOUT CENTRAL: New Hampshire pitching has struck out 62 batters in the five games this series. Three of the five starting pitchers this week have struck out double-digit batters. **Chad Dallas** matched **Ricky Tiedemann** with 11 strikeouts on Friday night while **Michael Dominguez** struck out a career-high 10 on Wednesday. On Friday, the Fisher Cats had 15 strikeouts with no walks allowed. The only other time that happened in a game was May 10, 2017 when they had 16 strikeouts and no walks in a 4-3 win at Hartford.

LET IT RAIN: IF **Rainer Nunez** hit a pair of homers last night, a solo shot in the second and a go-ahead two-run shot in the seventh, for his first multi-home run game at Double-A. It's the third multi-home run game of his career and his first since April 17, 2022 with Class-A Dunedin.

RODEN ON A ROLL: OF **Alan Roden** collected a game-high three hits last night, his second straight three-hit game and his fifth 3+ hit game at Double-A. The Blue Jays No. 7 prospect has 12 multi-hit performances in 36 games played, including in nine of his last 15 games. Roden is hitting .336 since joining the team on July 19.

RICKY TO WRAP IT UP: LHP **Ricky Tiedemann** makes his 9th start of the year and his third against Reading. The Blue Jays No. 1 prospect set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts in 3.2 innings on 64 pitches on Tuesday. At one point, the 21-year-old struck out eight batters in a row. It's the second time in his career where he has punched out double digit batters in a game and the second time this season at Double-A where he has recorded every out via a strikeout.

NEWCOMERS TO NEW HAMPSHIRE: OF **Devonte Brown**, RHP **CJ Van Eyk**, IF **Abiezel Ramirez**, and IF **Jeffrey Wehler** are the four newest Fisher Cats to be added onto the roster this week. Brown signed as an undrafted free agent out of NC State in July 2022. Van Eyk is a former top 10 Blue Jays prospect who did not pitch last year while recovering from Tommy John surgery. A former Rays farmhand, Ramirez played only four games with Vancouver before earning promotion to Double-A. Wehler started the year in independent ball with Staten Island before eventually having his contract purchased by the Blue Jays on June 9.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (September 3, 2004) - Gustavo Chacin won another game for the Fisher Cats, improving to 16-2 with a 4-1 win at Hadlock Field. Chacin would finish the season helping New Hampshire win the Eastern League title, and then made his first two career starts for the Blue Jays. He beat the Yankees in his MLB debut.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (74-62) failed to gain ground in the wild card race after falling 8-7 at Colorado. The Jays had a 5-0 lead early and scored twice in the ninth. Santiago Espinal drove in two runs with two hits and Davis Schneider had an RBI triple. The rubber game of the series is this afternoon...Buffalo (66-63) won its sixth straight 7-3 over Indianapolis. Orelvis Martinez homered in the second as the Bisons opened a 4-0 lead. Damiano Palmegiani's Triple-A debut went well. He went 2-for-4 with a double. Wes Parsons had an impressive start, striking out 11 in five scoreless innings. He only gave up one hit. Buffalo remained a game out of first as Durham and Lehigh Valley both won Saturday...Hillsboro beat Vancouver (74-50) last night 6-4. Glenn Santiago drove in two runs, giving him seven in three games since being promoted...Dunedin (60-65) split a doubleheader at Daytona Beach. In the opener, Kendry Rojas and Grayson Thurman combined on a no-hitter in a 1-0 win. Rojas went the first six innings. He walked three and struck out three. Thurman tossed a perfect seventh inning. Daytona won the nightcap 6-4. Manuel Beltre hit his sixth homer.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats will visit the Bowie BaySox for six games beginning Tuesday, September 5. The final home stand of the regular season begins Tuesday, September 12 against the defending Eastern League champions and this season's first-half champions, the Somerset Patriots.

LAST TIME OUT: Struck out 11 in 3.2 IP in his start here in Reading on Tuesday. Allowed a pair of doubles (Ortiz/Wilson) and three runs, although only one was earned.

v. READING– Third start vs. Reading. Was knocked out in the first inning of his first start back with the Fisher Cats 8/11 and struck out 11 in 3.2 in Reading August 29.

2023: Opened 2023 campaign with a nine strikeout performance over three scoreless frames against Portland (4/13). Struck out six at Somerset (4/19) working into the fourth inning for the first time with New Hampshire. Injured 5/4 in start vs. Harrisburg and missed over 2-1/2 months before returning to the Fisher Cats on August 11. Struck out a career-high 11 batters in just 3.2 innings of start at Reading August 29.

2022: Made four starts with the Fisher Cats before the Blue Jays shut him down last August. Did not allow a run in three of the four three-inning starts he made with New Hampshire.....Made eight starts with Advanced-A Vancouver, earning a pair of wins in consecutive starts June 4 and June 10. Given a break after having two of his least successful starts in July...Opened his first pro season with Class A Dunedin, where he made six starts, allowed no more than two runs in each of his six starts. Worked five innings in all six of them.

Obtained: Selected by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2021 draft (Golden West Junior College). Signed for \$644,800.

Personal: Ranked the No. 33 overall prospect by MLB.com (was ranked 28th overall in May rankings). He is the second ranked LHP pitcher in the overall MLB rankings and remains the top overall prospect in the Blue Jays system.
