Tonight: It's a *Copa* night as the Lansing Locos take the field, with a Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. 25th Anniversary Bobblehead for the first 1,000 fans, and LAFCU Fireworks, as the Locos play the fifth game in a six-game series with the Fort Wayne TinCaps, the 11th meeting of 18 between the two clubs this season. The Nuts and Caps split a six-game series at Parkview Field in May, one of the Nuts' eight series splits this season. The Lugnuts will start right-hander **Colin Peluse**, the No. 26 prospect in the organization, opposed by the youngest TinCap, **Carlos Guarate**.

Last Night: **Lugnuts 9, TinCaps 6.** **Lester Madden, Jr.**, slugged a three-run double in a six-run third-inning rally, and **Cobie Vance** made a tremendous defensive play to rob **Jonny Homza** and thwart a seventh-inning Fort Wayne threat, lifting the Nuts to victory in four hours and two minutes in front of 4,205 fans. Neither team's starter escaped the third inning, which took an hour to complete.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Copa Background: Lansing's *Copa* identity as the Locos derives from a translation of "Go Nuts!" to "¡Vamos Locos!" The team's colors are gem blue (or turquoise) and marigold, and the logo is that of the potoo bird. This is the fifth game this year Lansing has played as the Locos, with a 2-2 record thus far.

No Place Like Close to Home: The Lugnuts are in the midst of a period of easy travel. Between June 28 and August 1, the Nuts don't leave the state of Michigan, with their only road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

Transaction: Today the Nuts added 27-year-old pitchers **Dalton Sawyer** and **Norge Ruiz** to the roster, giving Lansing 26 active players. Sawyer returns after an appearance in Double-A Midland while Ruiz is working his way back up the ladder after prior stints in Double-A and Triple-A in the Athletics' organization.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: Before yesterday's game, Lugnuts catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Oakland Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and outfielder **Josh Harrison**. All three are expected to report to High-A Wilmington. Interestingly, Gomes played for the Lugnuts in 2010.

More Trade Talk: In addition to **Yan Gomes**, a number of other former Lansing Lugnuts were also dealt approaching the deadline, namely:
- the St. Louis Cardinals traded **Lane Thomas** to the Washington Nationals for Jon Lester,
- the Chicago Cubs sent **Ryan Tepera** to the White Sox for Bailey Horn,
- the Cubs also traded **Jake Marisnick** to the Padres for Anderson Espinoza (of the visiting Fort Wayne TinCaps, to tie it all together),
- the Seattle Mariners sent **Kendall Graveman** to the Astros in a four-player deal with Rafael Montero for Abraham Toro and Joe Smith,
- and the Detroit Tigers traded **Daniel Norris** to the Brewers for Reese Olson.

Alumni Report: **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who played for the 2017 Lugnuts, is third in the Majors in batting average (.327), second in home runs (33), first in RBIs (83), second in on-base percentage (.424), second in slugging (.654), first in total bases (240), first in OPS (1.078) and first in runs scored (81).

Historical Lugnuts Roster Index: Upon his first appearance, **Norge Ruiz** will become the 849th Lugnuts player all-time and the 45th player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have thus surpassed the total number of players used in 1996 (40), 1997 (42), 1998 (44), 1999 (38), 2000 (42), 2001 (40), 2003 (44), 2004 (42), 2006 (43), 2007 (43), 2008 (43), 2009 (38) and 2013 (41) seasons. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.7% of all Lugnuts have reached the Major Leagues (159 of 849). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least eight of the 45 Lugnuts players this year will eventually reach the Majors.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: It was a top prospect matchup: Ryan Borucki pitched seven innings of eight-hit, one-run ball, walking none and striking out three, needing only 80 pitches. 18-year-old TinCaps right-hander Anderson Espinoza countered with five shutout innings, allowing three hits, two walks and striking out four. Fort Wayne scored two runs in the bottom of the ninth, thanks to a Brad Zunica sac fly and a Tyler Selesky RBI infield single, to walk off the Lugnuts for a second straight day, 3-2.

2019: In 435 pitches, four hours and 26 minutes, and ten innings, the Lugnuts outlasted Lake County, 10-8. The Nuts had blown leads of 3-0, 5-3, and 8-5 at Classic Park. There were five hit batters and eight wild pitches in the game (six wild pitches by Lake County pitchers).

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland Athletics, Miami Marlins and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays. Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 159 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, pitcher Taylor Saucedo '16-'17, pitcher Conner Greene '15 and pitcher Kirby Sneed '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Diaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Goldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Last Outing: July 24 at West Michigan: allowed three runs (one earned) in six innings, walking none while striking out six in the Lugnuts' 5-3 win... gave up solo tallies in the 3rd, 4th and 5th innings... committed throwing error, leading to one of the two unearned runs.

2021 in Lansing:

- May 8 vs. Lake County: Relieved Jeff Criswell (2 IP) and Shohei Tomioka (3 IP)... worked with William Simoneit, a fellow Demon Deacon, to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base in the 6th inning... opened the ninth with two walks and was taken out in favor of Aiden McIntyre, who sewed up the 2-0 win.
- May 15 at Dayton: Relieved Seth Shuman (2 IP)... gave up a Brian Rey HR for only run... exited with 2-1 lead, but Michael Danielak gave up a two-run HR to Bren Spillane in the 8th.
- May 22 at Fort Wayne: Made first start... allowed a Jonny Homza solo HR in the 3rd... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, and Bryce Nightengale allowed all three inherited runners to score.
- May 29 vs. Great Lakes: gave up solo HR to Andy Pages in the 1st... exited after allowing first two batters to reach base in the 6th, one of whom scored against Bryce Nightengale.
- June 5 vs. South Bend: Domination. 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings... allowed only run in the 2nd inning on a Bryce Windham RBI single.
- June 12 at West Michigan: Held Whitecaps scoreless for the first four innings... five hits and five runs in the 5th.
- June 19 vs. Great Lakes: gave up a Deacon Liput two-run HR in the 4th... Lugnuts rallied from 2-0, 4-2, and 5-4 deficits to win 6-5 in 10 innings on Elvis Peralta, Jr.'s walk-off single.
- June 26 at Cedar Rapids: exited with 3-2 lead, in line for the win, but Leudeny Pineda gave up two runs in the 7th... Lugnuts rallied for 5-4 victory in 11 innings.
- July 11 at Great Lakes: served up home runs to the first two Loons batters, James Outman and Justin Yurchak, before blanking the Loons over the next 12 outs, with five strikeouts.
- July 17 vs. Lake County: earned the victory, striking out five batters in five innings while allowing two runs (one earned) - one in the 1st inning and one in the 3rd inning... Lugnuts brought a 7-3 lead to the 9th and held on, 7-6.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 28 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing."

Draft Day: Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of nine Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 3 GS, 1.37 ERA, 26 1/3 IP, 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).

High School: At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team... was also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... in second start, junior year, on the Middletown Cavaliers baseball team, tossed no-hitter with 11 strikeouts at Wilmington Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, and then woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm... the injury led to Tommy John surgery, causing Peluse to miss entire senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.
