**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** 1B **JT Schwartz** singled in the go-ahead run in the bottom of the fifth inning, sending Brooklyn to a 2-1 victory over Wilmington. RHP **Jeffrey Colon** allowed just one run over 4 2/3 innings, while RHP **Sammy Tavarez** and RHP **Daison Acosta** shared the final 4 1/3 innings of scoreless baseball to seal the victory. OF **Alex Ramirez** tallied two more hits and one more double, bringing him to the Mets lead with 130 hits and 28 doubles. Blue Rocks RHP **Michael Cuevas** took the tough-luck loss, yielding two runs over five innings. Brooklyn has won three of five against Wilmington this week.

**A TEAR:** This afternoon marks Brooklyn's final regular season home game in 2022. This afternoon is a Sunday Family Funday and Fan Appreciation Day. This year, the team has hosted a franchise-record 66 regular season home games.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have seven games remaining and two series: one more game vs. Wilmington, and six games at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in second place a half game behind the New York Yankees affiliate the Hudson Valley Renegades.

**STREAK SNAPPED:** INF **Jose Peroza** snapped a streak of 31-consecutive games on base last night, going 0-for-4. The streak falls one game short of the team record of 32-consecutive games on base set by INF **Jake Eigsti** in 2007.

**MENA UNO:** C **Jose Mena** has hits in eight consecutive games with three multi-hit games. The Dominican has hit .325 since the beginning of August. This year, Mena has played in 78 games. Prior to 2022, his sixth season, Mena has never played in more than 34 games. He has had 302 plate appearances this year, crushing his career-high of 115.

**vs. WILMINGTON:** The Washington Nationals affiliate comes back to Coney Island for the final meeting of 2022. The Blue Rocks, from Wilmington, DE are 13-12 against the Cyclones in 2022. Wilmington hosts three of Washington's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: No. 10 OF Jeremy De La Rosa, No. 27 LHP Mitchell Parker, and MLB rehabber No. 29 LHP Evan Lee. The Blue Rocks enter Friday's game 8.5 games behind first place.

**JT JOLTING:** Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B **JT Schwartz** is hitting .359 with a .894 OPS, going 23-64 with six doubles, a home run in 15 games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the ranking.

**PEROZA PRODUCING:** Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .861 over his past 45 games. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 42 of the past 45 contests, hitting .311 with a .400 OBP.

**LUGO LAUNCHING:** Over his past four games, 3B **William Lugo** has a double, two home runs, and eight RBIs, hitting .409 (9-22). Lugo has blasted four home runs with Brooklyn and has a career-high 14 overall after 10 long balls with Low-A St. Lucie.

**MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN:** The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball, having allowed 492 runs in 125 games (3.9 runs/game).

**THAT'S OFFENSIVE!:** The Cyclones have scored just 517 runs in 125 games (4.1 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and tied for ninth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

**SHERVYEN FOR PRESIDENT:** INF **Shervyen Newton** won the South Atlantic League's Offensive Player of the Week Award for his week in New Jersey against the Phillies High-A farm club, going 9-for-23.

**MIKE IS BACK:** Mike Vasil returns to the mound for the first time since June 29. Vasil had been sidelined with an elbow injury.

**TWO REHAB OUTINGS:** Vasil pitched with the FCL Mets and the Low-A St. Lucie Mets on his way back to the High-A mound with Brooklyn today.

**TOP 30:** Vasil ranks as the No. 11 prospect in the Mets organization, according to MLB Pipeline, after his draft selection in 2021. The righty signed for \$181,200 after his 8th-round selection by New York (NL).

**FLORIDA PHENOM:** Vasil dominated his time in St. Lucie, pitching with the Low-A affiliate of the Mets. In eight starts with the Baby Mets, Vasil compiled a slim 1.80 ERA over 35.0 innings. Amongst qualified arms, Vasil departs the Florida State League with the lowest ERA (1.80) and a 2.29 FIP, marking the best metrics in the circuit at the time of his promotion.

**TAMP DOWN:** In his penultimate appearance with the St. Lucie Mets, Vasil struck out 11 Tampa Tarpons hitters over a career-high seven innings on May 17.

**VASIL AT VIRGINIA:** The 6-foot-5 Vasil pitched in the ACC with Virginia, making 34 career appearances and 32 starts. He posted a 4.74 ERA in 161 1/3 innings. In his 2021 season, his junior year on campus, Vasil made 16 starts which tied for second-most in the ACC, ranking fifth in strikeouts looking (33).

**MASSACHUSETTS MIKE:** The righty pitched at the University of Virginia after earning No. 1 overall player in the state of Massachusetts by Perfect Game in 2017. He was a First Team All-State pick by USA Today and the 2017 Massachusetts Player of the Year.
