SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 4-0. Harrisburg took a 1-0 lead in the third on an error. In the sixth, Frankie Tostado hit an RBI single and Trey Lipscomb added an RBI double to extend the lead to 3-0. James Wood brought in a fourth run with a groundout in the eighth. **Nick Zwack** struck out eight over a season-high five relief innings. The Richmond offense was held to three hits.

**TDDAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels opener of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The series marks Richmond's only trip to Akron this year. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 16-21. The RubberDucks return to Richmond for a six-game series from Sept. 5-10.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 15-7 in their last 22 games since June 18 but have dropped five-of-six. They went 14-2 from June 18-July 6, including taking five-of-six in series against Harrisburg and Reading, prior to losing four straight through Friday. In their last 22 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .242 (169-for-698), second-best in the Eastern League, with 24 homers, 30 doubles and have score 105 runs. In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 2.98 ERA, second-best in the league, with 248 strikeouts. Over the last 27 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.79 ERA (30 ER/96.2 IP) and have allowed seven home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.68 ERA is the best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 298.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 425.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.19 ERA, which is tied for third-lowest in Double-A and tied for the fifth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** are 7-3 in their last 10 games since July 3, but dropped the final two games in last weekend's series in Bowie. Akron's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including SS Angel Martinez (No. 7), 2B Juan Brito (No. 11), SS Jose Tena (No. 13), OF Petey Halpin (No. 20), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 23), and LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes Martinez (No. 7), Halpin (No. 12), Brito (No. 13), Burns (No. 17), Tena (No. 18), Nikhazy (No. 25) and Will Dion (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his Double-A debut. He last pitched on July 5 for High-A Eugene against Tri-City and set a career high with seven strikeouts over five innings, allowing one unearned run. He did not allow an earned run over his final two starts for the Emeralds, spanning 10 innings of work. In his last five High-A starts, Bertrand went 3-0 with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP). During his time with the Emeralds from May 9-July 13, Bertrand led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.95) and BAA (196), held the second-best ERA (2.92), was second in wins (5) and ranked fourth in innings pitched (49.1). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five relief appearances. Bertrand pitched three seasons at Furman before spending his final two seasons at Notre Dame. Last year, he was an All-American with the Irish before being selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FUR AKRON: Right-hander Hunter Stanley makes his 14th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he worked 6.1 innings and surrendered two runs in a no-decision while throwing out of the bullpen on July 7. On May 19 at The Diamond, Stanley allowed five runs (four earned) in 4.1 innings with five strikeouts. Stanley was selected in the 11th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by Cleveland out of Southern Miss. He made his professional debut last season with High-A Lake County and made four appearances with a 1.84 ERA before an injury ended his season in May. He made six starts in the Arizona Fall League last year, going 2-2 with a 4.43 ERA. This year, Stanley is ranked 10th in the Eastern League in WHIP (1.31).

MARTY PARTY: Brandon Martorano has reached base six times in his last two games since Friday. On Friday night at Harrisburg, he reached base five times, picking up three hits with a walk and was hit by a pitch. In his last six games since July 3, Martorano is batting .400 (6-or-15) with three walks, one RBI and three runs scored. Martorano missed 39 games on the injured list from April 21. June 8

**BERICOTO BOMBS: Victor Bericoto** hit his second Double-A home run on Friday night, a 428-foot, two-run shot to left-center field. It was his second straight game played with a home run, his first in his previous game on July 8 at The Diamond. Bericoto started the season with High-A Eugene and homered 16 times in 71 games, which was tied for third-most in the Northwest League at the time of his promotion. His 18 total home runs this year are the most among all Giants minor leaguers.

RETURN OF THE MECK: On Friday, Wade Meckler snapped a rare three-game hitless streak, going 2-for-4 with an RBI. He has picked up multiple hits nine times in his 29 Double-A games. He went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by Luis Matos (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 200 PA) in batting average (.395) and is seventh in OBP (.460). He leads the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) in on-base percentage (.438) and BABIP (.407) and is second in batting average (.351).

VAUN GONE WILD: Vaun Brown has picked up 10 RBIs over his last eight games since July 5, including three in last weekend's series at Harrisburg. He hit a two-run homer on Friday night and added a go-ahead double on Saturday. In his last 15 games, Brown is batting .288 (19-for-66) with six homers, five doubles, 19 RBIs, 11 runs scored and one walk. Brown homered in back-to-back games on June 28 and 29 at Reading, totaling six RBIs in the two games. He homered twice last series against the Baysox and added a two-run homer in the series-opener at Harrisburg on Friday night.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base in 21 consecutive games dating back to June 18, which is the longest active streak in the Eastern League and the ninth-longest in the league this season. For that stretch, he is batting .250 (18-for-72) with six doubles, two homers and 11 RBIs, adding 12 walks with a .353 on-base percentage. He has walked in a league-high five consecutive games. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 107 walks, which is tied for the third-most in franchise history with Jarrett Parker (2013-14). His .359 career on-base percentage is third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 700 PA).

**I LOVE LUCI:** In his last 17 games since June 23, **Marco Luciano** is batting .316 (18-for-57) with two homers, five doubles, seven RBIs and 11 runs scored. On June 24, he tied his career high in hits, going 4-for-4. On July 4, he hit his 11th Double-A homer, a solo shot in the eighth inning. In his last 25 games since June 10, Luciano is batting .309 (29-for-94) with six homers, six doubles, 17 RBIs and 18 walks

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Among the Eastern League leaders, Hayden Cantrelle is ninth in on-base percentage (.385) and tied for eighth in walks. Carson Seymour is eighth in walks (3.91) fifth in BAA (.221) and fifth in WHIP (1.22). Mason Black is tied for seventh in strilegalts (83)

WHERE THE RUBBERDUCKS RANK: In the Eastern League, Johnathan Rodriguez is tied for sixth in homers (15), tied for fifth in RBIs (46), ninth in SLG (.488), tied for fourth in hits (84) and fourth in total bases (145). Angel Martinez is 10th in hits (75). Hunter Stanley is 10th in WHIP (1.31).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
