DOUBLE DOWN DAVALILLO: David Davalillo earned his first win Friday af ter another fantastic performance at Fifth Third Park, tossing 5 innings and striking out seven. The right-hander won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for April 15-20 after his dominant performance (5 IP. O H. O R. 9 K1 v. BG.

LATE GAME LEADERS: The Spartanburgers are outscoring opponents 28-13 in the final three innings. 14 runs in the seventh, just two in the eighth, and a whopping 12 in the ninth. On the contrast, opponents have only scored four runs in the ninth.

ICE BUCKET CHALLENGE: Red-hot Anthony Gutierrez got a cold shower after his single clinched the Spartanburgers' first-ever walk-off win. Gutierrez has 11 hits and eight stolen bases over his last 10 games.

GET BLANKED: Tuesday's 1-0 victory over Greenville was Hub City's first-ever shutout win. The Spartanburgers combined for 13 strikeouts between Leandro Lopez and four relievers, and played errorless baseball behind them.

I-85 RIVALRY: Separated by just 33.2 miles, Greenville and Spartanburg are the two closest cities in the Southern League. Teams from the Upstate have faced off since the early 1900s, when the Negro League Greenville Black Spinners would battle the Spartanburg Sluggers at Duncan Park.

2024 v. GVL: The Hickory Crawdads and Greenville Drive played 24 games last season and split them down the middle, 12-12. The Rangers then-High-A affiliate went 7-5 at home against Greenville.

A TRIP TO REMEMBER: The Spartanburgers left their nine-game Northeast roadstand with their first series win in franchise history. Throughout the trip, numerous "firsts" were recorded: first win (Victor Simeon), first run (Arturo Disla), first save (Seth Clark), first double (Malcolm Moore) and first ejection (Quincy Scott).

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-Asaffiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jay Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
