YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped the series opener to the Akron RubberDucks, 5-1. Akron opened a 2-0 lead in the first inning with a two-out, two-run single by Jonathan Englemann. George Valera extended the RubberDucks' lead to 4-0 with a two-out, two-run double in the second. Englemann hit a solo homer to lead off the eighth inning that opened Akron's lead to 5-0. Richmond broke the shutout with a solo home run by **Diego Rincones** in the bottom of the eighth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Richmond has gone 27-33 against Southwest Division opponents this season, including a 14-17 mark at The Diamond. This series is the final homestand of the year for the Flying Squirrels and the only trip to Richmond for the RubberDucks. The RubberDucks won five of six games in Akron against the Flying Squirrels in the only other series between the two teams this year from July 20-25. Today marks the latest into the calendar the Flying Squirrels have ever played a regular-season game.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 14-20 since July 21 but have won eight of the last 11 games since August 18. They are in fourth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 13.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.94 ERA for the season.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won six of the last seven games. They won the first five games of last week's series against Altoona before dropping Sunday's finale. The Akron offense is ranked third in the league with a .255 team batting average. The pitching staff is second with a 3.53 team ERA. Akron's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including INF Tyler Freeman (No. 1 - on IL), OF George Valera (No. 2), C Bo Naylor (No. 6), INF Brayan Rocchio (No. 7), LHP Logan Allen (No. 10), RHP Peyton Battenfield (No. 17), RHP Ethan Hankins (No. 21 - on IL), RHP Carlos Vargas (No. 27 - on IL) and OF Will Brennan (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Akeel Morris** makes his eighth start at Double-A this season. Tonight marks his fifth start since returning to the Richmond roster from Triple-A. He last pitched on August 25 at Altoona and tossed seven scoreless innings, combining with **Joey Marciano** for a shutout against the Curve. In his four starts since returning to Double-A, Morris has gone 4-0 with a 0.72 ERA (2 ER/25.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts and five walks. He has pitched six innings in three of those starts before going seven frames in his most recent start. He made his previous five appearances, including four starts, for Triple-A Sacramento, going 1-3 with a 10.23 ERA. Morris was assigned back to Richmond on August 1. He signed with the San Francisco Giants on June 19 from the independent Long Island Ducks, where he made two starts and combined for 11.0 scoreless innings of work. Morris, a native of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, was drafted by the New York Mets in the 10th round in 2010 and reached the big leagues with them for the first time in 2015. He has also appeared in the majors with the Atlanta Braves and the Los Angeles Angels. After reaching free agency following the 2018 season, Morris signed with the High Point Rockers of the independent Atlantic League to begin the 2019 season, where he pitched as a reliever. He was traded to the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs and then swapped again before making an appearance to the New Britain Bees, where he finished the year going 7-4 with a 4.94 ERA in 16 outings (13 starts). **For more on Morris, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Peyton Battenfield makes his sixth start since joining the Cleveland organization. He last pitched last Thursday and worked six scoreless innings in a combined shutout against the Curve, picking up six strikeouts. Battenfield was selected in the ninth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros out of Oklahoma State. He was traded to the Tampa Bay Rays on January 9, 2020 along with OF Cal Stevenson for RHP Austin Pruitt. He began this season with the High-A Bowling Green Hot Rods, going 2-0 with a 1.45 ERA in seven games. Battenfield was promoted to Double-A Montgomery on June 15 and went 3-0 with a 2.76 ERA in seven outings for the Biscuits. On July 30, Battenfield was traded by the Rays to the Indians for OF Jordan Luplow and RHP DJ Johnson. He has held opponents to one run or less in four of his five starts with Akron.

BIG FLIES IN BUNCHES: The Flying Squirrels have hit 31 homers in the last 17 games since August 10. In that stretch, **David Villar** has seven homers, **Diego Rincones** has six home runs, **Sandro Fabian** has four, **Brandon Martorano**, **Andres Angulo**, **Will Wilson** and **Heath Quinn** have two and **Vince Fernandez**, **Jacob Heyward**, **Shane Matheny**, **Mitchell Tolman**, **Frankie Tostado** and **Simon Whiteman** each have one. All but two active Richmond position players have homered in that span.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank seventh in the Double-A Northeast with 114 home runs. On August 24, **Andres Angulo** hit the team's 110th home run of the season, breaking the previous franchise record of 109 from 2013. This year, the team has combined for a .400 slugging percentage, which is seventh in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history (Ahead of a .382 mark from 2013). The Flying Squirrels have hit 54 homers in home games at The Diamond this year, the most in franchise history.

LEAVING THE YARD: The 2021 Flying Squirrels have six players who have reached double-digits in home runs this season, including **David Villar** (18), **Vince Fernandez** (14), **Sandro Fabian** (13), **Frankie Tostado** (11), **Heliot Ramos** (10) and **Diego Rincones** (10). Six players with 10 or more homers is a new franchise record, surpassing the 2013 season, which included **Jarret Parker** (18 - tied for most in a season in team history), **Adam Duvall** (17), **Javier Herrera** (16), **Andrew Susac** (12) and **Mark Miniccozzi** (10).

BACK IN THE SWING OF THINGS: On August 12 at Bowie, Villar snapped a season-high stretch of 25 games without a homer. In his last 16 games since August 12, **David Villar** is batting .393 (22-for-56) with seven homers, seven doubles and 17 RBIs. He leads the team with 18 home runs this season, which is also tied for the most in a season in franchise history (**Jarrett Parker** in 2013 and **Mario Lissou** in 2014).

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over the last 18 games since August 10, **Sandro Fabian** is hitting .304 (21-for-69) with four homers and 20 RBIs. He has 13 home runs this year, which is a new career high. Fabian has picked up 16 RBIs over the last 14 games since August 14, with multiple RBIs in five of those contests.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Over his last 35 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .323 (41-for-127) with 10 homers, seven doubles, one triple and 27 RBIs. Over his last 24 games since August 3, Rincones is batting .348 (32-for-92) with six homers, six doubles and 16 RBIs. He has 11 multi-hit performances in his last 24 games played. He added a walk-off single on August 20 to cap a three-run bottom of the ninth for the Flying Squirrels in a 7-6 win over the SeaWolves.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 29 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 109 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **David Villar** is ranked tied for seventh with 18 homers, seventh with a .373 OBP, eighth with a .499 SLG, seventh with an .872 OPS, tied for seventh with 95 hits, tied for eighth with 24 doubles, tied for 10th with 24 walks, tied for fifth with 42 extra-base hits, fifth with 173 total bases and seventh with 62 runs scored. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for ninth with 16 stolen bases. **Trenton Toplikar** is eighth with a 5.10 ERA and 10th with 84.2 IP. **Joey Marciano** (34/T-4th), **Patrick Ruotolo** (34/T-4th), **Frank Rubio** (33/T-7th) and **Matt Seelinger** (33/T-7th) are in the top-10 in the league in games pitched. **Patrick Ruotolo** is fifth with nine saves and **R.J. Dabovich** is tied for 10th with six saves.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Diego Rincones** (23) and **R.J. Dabovich** (30). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system and Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Wilson (15) is also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
