LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox dropped a 7-6 decision to the Altoona Curve on Thursday night. Bowie found themselves in a 6-0 hole after three innings, before RBI singles from Samuel Basallo and Frederick Bencosme cut it to 6-2. Zach Peek steadied the ship from there, as the right-handed reliever tossed four innings of one-run ball, allowing the Baysox to inch closer with an Anthony Servideo solo home run in the seventh and two more runs across in the eighth to make it 7-5. Jud Fabian matched a career-high with four hits on the night, including a double in the ninth, scoring on a single from Billy Cook, but Bowie would get no closer, as the Baysox two-game winning run came to a close.

SEASONING FROM BEYOND THE WALL

The Curve sport a well-seasoned roster to open 2024, with 20 players who share previous Double-A experience with Altoona. The Curve are 4-4 to open the series after taking three of five from their opening home series against Harrisburg last week. Altoona's roster includes seven of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (two Top 100), per MLB Pipeline - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4/No. 75), RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 5/No. 85), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 6), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 7), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 9), OF/1B Jase Bowen (No. 20), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Sean Sullivan is set to get the ball tonight for Altoona. The Curve right-hander returns for his second season with Altoona in 2024, after spending all of 2023 with the Curve. Sullivan is coming off an outing that saw him allow three runs in four innings against Harrisburg on Saturday. The 2021 8th round selection of the Pirates posted a 3.88 ERA in 21 starts last season (113.2 IP) in the Eastern League. He played collegiately at Cal, and features a fastball, curveball, slider, and changeup.

TERRY TATERS

OF/1B **TT Bowens** has homered in three consecutive games after a two-run shot in the second inning yesterday to open the scoring. Bowens is tied for the league lead in RBI (14) and is tied for third in the league in homers. The 25-year-old is also tied with Dylan Beavers for the longest on-base streak on the team at 9 consecutive games, which is tied for third-longest in the league.

BRINGING THE POP

Baysox hitters sit with the second-most extra-base hits in the Eastern League (41) through 12 games this season. Only Somerset (44) has more. The Baysox have the second-most doubles (24) and home runs (12), while recording the most triples (5) in the league thus far. This week, Bowie has posted the highest team average (.320) and home run total (7) across the Double-A level.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is off to a solid start in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect extended his on-base streak to ten consecutive games, which is tied for third-longest in the league. Beavers won Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month in August 2023 for his debut month at the Double-A level, after hitting .337 with a .443 OBP. The outfielder's .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Samuel Basallo** hit his first Double-A homer on Tuesday with a line drive shot in the seventh to put Bowie ahead for good. The 19-year old is coming off a monster season in 2023 where he finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

READY, FREDDY

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has enjoyed his start to life in Double-A. Bencosme has hits in nine of his first 11 Double-A contests, including six multi-hit contests. During his current six-game hitting streak, Bencosme is hitting .500 (12-for-24) with 5 RBI, 4 extra-base hits, and 5 multi-hit games. Still just 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.
