- The Sky Carp snapped an eight game losing streak with a 6-3 victory over Peoria on Tuesday night at Dozer Park.
- Peoria jumped to an early 3-0 lead as they belted two first inning homers against Jared Poland; a leadoff shot from RJ Yeager and a 2-run homer from Chris Rotondo.
- Following the long first, Poland settled in and did not allow another run in his 5.2 inning outing.
- Beloit knotted the game at three with a 3-spot in the fourth. Ynmnanol Marinez belted a 2-run homer Beloit's first home run in 15 games - to make it 3-2. Cam Barstad tied the game with an RBI single.
- The Carp took the lead with another 3-spot in the sixth, as Barstad came through with the go-ahead RBI knock, and Osiris Johnson added cushion with a 2-RBI single.
- Beloit's bullpen was excellent, as Zach King, Edgar Sanchez and Briedy Encarnacion combined for 3.1 scoreless innings with just one hit.

BACK IN THE W COLUMN

The Sky Carp ended their second-longest losing streak of the season last night at eight games. The victory also halts a stretch of 12 losses in 13 games. Beloit's longest losing streak of the year came when the team lost 11 in a row from May 23 to June 3.

RUNS ON THE BOARD

With six runs last night, the Sky Carp ended a streak of nine straight games scoring three or fewer runs. Beloit's 11 hits are also the most Beloit has tallied in nine contests.

HAPPY TO HOMER

Ynmanol Marinez ended a stretch of 15 games without a Sky Carp homer with his 4th inning, 2-run shot last night. The streak was Beloit's longest this season without a home run. Beloit's last homer came off the bat of Jake Thompson on August 18 at Quad Cities.

FIRST IMPRESSIONS

Marlins' 2023 20th rounder Ryan Ignoffo has made a strong first impression in Beloit, tallying a multi-hit game in two of his first three High-A contests. Ignoffo is one of just three Sky Carp to collect at least one hit in each of his first three games with the team this season [Jorge Caballero, Tanner Allen]. Ignoffo assumes Jake Thompson's roster spot, as the slugger was promoted to AA-Pensacola.

IT'S NOT HOW YOU START....

Beloit starter Jared Poland turned his start around after allowing three runs on two homers in the first inning. Following the first, Peoria tallied just two more base runners against Poland in his final 4.2 innings - two singles and one walk.

IT'S NOT MEANT TO BE WHEN THE CARP SCORE THREE (OR FEWER)

Beloit is 4-55 when scoring three runs or fewer this season. On the other hand, when Beloit tallies six or more runs, as they did last night, their record is 31-4.

SEARCHING FOR SERIES SUCCESS

Beloit has gone nine consecutive sets without a series win [5 losses, 4 splits]. Beloit's last series win came when it took five of six from South Bend June 28 through July 3.

OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

The Sky Carp offense has sputtered down the stretch, averaging 3.4 runs and 7.2 hits per game in their last 28 contests. The team has been shutout five times in that span. In the first 36 games of the second half, Beloit averaged 5.3 runs per game and 9.3 hits and suffered one shutout loss.

LANGUISHING WITH THE BASES LOADED

Across Beloit's last 14 games, the team has gone 0-18 with 10 strikeouts in bases loaded situations.


