THREE-RUN SIXTH LIFTS CARDINALS OVER HOOKS: A three-run bottom of the 6th inning was enough for the Cardinals as Springfield rode a quality start from **Alex Cornwell** and just enough offense to a 4-2 win over the Corpus Christi Hooks on Friday night at Hammons Field. **Cornwell** struck out a season-high 9 batters while allowing just 2 ER on 3 H over 6.0 IP. **Matt Lloyd** hit a solo homer for the Cards in the first inning, and **Dakota Harris** drove in the eventual winning run with a safety squeeze in the 6th. **Noah Mendlinger** added an RBI single with 2 outs to give Springfield a 2-run cushion. **Andrew Marrero** struck out the side in the 7th for his 3rd save of the season.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Miguel Ullola** makes his 17th start (19th appearance) of the season for the Hooks...Last pitched on Sunday, July 21 against Midland at Whataburger Field and took the loss allowing 4 ER on 8 H with a walk and 5 K over 5.0 IP...In his previous start the right-hander held Tulsa hitless through 5.1 IP with 4 K at ONEOK Field on July 13 before the All-Star Break...Faced the Cardinals on June 21 in Corpus Christi and allowed 3 ER on 4 H with 7 K over 4.0 IP and did not factor in the decision...For the season has racked up 110 K with 51 BB in 86.1 IP...Opponents are hitting .170 against him...Spent all of last season with High-A Asheville going 3-9 with a 5.86 ERA in 25 appearances (13 starts)...Made 7 appearances with the Mesa Solar Sox of the Arizona Fall League after the season going 0-1 with a 14.04 ERA, walking 11 and striking out 6 in 8.1 IP...First full season came in 2022 with Low-A Fayetteville where he put together a 2-2 record with a 3.25 ERA in 22 appearances (11 starts)...Best fastball in the Astros system according to *Baseball America*...Signed by the Astros in 2021 out of the Dominican Republic for just \$75,000...22 years old

CARDS HOST HOOKS IN FINAL REGULAR-SEASON MATCHUP: The Cardinals return to Hammons Field for a six-game series and their final regular season matchup with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). Springfield won four of six against the Hooks at Whataburger Field in June, including a postseason-clinching win in the series finale on the final day of the first half on June 23.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

HOME SWEET HOME: After struggling for a stretch and even after Wednesday night's loss, the Cardinals have turned things around at Hammons Field of late. Springfield is 11-3 over its last 14 games at home, lifting its home record back to .500 at 24-24. The recent home hot stretch follows a down period over which the Birds dropped 11 of 12 had saw their home record drop to 14-22, at that point the worst home record in the Texas League.

Away from home, the Birds are 28-16 (.636) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.53.

POWER SURGE: While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in home runs this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles of late. Over its last 20 games since June 30 Springfield has clubbed 23 homers, tied for 2nd with Corpus Christi for in the circuit during that time behind only Midland (28). The Cardinals sport a SLG of .449 and .802 OPS during that time and have homered in 12 of their last 14 games. For the season the Cardinals are 8th in the Texas League with 64 homers.

EDMAN RETURNS TO HAMMONS FIELD: Rehabbing wrist and ankle injuries, Cardinals utilityman Tommy Edman returns to the Ozarks for his 2nd rehab stint with Springfield. Edman played in 4 games against Wichita going into the All-Star Break and went 4-for-14. The Stanford product has not played in the big leagues yet this season after offseason wrist surgery. The 2021 gold-glover at 2B signed a 2-year, \$16.5 million deal in January.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 20 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 2nd in the league among qualified hitters with a .338 average while adding 5 HR and 16 RBIs with 3 doubles and a triple. **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging .608 and has a 1.003 OPS. Among active, qualified Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks'** .858 OPS and .401 OBP tops in the circuit.

ANTICO HITS CAREER MILESTONE: With his stolen base in the 3rd inning on Friday night, Cardinals OF **Mike Antico** reached 150 for his career. With the franchise record for stolen bases in hand, **Antico's** next stolen base will give him 100 for his Springfield career. With his 2-run shot on Tuesday is just 3 homers shy of 50 career bombs. Over his last 10 games, **Antico** is batting .351 with 2 HR, 7 RBIs and is 3-for-3 in SB.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, **Chandler Redmond** etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the all-time franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander **John Stankowicz**. For good measure, **Redmond** added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, **Redmond** has continued swinging a hot bat. During a current 7-game hitting streak, the Cardinals slugger is 13-for-25 (.520) with 3 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI. In 11 games in July, he is batting .400 (16-for-44) with a team-high 1.080 OPS.

YEAGER BOMBS: With home runs in back-to-back games, Cardinals INF **RJ Yeager** has regained his power stroke and run his hitting streak to 8 straight games, batting .306 with 2 2B, 3 HR and 7 RBIs since July 10. Yeager hit a team-high 5 homers in April before hitting just 2 longballs in May and June combined.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights-out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 16-for-16 and his 16 saves lead all of Double-A.

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 12.0 IP (0.69 ERA) and is 6-for-6 in save opportunities.
