LAST GAME

The Baysox got back in the win column last night, with a 12-4 victory over the Erie SeaWolves. What started as a back-and-forth affair began with a run across for the SeaWolves in each of the first two frames against Baysox starter Justin Armbruster. Bowie responded with a pair of home runs in the third - a solo shot from Heston Kjerstad and a two-run blast from Cesar Prieto, to give the Baysox a 3-2 lead. Erie would manage a pair of unearned runs across the fifth and sixth inning, before the Baysox bats came to life in the bottom half of the sixth. Bowie sent all nine men to the plate and capitalized with five runs in the frame. Gilbert Lara started it off with an RBI double, before Noelberth Romero singled him home. Kjerstad would go on to pick up a two-run double followed by a Coby Mayo RBI single later in the frame. The Baysox followed it up with four more runs in the seventh. Lara picked up his second RBI of the night on a single, with Zach Watson playing a run on a sacrifice fly prior to Mayo notching two more RBI on a single. On the mound, four stellar innings of one-hit relief from Connor Gillispie was enough to secure the victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The SeaWolves enter tonight with a record of 10-14 and sit in fifth place in the Southwest division standings - two games ahead of Bowie. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, The SeaWolves have hit seven home runs in the first three games of the series and lead the Eastern League with 27 home runs on the season. However, Erie has the worst staff ERA in the league at 5.90. SeaWolves arms has allowed the most hits (233), earned runs (143), and home runs (28) in the league. The SeaWolves welcome back Gabe Alvarez for his second season as the team's manager, alongside a mostly new staff. Erie's roster consists of nine of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. Position players include infielders Colt Keith (No. 4 DET/ No. 94 overall), Wencel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 29 DET), along with C Dillon Dingler (No. 14 DET). Right-handers Wilmer Flores (No. 3 DET/ No. 85 overall), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), and Elvis Alvarado (No. 23 DET), alongside left-hander Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET) feature on the mound.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Erie's projected start for the evening is right-hander Sawyer Gipson-Long. Making his sixth appearance, and fifth start of the season, tonight, Gipson-Long has had a mixed bag of performances so far in 2023. In his most recent start last Friday, he was tagged for five runs on seven hits through just three frames against Portland. In his two starts prior, the right-hander only allowed a single run across five innings in each of them. Gipson-Long enjoyed the bulk of last season in Double-A, but actually began his career at the level in the Twins' organization, playing for the Wichita Wind Surge. The right-hander was the return for the Tigers in the Michael Fulmer deal last August. Upon arrival in Erie, Gipson-Long posted a 4.54 ERA across 35.2 innings (seven starts), including a start against Bowie on 8/30, where he allowed five runs (three earned) through six frames. Gipson-Long began 2022 at High-A Cedar Rapids, where he was teammates with tonight's Baysox starter, Cade Povich. Originally a sixth-round pick of the Twins out of Mercer, Gipson-Long features a fastball, slider, and changeup.

AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

Out of the 17 home runs hit by the Baysox this season, all of them have been either solo or two-run shots. Bowie is one of two Eastern League teams to have yet to hit a three-run homer or a grand slam in 2023, with the other being the Portland Sea Dogs. More specifically, 12 of Bowie's 17 home runs have been solo bombs this season, accounting for just over 70% of its long ball production. Only Portland has a higher portion of solo home runs in the Eastern League, at 86.7% (13/15).

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his seventh home run of the season last night, good for second-most in the Eastern League. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated consistency across the league leaderboards - ranking fourth in OPS (1.006), third in slugging percentage (.634) and second in extra-base hits (13) and total bases (52). Kjerstad has the second-most home runs and most extra-base hits throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS is third best and his slugging percentage is second.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 31 hits and .348 batting average. Last night's 2-5 performance was Prieto's ninth multi-hit contest in his first 22 games of 2023. Prieto's 11-game hitting streak last month is currently tied for the longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's average is third best on the Baltimore farm among qualifiers.

DOUBLE THE MAYO

INF Coby Mayo has gotten on a roll for the Baysox through this most recent home stand. The No. 9 Orioles' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, notched his first three hit game of the season last night, and just his second in a Baysox uniform. Mayo is now hitting .308 (8-for-26) with five doubles in eight straight games at home. Beyond that potency at the plate, Mayo has also walked seven times during this stretch, giving him an on-base percentage of .484 this home stand after reaching on 15 of his 31 plate appearances. Mayo leads the Orioles' system with his eight doubles, while his 11 extra-base hits are the third-highest total on the farm.

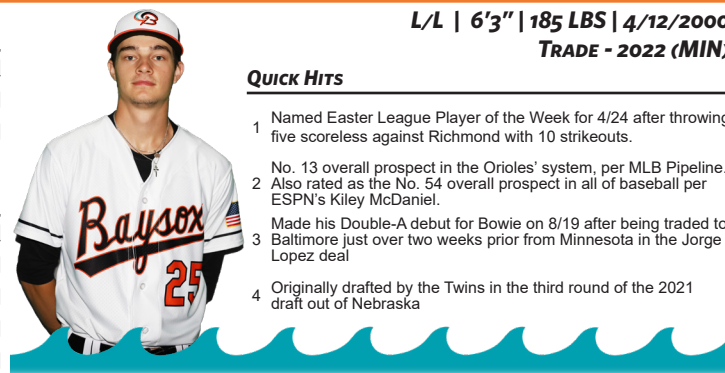

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third.
