**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds wrap up the series with Jacksonville this afternoon after yesterday's game was postponed due to wet grounds. Right-hander Adrian Houser is making his third rehab start for the Sounds. Chi Chi González gets the start for the Jumbo Shrimp.

**Adrian Houser:** 30-year-old Adrian Houser makes his third start of the season after opening the series Tuesday. He was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 29 (retroactive to March 27) with right groin tightness. Houser went 6-10 with a 4.73 ERA (102.2 IP/54 ER) in 22 games (21 starts) with the Brewers in 2022. He made three rehab appearances with the Sounds last year, going 0-1 with a 3.24 ERA. Houser was acquired by Milwaukee on July 30, 2015 in a trade with Houston. He was originally drafted by the Astros in the second round of the 2011 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Locust Grove High School (Okla.).

**Chi Chi González:** 31-year-old Chi Chi González starts for the Jumbo Shrimp today. The righty is 2-1 with a 5.16 ERA (22.2 IP/13 ER). He hurled 7.0 scoreless innings for the win in the series opener on Tuesday (3 H, 2 BB, 4 K). In 2022, González went 0-1 with a 5.87 ERA (23.0 IP/15 ER) in 7 games (5 starts) between New York-AL, Miami and Minnesota. He also went 2-3 with a 4.03 ERA in 18 games (14 starts) in Triple-A between the three organizations. González was named the IL Pitcher of the Week for May 15, 2022. He was originally drafted by Texas in the first round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft out of Oral Roberts University (Okla.).

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 7, Sixth: 2, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Jacksonville Gets Junked:** On Friday night, Janson Junk became the first Nashville starter to earn a win in 2023, holding the Jumbo Shrimp to two hits over 5.2 scoreless innings. He has not allowed a run in Triple-A since the fourth inning of his April 2 start vs. Louisville - 12.0 innings ago. Junk's ERA is down to an International League-best 0.57. He also ranks among IL leaders in opponent average (.135, 2nd) and WHIP (0.89, 4th).

**Can't Fool the Bull:** Abraham Toro pushed his on-base streak to 14 games Friday night with another two-hit performance, driving in three runs. It is one of nine active on-base streaks of 14 or more games in the IL and remains tied with Jon Singleton's active on-base streak as the longest on the team. Toro also has a nine-game hitting streak, batting .378 (14-for-37) over the span.

**Made For Walking:** Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 14 games with an RBI single and walk on Friday. After walking only once through his first 10 games, Singleton has earned 11 free passes over the past seven games and has taken ball four in each of those games. He set a Sounds single season record and led the league with 117 walks in 2022.

**Steady Eddy:** Sounds infielder/outfielder Eddy Alvarez is riding an eight-game on-base streak dating back to April 12 and has picked up a hit in his last six games. The speedy lefty is batting .533 (8-for-15) this series with 3 doubles and 4 RBI. Alvarez is batting .353 on the season, the highest mark in the Brewers' system and 10th-highest in the International League.

**My Hiura:** Keston Hiura went 2-for-5 with a double and 2 RBI in Friday's win. Seven of Hiura's last nine hits have gone for extra bases (1 2B, 6 HR). The slugger is tied for second in the IL in home runs (7).

**Why Settle for Less?:** The Sounds' seven-run margin of victory on Friday was the largest of the season, easily surpassing the previous high of four runs. It is also the franchise's biggest win since September 21, 2022, when they pummeled the Louisville Bats 17-1.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 610-527 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Houser's previous start came on April 18 at Jacksonville, his second rehab start. Houser tossed 3.0 innings, allowing six hits, one walk and striking out five. He took the loss as the Sounds fell 3-2.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Houser has twocareer appearances against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. In his first start on August 16, 2022 at 121 Financial Ballpark, he allowed five runs (3 earned) on five hits (1 homer) in 3.1 innings. Houser also walked three and punched out four. He was saddled with the loss in Nashville's 12-1 defeat. He also faced the Jumbo Shrimp on Tuesday. He is 0-2 with a 7.11 ERA (6.1 IP/5 ER) against Jacksonville in his career.

## 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Placed on injured list with right groin tightness on 3/29...sent to Nashville on rehab assignment on April 14 and made season debut that night (2.0 IP, 2 H, 2 BB, 2 K).

## 2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 6-10 with a 4.73 ERA in 22 games (21 starts) with Milwaukee...102.2 IP, 103 H, 66 R, 54 ER, 47 BB, 69 K.
- After taking loss in first two starts, earned win in back-to-back quality starts on 4/23 (at PHI) and 4/29 (vs. CHC)...finished April with a 2.53 ERA.
- Took loss on 5/17 vs. ATL despite lone run being unearned...was only quality start loss of season.
- Placed on the injured list with a right flexor strain on 7/1.
- Began rehab assignment with Nashville on 8/6...went 0-1 with a 3.24 ERA in three games with the Sounds.
- Rejoined Milwaukee on 8/24, but placed on injured list on 9/28 with a right groin strain.
- Allowed just one run on one hit in 6.0 innings on 9/10 vs. CIN...did not strike out any of 21 hitters faced, the most he's faced in a game without a punchout...was one of eight games last year where starter tossed 6.0+ innings with no strikeouts.

- Went 10-6 with a 3.22 ERA in 28 games (26 starts) with Milwaukee...142.1 IP, 118 H, 61 R, 51 ER, 64 BB, 105 K.
- Went 7-1 with a 2.65 ERA (98.2 IP/29 ER) over last 19 games (17 starts), including 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (30.0 IP/5 ER) over his last five starts.
- Made seven quality starts and held opponents to a .228 average.
- Became the 15th pitcher since 1900 to hit a home run, walk nobody and strike out 10 batters on 5/8 at Miami.
- Hit solo homers off Miami's Daniel Castano on 4/27 and 5/8.
- Threw his first nine-inning complete game shutout on 9/4 vs. St. Louis (also was the first Brewers shutout since Kyle Lohse on 9/24/14 at Cincinnati).
- Pitched in two games in the NLDS...earned a win in game one (2.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 K) and took the loss in game three (1.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 BB).

- Went 1-6 with a 5.30 ERA in 12 games (11 starts) with the Brewers.
- Went 1-0 with a 0.75 ERA (12.0 IP, 1 ER) in his first two start of the season.
