PITCHING PROWESS: The Spartanburgers lead the SAL South Division in team ERA (3.38). Hub City has tossed three shutouts across its past two series. A big reason for the success? Hub City has limited the long ball. The Spartanburgers arms have allowed just 12 HRs, one shy of the league best. The league average is up above 20 HRs surrendered. The bullpen has led the charge for Hub City. Spartanburgers relievers combine for an ERA of just 3.18.

LEADIN' OFF WITH LEANDRO: Hub City sent Leandro Lopez to the mound to begin the home series. Lopez has been the game #1 starter in each of the three home series so far this season. Hub City is undefeated in home series openers; Lopez tossed 10.2 scoreless with 14 strikeouts in his last two home outings.

TOP DOGS: The Spartanburgers sit in a tie for first place in the South Division with Rome. Greensboro has the best record in the league with a half game advantage in the North Division. Neither team has lost a series so far this season.

FLYIN' OUT OF FIFTH THIRD PARK: Hub City has managed to turn its ballpark into a hitter-friendly park, at least for the home team. So far this season, the Spartanburgers have a batting average almost 50 points higher at home compared to on the road. Hub City has yet to hit a home run while on the road in 15 games. Meanwhile, the Spartanburgers have launched 15 home runs at home in just 13 games played in the brand new ballpark.

LATE GAME LEADERS: The Spartanburgers are outscoring opponents 35-18 in the final three innings. 18 runs in the seventh, just four in the eighth, and a whopping 13 in the ninth. On the contrast, opponents have only scored seven runs in the ninth.

2024 v. GBO: The Hickory Crawdads went 7-8 against the Greensboro Grasshoppers. Hickory won its final five games of the year against Greensboro, including a three-game series sweep in the middle of July.

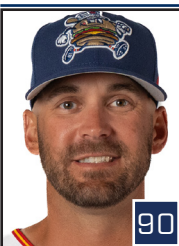
The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



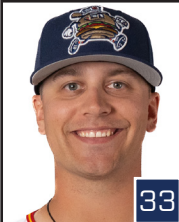
Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Spartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.

He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.
