FEELS GOOD TO BE 4-0: The fourth season of Fredericksburg Nationals baseball is off to the best start in franchise history at 4-0 after a 15-4 thrashing of the Lynchburg Hillcats in the first road game of the year last night. Fredericksburg is one of two remaining undefeated teams in the Carolina League, and the team has scored double digit runs in three games in a row. Tonight, RHP Bryan Sanchez gets the ball for the first time this year. His 2023 season in Fredericksburg was cut short due to injury, and prior to his injury, he split time between the starting rotation and the bullpen. He faces Top-15 Guardians prospect LHP Jackson Humphries for the Hillcats.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Freddies racked up a season-high 15 runs on 15 hits, and took advantage of seven Lynchburg errors to cruise to a 15-4 win in the series opener. Liam Sullivan pitched into the 5th inning in his start, allowing two runs and striking out a career-high nine hitters. Brenner Cox had a career-high three hits and three RBIs, Phillip Glasser had two more hits and three runs scored, Elijah Green had a multi-hit game with two RBIs, and Gavin Dugas had two RBI doubles in the win. Bubba Hall and Anthony Arguelles also had scoreless relief outings for FXBG.

THE START BY THE NUMBERS: The FredNats are on top of the leaderboards in many different categories offensively to start the year, and the pitching staff is not far behind. The Freddies have scored the second-most runs (40) out of any team Double-A and below (who all started the season on the same day), second to Fresno who has 41. Frederickburg's +26 run differential is also the best among teams Double-A and below. Gavin Dugas is also second in the Carolina League in batting average (.500) among qualified hitters. The FredNats have put up these offensive numbers despite having only one home run through the first four games of the year.

RECORD-BREAKING START: Brandon Pimentel's eight RBIs Saturday night set the single-game franchise record since the team moved to Fredericksburg. He had two RBI doubles, and a grand slam in the 7th inning for his first home run as a FredNat, and the first homer of the year for Fredericksburg. Pimentel had two more doubles and two more RBIs last night in Lynchburg, and his 11 RBIs through four games is the most in Minor League Baseball in Double-A and below. Pimentel's four doubles in four games is also the most in Double-A and below. Pimentel is an undrafted free agent out of the University of Texas at Rio Grande Valley, where he set numerous school records in just two seasons.

PROSPECTS IN THE 'BURG: Three of the Nationals' Top-30 prospects will begin the season with Fredericksburg. All three spent time with the FredNats in 2023, and all three of those prospects are ranked in the Top-10 in the system. Elijah Green is ranked as the 6th-best prospect in the system according to MLB Pipeline, Cristhian Vaquero is the 9th-best, and Jarlin Susana is the 10th ranked prospect. All three are also in the Top-10 in the Baseball America prospect rankings.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 145-120 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Bryan Sanchez is making his 2024 debut tonight for the Fredericksburg Nationals. Signed by Washington out of the Dominican Republic in 2018, Sanchez got his first taste of professional baseball in the Dominican Summer League in 2019.

After missing 2021, Sanchez came stateside for the first time in 2022, and impressed in the GCL with a 3.79 ERA across nine appearances (eight starts).

That earned him a spot on the Opening Day roster for the FredNats last season, where he split time evenly between starting and coming out of the bullpen. Bryan began the year as a reliever, with six appearances from April into early May. But after some reshuffling, Sanchez moved into the starting rotation. He excelled in that role, allowing one run or fewer in four of his six starts before ultimately being shelved for the year due to injury in mid-June.

AGAINST LYNCHBURG: Bryan Sanchez pitched against Lynchburg twice last season. During opening weekend, the right-hander fired two innings of relief, giving up one earned run while punching out three. The second outing against the 'Cats was less effective, as Sanchez allowed three ER in 1.2 innings of work.
