**GRAND FINALE:** The Omaha Storm Chaser came from behind to defeat the St. Paul Saints on Sunday, 9-6, thanks to a go-ahead grand slam from **1B Nick Pratto** in the seventh inning as part of a five-run inning. It was the first grand slam at Werner Park this season and second this season for Omaha (Anderson Miller, 6/24 @ IOW). The Chasers also got a home run from **INF Bobby Witt Jr.**, his second home run of the series and his first that cleared the fence after his inside-the-park home run on Wednesday, 7/21. **RHP Dylan Coleman** earned his first career Triple-A win while **RHP Joel Payamps** picked up his first save as a member of the Storm Chasers.

**AT THE TOP:** The Omaha Storm Chasers took over sole possession of first place in the Triple-A Midwest Division on May 26 following a win over Indianapolis and have now remained in sole possession of first place for two consecutive months (May 26-pres.), a stretch that spans 62 days. Omaha has held a 2.0 lead over second-place Toledo since July 24, the slimmest divisional lead since May 27. The Chasers largest divisional lead was 7.0 games, most recently on 6/24. Omaha had a 12-7 record following the game on May 26 and has gone 30-11 since.

**YOUNG STUDS: INF Bobby Witt Jr.**, the youngest player on the Omaha roster at 21 years old, made his Triple-A debut on 7/20 vs. STP and is 11-for-30 (.367) with a double, two home runs, and four multi-hit games through his first six Triple-A games. He recorded his first Triple-A home run on Wednesday, 7/21, a go-ahead inside-the-park home run. **1B Nick Pratto**, the team's third-youngest player at 22 years old (one month older than **C Sebastian Rivero**), also made his Triple-A debut on 7/20 vs. STP and is 6-for-22 (.273) through six games with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBIs, and five walks, reaching safely in all six games. He hit his first Triple-A home run on 7/22 vs. STP before crushing a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning on 7/25 vs. STP in the series finale.

**GET IZZY WITH IT: OF Kyle Isbel** is in the midst of a season-best 13-game hitting streak, the longest hitting streak by an Omaha player this season. In his last 13 games (7/11-pres.), Isbel is batting .415/.538/.707 with six doubles, two home runs, nine RBIs, 11 walks, and six strikeouts. While Isbel is batting .254/.354/.415 in 65 games this season, he's batting .324/.434/.559 in 20 games in July. After batting either first, second, or third in the order in his first 43 games, Isbel has hit fifth in the lineup each of his last 22 games, beginning on 6/29 @ STP. He is currently tied for third in the league with 16 stolen bases (17 attempts).

**STEALING THE SPOTLIGHT:** The Storm Chasers are tied for the Triple-A East lead with 82 stolen bases. Omaha has only been caught stealing 16 times, giving the team an 85.4% success rate that is also second in the league. The Chasers stole 65 bases in 76 attempts (85.5%) in the first 61 games of the season while the league used experimental 18" x 18" bases and have 17 steals in 23 attempts (73.9%)—the most in the league—since the switch to the standard 15" x 15" bases on Tuesday, July 13. **OF Kyle Isbel** is tied for third in the league with 16 steals while **OF Edward Olivares** has 12, **INF Lucius Fox** and **OF Anderson Miller** have seven, and **OF Rudy Martin** has six.

**ROCKY ROAD:** The Omaha Storm Chasers are 24-11 (.686) at Werner Park—the third-best home winning percentage in Triple-A East—but 18-17 (.514) in road games this season. In 35 home games, the Chasers are batting .278/.347/.488 with 62 home runs and a 4.06 ERA. In 35 road games, Omaha is batting .253/.335/.460 with 57 home runs and a 5.64 road ERA that ranks third-worst in the league.

**FOR OMAHA: RHP Brandon Barker** makes his third start (fourth appearance) for Omaha. He allowed three runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings on 7/21 vs. STP and now has back-to-back starts of at least 5.0 IP and no more than three runs allowed. His Chasers debut came in relief on 7/11 vs. TOL, when he allowed two runs on four hits in 0.1 inning in the series finale at Werner Park. Barker was pitching for the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs in the independent Atlantic League, posting a 2.89 ERA in seven starts (371 innings) with 34 strikeouts and 13 walks. Barker last pitched in affiliated baseball in 2018 for Double-A Jacksonville (MIA). He was drafted in the 16th round of the 2014 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves after playing four seasons at Mercer University. Barker was born in Panama City, Panama, and grew up in Woodstock, Ga.

**FOR TOLEDO: RHP Ricardo Pinto** makes his eighth start for Toledo and second start against Omaha. Pinto allowed a season-high eight runs on a season-high 10 hits in a season-low 2.0 innings in his last start on 7/20 @ IND, his first start in July with less than 5.0 IP and more than two runs allowed. Pinto Recorded a 19.0-inning scoreless streak across three starts from 6/25-7/7, including throwing 7.0 shutout innings against Omaha on 7/7 at Werner Park. This is Pinto's first season with the Detroit Tigers organization, signing with them as a free agent in February of 2021. He has also spent time with Philadelphia, Chicago (AL), Tampa Bay, and San Francisco.

- Tossed 6.1 innings of one-run ball on 7/14 @ IND in first start with Omaha, recording the longest start of the year for an Omaha starting pitcher
- Began the 2021 season with the Southern Maryland Blue Crabs of the Atlantic League, recording a 2.88 ERA in seven starts with 34 strikeouts and 13 walks in 37.1 innings
- Played for the Trois-Rivieres Aingles of the Can-Am League in 2019, posting a 3.39 ERA in 19 starts
- Played for Fargo-Moorhead in the independent American Association in 2018, posting a 4.85 ERA in 12 starts
- Voluntarily retired on April 28, 2018 following six outings (one start) with Double-A Jacksonville (MIA)
- Has made three career starts at the Triple-A level, two with Gwinnett (ATL) in 2015 and one with Norfolk (BAL) in 2017
- Was selected by the Miami Marlins in the fourth round (Triple-A phase) of the 2017 Rule 5 Draft
- Was traded from the Atlanta Braves to the Baltimore Orioles on May 23, 2016 in exchange for RHP Brian Matusz and LHP Trevor Belicek
- Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 16th round (493rd overall) in the 2014 MLB Draft
- Pitched three years at Mercer, serving as a mid-week starter as a freshman, a weekend starter and closer as a sophomore, and the team's Friday night starter as a junior
- Posted a 2.66 ERA in 17 starts as a junior at Mercer, striking out 79 and walking 27 in 84.2 innings
- Was born in Panama City, Panama and grew up in Woodstock, Ga., graduating from Etowah High School with a perfect 4.0 GPA
