W IS FOR WIN: The Omaha Storm Chasers bounced back from Friday's loss with a 4-2 win over the Columbus Clippers on Saturday, led by a strong start from RHP Jackson Kowar and a three-run third inning. Kowar struck out eight—one shy of tying his career high—across 51 innings, allowing one run on three hits and two walks. In the third, shortstop Kevin Merrell singled with two outs to start a rally. Merrel scored on an RBI double by Edward Olivares, who scored on an RBI single from Lucius Fox, who scored two batters later on an RBI single by Ryan McBroom. The Chasers added a run in the sixth on an RBI single by Meibrys Viloria, who finished the game 3-for-4 with an RBI. RHP Kyle Zimmer tossed 1.2 scoreless innings in his second rehab appearance and LHP Gabe Speier recorded the final four outs to secure the win and earn his second save of the season.

**E IS FOR EDWARD: OF Edward Olivares** went 1-for-4 with an RBI double to extend his on-base streak to 11 games to begin the season. He's hit safely in 10 of 11 games this season, batting .341/.431/.568 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, nine RBIs, 10 runs scored, six walks, and four stolen bases. The 25-year-old is currently tied for seventh in Triple-A East with 15 hits.

V IS FOR VILORIA: C Meibrys Viloria has reached safely in nine of his last 12 plate appearances after going 3-for-4 with an RBI on Saturday. Viloria, who is seeing his first Triple-A action in 2021, ranks eighth in Triple-A East in average (.379) and 13th in on-base percentage (.455)

**B IS FOR BIRTHDAY:** Storm Chasers manager **Brian Poldberg** (64) and **C Freddy Fermin** (26) each celebrate birthdays today. The Storm Chasers have not fared well in celebrating Poldberg, posting an 0-3 record in games on May 16 since his teunre as skipper began in 2014. The Chasers were rained out on May 16, 2017 vs. Tacoma and had a scheduled off day on May 16, 2018. Overall, Omaha has been outscored 14-3 on May 16 since 2014. Fermin has played one professional game on his birthday, going 1-for-4 with a home run at Kannapolis in 2019.

P IS FOR PITCHING PROSPECTS: With LHP Daniel Lynch joining the Storm Chasers after being optioned on Saturday, each member of the team's starting rotation is one of the Kansas City Royals top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. Lynch, who is scheduled to make his Omaha debut on Tuesday, is the No. 2 prospect in the Royals organization, while RHP Jackson Kowar is No. 4, RHP Carlos Hernández is No. 15, RHP Ronald Bolaños is No. 18, and RHP Scott Blewett is No. 25.

R IS FOR REHAB ASSIGNMENTS: RHP Kyle Zimmer (strained left trapezius) and RHP Jesse Hahn (right shoulder impingement) have joined the Storm Chasers for rehab assignments. Zimmer, who was placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 1, has made two rehab appearances, throwing 2.2 scoreless innings with four strikeouts and two walks. Of the two hits he's allowed, one was an opposite-field single to his younger brother Bradley in their first-ever meeting in a professional game on Wednesday. Hahn threw 0.2 scoreless innings on Thursday, striking out the first batter he faced but exited with the bases loaded and two outs after allowing a single and hitting two batters.

O IS FOR OMAHA: RHP Carlos Hernández makes his third start of the season and second start of the series after taking the hill in the series opener on Tuesday. Hernández tossed 5.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday, allowing just three hits and two walks while striking out six in a bounce-back outing from his season debut on May 5 vs. St. Paul when he yielded a career-high eight runs (six earned) on 10 hits in 4.0 innings in his Triple-A debut. Hernández, the No. 15 prospect in the Royals organization according to *Baseball America* began the season with the Royals, posting a 10.80 ERA in three relief appearances (3.1 IP) with five strikeouts and five walks

C IS FOR COLUMBUS: LHP Kirk McCarty makes his third start of the season and second start of the series after starting the series opener on Tuesday. McCarty outdueled RHP Carlos Hernández on Tuesday, holding Omaha scoreless for six innings while allowing just three hits and no walks and striking out three in a 2-0 shutout win for Columbus. A seventh round pick in 2017 out of Southern Miss., McCarty's start on Tuesday marked his Triple-A debut and first above the High-A level. He made 13 starts for High-A Lynchburg in 2019, recording a 5.66 ERA, 60 strikeouts, and 16 walks in 55.2 innings.

**U IS FOR UPCOMING SCHEDULE:** Following the completion of this week's six-game series at Columbus, the Chasers travel to Des Moines, IA, for the first of three trips this season to Principal Park to face the lowa Cubs in a six-game series. Omaha, which faces lowa more than any other opponent this season (36 games), is 499-465 (.518) all-time against lowa dating back to 1969. The I-Cubs are currently 5-5 (-1.5 GB, 4th Place - MW).
