STEPHAN, WALCOTT'S BIG NIGHTS FUEL FOURTH-STRAIGHT ROUGHRIDERS WIN:

Sebastian Walcott homered while Josh Stephan earned a quality start to guide the Frisco RoughRiders to a 4-0 victory over the Corpus Christi Hooks on Thursday night from Whataburger Field. The Riders extended their winning streak to four games with the victory. The RoughRiders (13-5) drew first blood in the top of the first inning when Walcott stole third and scored on a throwing error by Hooks (4-14) catcher Ryan Wrobleski. Then in the top of the second, Cam Cauley nabbed third and scored on a wild pitch to give the Riders a 2-0 lead. Walcott accounted for the final two Frisco runs. In the top of the third, he lifted a solo home run, his second of the season and, in the top of the sixth, he served an RBI single to give the RoughRiders a 4-0 lead. RoughRiders starter Josh Stephan (2-0) earned the victory and his second Double-A quality start, punching out eight in six scoreless innings, allowing just three hits while walking one. Corpus Christi threatened by loading the bases in the bottom of the eighth. With the tying run at the plate, Riders reliever **Travis MacGregor** struck out Wrobleski to end the threat. Frisco reliever **Skylar Hales** pitched a scoreless ninth inning to seal the RoughRiders' fourth-straight win. Hooks starter James Hicks (0-1) suffered the loss, allowing three runs (two earned) in 4.2 innings.

#### OH WHAT A START:

The Riders have started the season with a 13-5 record, the third-best start in franchise history through 18 games. In both 2008 and 2016, Frisco started the season 14-4, which is tied for the best start to a season since 2005 in the Texas League.

#### **LITTLE SEBASTIAN? BIG SEBASTIAN:**

Top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been off to an incredible start with the RoughRiders. The 19-year-old is the second-youngest player in the Texas League in 2025. During an 11-game on-base streak, he is hitting .316 (12-for-38)/.460/.579/1.039 with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBIs, 10 walks, 12 runs scored. In that streak, he has walked 10 times while striking out 10 times. His career .882 OPS in Double-A is the seventh-best in the Texas League as 19-year-old since 2005 (min. 100 ABs). The top three are **Oscar Taveras** at .971 (2012, SPR), **Mike Trout** at .955 (2011, ARK) and **Daric Barton** at .914 (2005, MID).

#### FLYING THE COOP

Cooper Johnson has started out well in 2025 on both offense and defense. At the plate, he is hitting .289/.350/.605/1.043 with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, nine walks and six runs scored. He is third in the Texas League in both SLG and OPS. On defense, Johnson leads the Texas League with seven caught stealings behind the plate, throwing out seven of nine base runners against him. His 78 percent caught-stealing rate is the best in MiLB currently.

The RoughRiders have been excellent in close games this season. In games decided by three runs or fewer, they 7-1 while they are tied for the league lead with eight saves this year. Their bullpen ERA of 3.48 is fourth in the Texas League.

#### POWER BRINGS WINS:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been amazing on offense during their first 18 games. Frisco's 19 home runs through 18 games are second in the Texas League. They are fourth in BA (.259), second in SLG (.415) and second in OPS (.773). **Josh Hatcher**, **Cooper Johnson** and **Luis Mieses** have all hit three home runs, tied for the team lead. Over this stretch where they have won 11 of their last 14 games, Frisco is hitting .264/.372/.477/.849 while also ranking second in runs per game (6.2) and second in home runs (16).

#### HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit 300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 13 of 15 games he's played in, batting .381 (24-for-63)/.388/.603/.991 with five doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, a stolen base and 11 runs scored over his first 15 games. His .381 batting average is 9th in all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has eight multi-hit games and is 7-for-10 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs.

#### **VERSUS THE HOOKS:**

The Riders dominated Corpus Christi last season, going 17-7 against the Hooks. This was in large part due to their dominance on the mound, owning a 3.01 ERA (71ER/212.0IP) in their 24 head-to-head meetings a year ago. Since 2021, the Riders are 50-34 against Corpus Christi despite their losing record against the Hooks in their franchise history (273-279).

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz clubbed his first two home runs of the season last week.

#### **ABOUT BEN**

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.82 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

#### 2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out thee side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

# 2023 SEASON -Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

#### **2022 SEASON**

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

#### **2021 SEASON**

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.

#### **2019 SEASON**

-Saw minimal pro action after being drafted. Posted a 9.9 SO/9 figure over 7 G for Spokane (A) and AZL Rangers (Rk.).
