



With the reopening of Regions Field for Barons baseball in 2021, the Birmingham Barons' intent is to provide a fun, family atmosphere in a safe environment. Through a reduced capacity with social distancing boundaries, guests can take comfort in knowing that the Birmingham Barons and Regions Field have committed to their safety at all times.

Before You Arrive

If you or any member of your ticket group has been exposed to COVID-19 or is feeling sick, please stay home. Attendees are not permitted to enter the ballpark if, during the 14 days prior to the date of the game, they have: (i) tested positive or presumptively positive for COVID-19 or other Communicable Disease (defined below) or been identified as a potential carrier of COVID-19 or other communicable disease; or (ii) experienced any of the symptoms listed below or any other symptom commonly associated with COVID-19 or other Communicable Disease; or (iii) been in direct contact with or the immediate vicinity of any person who is confirmed or suspected of being infected with COVID-19 or other Communicable Disease.

A "Communicable Disease" as used herein is COVID-19, any strains, variants, or mutations thereof, the coronavirus that causes COVID-19, and/or any other communicable and/or infectious diseases, viruses, bacteria or illnesses or the causes thereof.

SYMPTOMS COMMONLY ASSOCIATED WITH COVID-19 OR OTHER COMMUNICABLE DISEASE:

- Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing
- Cough (new onset or worsening)
- Fever (felt feverish or warm)
- Headache
- Chills
- Sore or Scratchy Throat
- New Loss of Taste or Smell
- Muscle Pain
- Nasal Congestion
- Runny Nose
- Nausea or Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Gastrointestinal distress or upset stomach
- Fatigue or Weakness
- Swelling of the toes or lower extremities
- Chest tightness or pain
- Swollen lymph nodes or glands
- Abdominal pain
- Rash or "COVID toes"

Attendees who display any of these symptoms may be denied entry to the ballpark or, if already inside the ballpark, may be required to leave. Attendees must comply with instructions of ballpark personnel and health authorities, including any instructions to leave the ballpark or temporarily quarantine or isolate somewhere in the ballpark.

Entry

- All attendees age two (2) years and older must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth at all times on ballpark property other than when actively eating or drinking at their ticketed seats.
- Only medical bags, manufactured diaper bags that accompany infants and young children will be permitted. All bags are subject to inspection prior to entering the ballpark.
- Food, beverages, weapons of any kind, (even with a concealed weapons permit) containers such as coolers or thermoses, lawn chairs, helium balloons, banners or signs that are not in the spirit of the event or that obstruct the view of others, animals other than service animals and compressed air horns are all prohibited at Regions Field.
- It is recommended tickets are purchased online in advance of each game. Tickets will also be available for purchase at Regions Field (based on availability).

Inside Regions Field

- All attendees age two (2) years and older must wear a face covering over their nose and mouth at all times on ballpark property other than when actively eating or drinking at their ticketed seats.
- We ask that you physically distance at ingress, egress, and in lines for concessions and merchandise to the extent possible. Please refrain from crowding during the event.
- Hand sanitizing stations are available in various locations around the ballpark.
- Bowl seating will consist of pods of no more than six (6) seats. Seats that have been “blocked” for social distancing purposes will be tied with an identifying string or zip tie to label the seat is not able to be used by guests.
- Right field bleachers will be made available to the fans with limited seating marked by tape on the backs and bench of the bleachers
- Ballpark Berm (lawn areas) will be marked for guest on what is open to sit in and what is not open by an identifying marker
- Guests must sit in purchased seats. Guests found sitting in incorrect seats will be asked to move; tampering with closed/open seats may be instructed to leave the facility.
- The Family Fun Park will be closed due to sanitation issues until further notice.
- No player autographs will be available.
- All areas of the ballpark accessed by fans will be cleaned and disinfected at regular intervals using processes and products approved by the CDC and EPA for use against COVID-19.
