JACKSONVILLE HOLDS OFF GWINNETT IN 4-3 WIN
Robinson Piña tossed 5.0 innings of one-run ball on Friday and Jacksonville stymied a late Gwinnett rally to win 4-3. Three batters into the bottom of the first, **James McCann** homered to give the Stripers the early advantage. The Jumbo Shrimp gained the lead in the third on an **Andrew Pinter** RBI triple and **Joe Mack** RBI single before adding two more runs in the fourth, thanks to an error and then **Jakob Marsee** RBI ground out. The score remained 4-1 until Gwinnett plated two runs in the ninth inning, but Jacksonville escaped the threat to win 4-3.

AND SHE THINKS WE'RE JUST FISHIN'

Jacksonville is now 10-0 against Gwinnett this season, meaning 29.4 percent of their wins have come at the hands of the Stripers. The Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their fishy foe by an extraordinary 46-15 margin, an average of 4.6-1.5 per game, while outhitting the Stripers 77-46. Meanwhile, Jacksonville pitching has held Gwinnett to a .156/.224/.247/.471 batting line through these 10 games - the Stripers have been shut out four times and scored more than two runs in a game against the Jumbo Shrimp just once thus far in 2025.

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 46 games, a whopping 33, or 71.7 percent, have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 23-10 (.697) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 25-11 (.694) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 13-6 (.684) mark in one-run games. Those 13 one-run victories are tied for the most in Triple-A and tied for second in MiLB.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the season opener, Jacksonville has recorded a stolen base in 45 of their last 54 games, with multiple steals in 34 contests. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have eight games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp lead Triple-A and are third in the minors with 129 steals.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

Jacksonville's bullpen went nearly a week between earned runs, yielding three runs in the ninth inning of their May 24 contest against Memphis before a ninth-inning tally on Friday for Gwinnett. Over their last five games, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to surrender only four runs, one earned, on five hits in 18.0 innings for a 0.50 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined for 17 strikeouts against 11 walks during this stretch.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Over the first four games of their series at the Stripers, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have combined to cede just two runs on nine hits in 21.0 innings for a 0.86 ERA. Jacksonville lid-lifters have fanned 16 Gwinnett hitters against seven walks during this set. Through the four games in general, the Stripers have scored only four runs on 11 hits in 32.0 innings.

EXIT (VELOCITY) STRATEGY

Jacksonville's biggest strength in 2025, along with stealing bases, has been its pitching and defense. The club ranks second in Triple-A with a 3.55 ERA, and their 220 runs allowed are the third-fewest at the level. Interestingly, Jacksonville's staff ranks only 16th in Triple-A in strikeouts (475), but their 374 hits allowed are the level's fewest, meaning the club has suppressed quite a few balls put in play. Opponents have mustered an average exit velocity of 87.0 against the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff, the third-lowest such mark in Triple-A.

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp are 13-13 during the month of May. If Jacksonville can win on Saturday against Gwinnett, they would seal with their first winning record in the month of May since going 14-10 in May 2021... Former Jumbo Shrimp **Heriberto Hernandez** made his major league debut on Friday for the Marlins, going 0-for-1 with a walk in Miami's 2-0 loss to San Francisco... By winning the first four games of the series at Coolray Field, Jacksonville has already earned a series win over Gwinnett and is now 6-2-2 in their first 10 series of the season. The club's 34-21 start to the season is their best 55-game beginning to a campaign in recorded club history (2005-present).

ABOUT FREDDY

-A two-way player at Riverview High School (Fla.), Tarnok went 7-0 with a 0.66 ERA while also batting .393. He was selected by the Braves in the third round, signing with Atlanta to bypass a commitment to the University of Tampa.

-Tarnok made his major league debut for the Braves on August 17, 2022, pitching 0.2 scoreless innings in a 9-7 loss to the New York Mets in Atlanta. His first big league strikeout came at the expense of Tyler Naquin.

-On December 12, 2022, the Oakland Athletics acquired Tarnok from the Braves in a three-team trade in which the Atlanta Braves received Sean Murphy, the Milwaukee Brewers acquired William Contreras, Joel Payamps, and Justin Yeager, and the Athletics also acquired Manny Piña, Kyle Muller, Esteury Ruiz, and Royber Salinas.

-The Philadelphia Phillies claimed Tarnok off waivers on June 1, 2024. Following the 2024 season, he signed a minor league contract with the Miami Marlins.

-In seven starts, Tarnok was 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 13 H, 3 BB, 15 K, .283 BAA). However, over 16 relief appearances, he posted an 0-3 record and 9.78 ERA (19.1 IP, 21 H, 17 BB, 21 K, .280 BAA).

-Tarnok held left-handed batters to a .192/.276/.269/.545 line in 58 plate appearances compared to a .184/.333/.447/.780 line for right-handed hitters over 93 plate appearances.
