SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

MASHING AGAINST THE LOOKOUTS: C Jeferson Quero has led Biloxi's offensive attack against Chattanooga, smashing five home run in the series between the two teams at AT&T Field in mid-May... His five home runs are the most by any Shuckers player in a series this year, and he tied the franchise record with three in the series opener... Quero has hit 7-22 (.318) against the Lookouts with five home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.348 OPS.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Shuckers sit six games behind the Pensacola Blue Wahoos for first place in the Southern League South Division with six games remaining in the first half... After the 69th game of the year, the division leaders in the North and South Division will both clinch playoff spots, securing half of the spots in the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... For Biloxi to win the South Division first half title, they would need to win their six remaining games, and Pensacola would need to lose each of their remaining games.

GRAND THEFT BASES: After two stolen bases on Sunday, the Shuckers now have 120 this season, the most in the Southern League and the second-most in Double-A... The Shuckers are one of four teams, along with the Portland Sea Dogs (128, BOS), Somerset Patriots (118, NYY) and the Arkansas Travelers (113, SEA) to swipe at least 100 in 2023... Biloxi is currently on pace for 263 stolen bases, one shy of the Birmingham Baron's Southern League record of 264, set in 1989.

BLX SINGLE-SEASON SB LEADERS THE RACE TO 52: With another stolen base on Sunday, INF Tyler Black has tallied 37 stolen bases in 2023, tied with **OF Corey Ray** for the second most in a single-season by a Shuckers player... His 37 stolen bases lead the Southern League and Double-A... He's also one of two players in Double-A with at least 30... Over 13 games in June, Black is a perfect 13-13 in stolen bases, including five last week in Montgomery.

THOU SHALL NOT STEAL: C Jeferson Quero threw out two more baserunners on Saturday night, increasing his CS% to 35%, a Southern League-best... In 2023, Quero has thrown out 15 of 44 potential basestealers... As a team, the Shuckers have allowed 51 stolen bases, the third-lowest in Double-A and the lowest in the Southern League.

ON THE WRONG SIDE OF THE COIN: After Sunday's 6-5 loss against the Biscuits, the Shuckers fell to 12-19 (.387) in games decided by two runs or less... Five of Biloxi's last eight games have been decided by two runs or less, including three last week in Montgomery.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JASON ALEXANDER [MLB REHAB]: Brewers' RHP Jason Alexander is set to continue his rehab assignment with the Shuckers after making two starts with the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League... Alexander joins Biloxi as he works back from a strained rotator cuff sustained this past offseason... Today marks his first start in the Southern League since 2021 with the Pensacola Blue Wahoos... He owns a 3.96 ERA over 25 appearances and 20 starts in the Southern League over three years.
