- The Blue Jays swept a doubleheader from Bradenton, 8-4 in game one, and 2-1 in game two.
- In game one, Dunedin claimed a 3-0 lead in the second inning thanks to a sac fly from Robert Robertis and a two-run homer from Bryce Arnold.
- After Bradenton rallied for four runs in the third, the Jays took command of the game with a 5-run, 4-hit fifth inning.
- In the nightcap, starting pitching shined. Juaron Watts-Brown went five innings, allowing just two hits and one earned run to earn the win. Antwone Kelly pitched all six innings for Bradenton, but allowed the game's deciding run in unearned fashion in the fourth.
- Between both games, the Jays bullpen delivered six scoreless innings.

### TWICE AS NICE

Dunedin swept its first doubleheader of the season last night. Last season, the D-Jays played seven doubleheaders and swept two of them.

### HIGH WATER MARK

Yesterday's doubleheader sweep pushed the Jays' win-streak to five games and record to three games over .500 at 31-28. It's the first time Dunedin has been three games over .500 since April 21st - the 15th game of the season.

### BIG TIME BULLPEN

The Blue Jays bullpen has fired 17 straight scoreless innings dating back to Friday. Across the last eight games, Dunedin's bullpen has posted a 1.74 ERA in 31 innings of work (6 ER). Overall this season, the Jays bullpen ERA stands at 4.25 (6th in the league).

### WALKING ON ARIAS

Manuel Beltre's 23-game on base streak was snapped in game two last night, but Dunedin still owns the league's longest active on-base streak, thanks to Victor Arias' 19-game stretch. Across the streak, Arias is hitting .239 with a .713 OPS.

### JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays are tied for third in the Florida State League with 43 home runs, trailing Daytona by four for the league lead. Dunedin was limited to three home runs in six games last week at pitcher-friendly Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium. 24 of those home runs have come at TD Ballpark.

### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

With last night's 2-1 win, Dunedin has played 21 one-run games this season, going 10-11 in those contests. 41 of the Blue Jays 59 games this season (69%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 21-20 record in those games. 10 of the team's last 13 games have been decided by two or fewer.

### SO YOU'RE TELLING ME THERE'S A CHANCE?

With seven games remaining in the first half of the season for the Blue Jays, Lakeland holds a seven game lead in the FSL-West standings. Due to rainouts, the Flying Tigers have nine games remaining in their first half schedule. In the event of a tie, Dunedin holds the tiebreaker with Lakeland.

### SERIES SUCCESS

After last week's series win, the Blue Jays have gone four consecutive sets without a series loss (two splits, two wins). The team can clinch at least a series split with a win today. Across the last five weeks, the Jays are 17-13. Last week's series win on the road marked the Jays' first road series victory since they took five of six from Tampa, April 9-14.

### MR. ROGERS NEIGHBORHOOD

Grant Rogers has struggled in his "neighborhood" this season, posting a 6.00 ERA in four starts at TD Ballpark, allowing all four of his home runs at home. Rogers' road ERA stands at 4.01 in five outings.
