ROAD WARRIORS: After splitting the first four games of this series in Myrtle Beach in week two of this road trip, the FredNats will try to secure at least a series split tonight as the weekend has arrived in MB. Fredericksburg is 6-4 through the first 10 games of this two-week road trip to Charleston and Myrtle Beach. Tonight, RHP Marc Davis makes another start for FXBG, and he's been rolling as of late. Davis has fired seven consecutive scoreless innings in his last two starts with seven strikeouts and just two walks. He missed the entire 2023 season with Tommy John surgery. The FredNats continue to lead the league in runs scored (212) and run differential (+56), and are still tied for first place in the North Division of the Carolina League with the Carolina Mudcats.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jarlin Susana had another rough start for Fredericksburg, allowing four runs and not making it out of the 4th inning for the second start in a row. For the second straight day, MB pitching faced the minimum through five, and by that point, the Pelicans led 6-0. The FredNats hit back for three runs in the 7th to make it closer, but ultimately couldn't get the big hit in a 6-3 loss on Friday night at the beach. Elijah Green had two hits and a run scored for FXBG.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. After allowing just five runs in 20 IP this series, the bullpen has pitched 194 innings this year and allowed just 48 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.23. The Fredies are also 13/14 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultiz is tied for first in all of Minor League Baseball with eight saves. The unit has also danced out of trouble time and time again on this road trip. Last night's win over MB was the first drama-free win on this road trip. In all five wins this trip prior to yesterday, the opposing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (18-0), and 8 (20-0) innings.

HE'S NASTY: Jeremy De La Rosa has dominated on this road trip while rehabbing a shoulder injury suffered in Spring Training. In nine games on this rehab assignment, De La Rosa is 11-for-31 with five doubles, two triples and a home run. Defensively in this series alone, he's also robbed two home runs in left field. Both clips were featured on the main Minor League Baseball social media accounts.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 17-2 this season when scoring first, including the last 14 out of the last 15 wins. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in last week's series against Charleston on Friday and Sunday, and Tuesday night against Myrtle Beach was the first time since mid-April the team won despite not scoring first.

FORMULA CONTINUED: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 24 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .247 with RISP, compared to .118 in losses. The FredNats did decently well at the plate with runners in scoring position last week, going a combined 11-for-44 (.250) against the RiverDogs, and then followed it up with an 9-for-37 (.243) performance in the first four games of this series with the Pelicans.

THEY COME THROUGH: The FredNats have two of the top run producers in the Carolina League in their lineup. Brandon Pimentel is first in the Carolina League and second in all of MiLB in RBI with 42, and Brenner Cox is tied for 4th in the league in RBI with 25. Cox has 9 RBI on this current two-week road trip. Pimentel is second in MiLB to Sugar Land's Pedro Leon, who has played a week's more of games at the Triple-A level.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 165-132 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TONIGHT'S START: Marc Davis is set to make his seventh start of 2024, in his return to the mound from Tommy John Surgery in 2022.

Davis had a promising start to his professional career, as the right-hander posted a 3.97 ERA out of the bullpen in '22, while earning a Carolina League Pitcher of the Week nod as well.

JUCO BANDIT: Davis played three seasons at Florida Southwestern State, a junior college located in Fort Myers, FL. With the Buccaneers, Marc worked primarily as a reliever; 34 of his 44 total appearances came out of the bullpen. He recorded a stellar 3.14 ERA to go along with a 1.41 WHIP for his collegiate career, while striking out a whopping 14.55 batters per nine innings.

TWO-WAY TALENT: Davis was recruited as a two-way player out of South Gwinnett High School. He impressed scouts at the plate on the travel circuit, with exit velocities north of 90 MPH as a teenager, and displayed excellent range as a shortstop. Of course, he also possessed a rocket arm, and ultimately chose to focus on the mound.

LAST TIME OUT: Marc authored his longest start of 2024 last week against the Charleston RiverDogs. He spun four dominant frames, limiting Charleston to just a pair of base hits and no runs, while fanning four.
