Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (6-7) vs. Gwinnett Stripers (5-8)

JUMBO SHRIMP BLANK STRIPERS 2-0

Max Meyer fanned seven in 5.2 scoreless innings in Tuesday's series opener to lead the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp to a 2-0 victory over the Gwinnett Stripers. Meyer scattered three hits and two walks in his 5.2 frames departing with the contest still scoreless. The Jumbo Shrimp finally opened the scoring in the sixth. Joe Dunand doubled before JJ Bleday was hit by a pitch. A fielder's choice advanced the runners, and afteer a fly out, Nick Fortes delivered a two-run single for what turned out to be the game's only runs. Jake Fishman. Huascar Brazoban and Jimmy Yacabonis combined to throw 3.1 shutout innings of relief to seal the win.

FOUR SOUARE

Jacksonville has won four consecutive games. In the process, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored their opponents 31-9 with a 47-16 advantage in hits and a 7-1 margin in home runs. In addition to the club's dominance over the last four games - the Jumbo Shrimp rank third out of 120 MiLB teams in hits, tied for eighth in runs and tied for 10th in home runs over this span - Jacksonville racked up 13 runs on 17 hits in Saturday's win over Durham. The 13 runs scored by Jacksonville marked the club's third-highest total over the last four seasons (since 2018), trailing a 15-run outburst at Chattanooga on July 19, 2019 and the 14 runs the club scored in that Charlotte game on July 27, 2021. The 17 hits tallied by the Jumbo Shrimp last night were bested during this same four-season span only by the 19 the club totaled in Chattanooga on July 19, 2019.

Both Lewin Díaz and Peyton Burdick have gotten off to a strong starts to the season. Díaz is 13-for-45 to begin the campaign, slashing .289/.377/.467/.844 with two doubles, two home runs. 10 RBIs and nine runs scored. Meanwhile. Burdick, the Marlins' Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, is 11-for-43, slashing .256/.407/.488/.895 with a double, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 16 runs. Thus, of the 77 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks fourth in the International League - the pair have accounted for 36 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs by the pair), a ratio of 46.8 percent.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 17 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking tied for fifth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late: no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

PITCH PERFECT

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings, posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. Over the last three games, though, Jumbo Shrimp starters have yielded just two runs, one earned, total. During this three-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered a 0.79 ERA in 11.1 innings, fanning 11 against 10 hits and four walks.

SHRIMP ON THE BARBIE

The Jumbo Shrimp rank in a tie for fourth in the International League in runs (77; 5.9 per game), and the biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting .256/.348/.410, producing a .748 OPS that ranks seventh in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .282/.355/.500, with the resulting .855 OPS placing third in the circuit.

Peyton Burdick, who set a career-high with four walks on Sunday leads the circuit in runs (16) His 10 walks place in a tie for fourth... Lorenzo Quintana is tied for sixth in hits (15), fifth in both average (.375) and slugging (.700) and sixth in OPS (1.081).

TRIPLE-A TOTALS

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings

2022 SEASON

2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season.

-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.

-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames.

2019 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted to Jacksonville on August 28 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the southpaw ranked fourth in the Florida State League in batting average against (.230), fourth in strikeouts (118) and ninth in ERA (3.34).

-Out of the 109 pitchers in the Florida State League with at least 50.0 innings pitched, Garrett was 11th in xFIP (2.72) and 20th in strikeout percentage (26.9 percent). He had posted the circuit's 10th-lowest fly ball rate (27.8 percent) and 15th-highest ground ball rate (52.7 percent).

2018 SEASON

-Garrett did not pitch during the 2018 season, as he was recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2017 SEASON

-The Florence, Ala., native did not allow more than one run in each of his first three professional starts. However, he surrendered four runs on six hits in 1.2 frames on May 25 against Kannapolis, which turned out to be his final outing before he underwent Tommy John Surgery.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Had he not decided to turn pro, Garrett had signed to pitch at Vanderbilt University.
