**CORNWELL, LLOYD LEAD CARDS TO SHUTOUT OF TULSA:** Alex Cornwell fired 8.0 scoreless innings and Matt Lloyd went 3-for-4 with 4 RBIs as the Cardinals won their 5th straight game with a 7-0 shutout of the Tulsa Drillers on Thursday night at Hammons Field. The shutout win for Springfield was its 8th of the season. **Cornwell's** 8.0 innings tied a career high and also tied a season high for the Cards; **Max Rajcic** went also went 8.0 on July 4 at Hammons Field vs NW Arkansas. **Lloyd's** RBIs came on a 2-run homer and 2-run double. **Chris Rotondo** added a two-run shot for Springfield, who has won 8 of its last 9.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Orlando Ortiz-Mayr** makes his 21st start (23rd appearance) of the season for the Drillers...Did not factor in the decision in his last start, allowing just 1 R on 5 H with 5 K over 6.0 IP at ONEOK Field against Midland...Over his last 7 appearances (5 starts) since July 5 has gone 4-2 with a 2.48 ERA with a .205 BAA after compiling a 3-4 record with a 6.12 ERA and a .284 BAA while allowing 13 HR over his first 15 starts of the season...In 4 starts against the Cardinals this season is 2-2 with an 8.15 ERA and has allowed 4 HR in 17.2 IP...Got the win in his last start against Springfield at ONEOK Field on July 30 allowing just 1 R on 3 H over 7.0 IP...Has allowed a league-high 17 HR this season...Made 13 appearances (11 starts) for Tulsa last season and went 3-8 with a 5.79 ERA...Began 2023 with High-A Great Lakes and went 2-4 with a 6.79 ERA over 14 appearances...Spent all of 2022 with Low-A Rancho Cucamonga going 2-4 with a 6.79 ERA...Signed by the Dodgers in 2021 as an undrafted free agent out of Troy...Born in Rio Piedras, Puerto Rico...26 years old

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

## CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**ON PAGE...:** With 68 wins through their first 117 games, the Cardinals are on pace for 79 wins in 2024, which would eclipse the franchise record for wins in a season. The current record is 77 wins which has been achieved twice: 2017 (77-63) and the Texas League title year of 2012 (77-61).

**LONG, HOT SUMMER:** Since the beginning of July, no team in Double-A has won more games than the Springfield Cardinals. The Cards are 29-13 since July 1, tied with the Portland Sea Dogs for the best record in Double-A during that time. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 4-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .278. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.99, which is 4th-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

**CARDIAC CARDS:** Over their last 9 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 6 of their last 9 games, Springfield is 7-1 during that time. The Cards scored 32 of their 63 (51%) runs in the 7th inning or later, and have outscored their opponents 27-8 in the 8th inning or later.

**POWER SURGE:** After getting off to a slow start in the power category to start the 2024 season, the Cardinals have already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 46 longballs in 48 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 66 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest SLG (.353) and OPS (.765) and has scored 20 more runs (264) than any other club in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half.

**TORRES BRINGS HOME TLPOW HONORS:** For his performance last week in Frisco, Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the first time this season. Torres is the 2nd Cardinal to win the award this season; **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the week of April 15-21. **Cooper Hjerpe** earned Texas League Pitcher of the Week for June 17-23.

**Torres** had himself a week, batting .609 (14-for-23) with 2 2B, 4 RBIs and 8 runs scored against the RoughRiders. He added 3 BB and 2 SB and had a .654 OBP. Despite going 0-for-8 over his last 2 games, **Torres** is 21-for-45 (.467) over his last 10 games.

**TALE OF TWO HALVES:** The 2024 campaign has been a tale of two seasons for Cardinals OF **Chris Rotondo**. He broke camp with Springfield but struggled to the tune of a .121 batting average in 24 games before being sent to High-A Peoria. **Rotondo** played well in 41 games for the Cheifs (.285, 4 HR) and after earning a promotion back to Double-A on July 30 has done nothing but hit. In 19 games since returning to the Texas League, **Rotondo** is batting .310 with 4 2B, a triple, 2 HR and 9 RBIs while sporting an .861 OPS.

**CROOKS CATCHING FIRE:** Over his last 40 games dating back to June 23, the final day of the 1st half, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Eules, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .366 average, 10 HR and 38 RBIs and is slugging a league-high .634 and with a 1.061 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, **Crooks** batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS. He has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games and is batting .414 (24-for-66) with 4 HR and 18 RBIs over 15 games in August.

**KING OF THE "K":** Cardinals LHP **Quinn Mathews** has been racking up the strikeouts through his 3 levels in his first full season. The Stanford product leads all of MiLB in whiffs with 168 in 119.0 IP over 21 starts this season. **Mathews** leads **Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson** of the Cleveland organization who has struck out 164 in 107.2 IP with Low-A Lynchburg and High-A Lake County.

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 22-for-22 and his 45 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 22 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 22.0 IP (0.41 ERA) and is 12-for-12 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one unearned run over his last 18 appearances, allowing just 11 H with 14 K over 21.0 IP. The Cardinals are 48-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
