



# 2026 NASHVILLE SOUNDS POLICIES

## HIT CITY HALL

### Buffet

Starts when gates open and will last for two (2) hours. At the picnic end time, all food and non-alcoholic beverages will be removed from the picnic area due to local food safety regulations. If you purchase a keg of beer, that will be removed at the start of the 7th inning or when it runs out, whichever happens first.

### Picnic Menu

Hamburgers, Hot Dogs, Mac N Cheese, Potato Chips, Coleslaw, Cookies, Soda, and Ice Water. Vegetarian options are available upon request and must be communicated to your Sounds representative prior to your event.

### Ticket Information

All tickets are digital, and fans can enter the ballpark using their mobile device. You can visit [milb.com/Nashville/tickets/mobiletickets](http://milb.com/Nashville/tickets/mobiletickets) for additional help on how to access your tickets and how to transfer them to guests. Each guest will need their own ticket on their device. Screenshots of tickets will not work, so please make sure you transfer tickets to each guest in advance of the game.

### Guest Arrival

Guests will show their ticket upon arrival to the group location. Each guest will receive a wristband to come and go from the area throughout the game. Anyone without a wristband will not be permitted at the picnic/buffet areas. All guests will have access to Hit City Hall during the whole game.

### Rain Policy

If the game is rained out **prior** to gates opening, the entire group event can be rescheduled for another date (based on availability). If the game is rained out **after** gates are open, and the game becomes official, there are no refunds or exchanges. In the case that gates open, but the game does not become official, the tickets can be moved to an equal or lesser value ticket for a new game, but food and beverage is not refundable or exchangeable, since food and beverage is served. ### Rain Policy (cont.)

In the event of inclement weather impacting a scheduled game, our catering team will make every effort to fulfill picnic services as planned. However, if a group elects to delay the start time of their picnic, fulfillment beyond the originally scheduled time cannot be guaranteed. Adjustments due to weather-related game postponements may limit our ability to provide service outside the confirmed time frame.

### Parking Information

Pricing around First Horizon Park can vary from \$15.00 per vehicle to higher. We recommend that fans park in the parking garage located on the corner of Rep. John Lewis Way & Harrison Street. To purchase garage passes in advance please contact your Nashville Sounds Representative.

### Bag Policy

A clear bag policy is in place for every event at First Horizon Park. The policy permits clear bags no larger than 12" x 12" x 6" in size. Small, single compartment clutches no larger than 5" x 9" are allowed into the ballpark. Any bag exceeding that size will need to be a clear bag. Exceptions include medical bags and diaper bags for guests accompanied by infant(s). This policy applies to goodie bags for birthdays and corporate outings.

### Birthday Parties; Gifts & Presents; Group Goodie Bags

To comply with our fan safety & ballpark security procedures, wrapped packages, gift bags, etc. will not be allowed into First Horizon Park.
