WEIRD WEEK: After being shut out on Tuesday and Thursday and scoring a season-high 16 runs on Wednesday, the Frednats will try to bounce back once again tonight on Firework Friday. Jarlin Susana makes his third start of the year tonight and second at home after he pitched three scoreless innings on opening night. Despite the two shutouts this week, the FredNats still comfortably lead the league in runs scored with 88. In a scheduling quirk, this is Fayetteville's first-ever trip to Fredericksburg since VACU Stadium opened in 2021. Fredericksburg has only traveled to Fayetteville the last two seasons, but this week marks the only meeting in the 2024 regular season for the two clubs that share the spring training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. The Woodpeckers are the final team to visit Fredericksburg, meaning all 11 of the other current Carolina League clubs have now played in this ballpark.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats were held to just two hits in a 4-0 shutout loss to Fayetteville, the second time in three days the Woodpeckers have shut down this high-powered offense that continues to lead the Carolina League in runs scored. Jose Atencio pitched well in his first start of the season, allowing two runs in five innings. Kevin Rodriguez and Samuel Vasquez each had shutout bullpen appearances.

HISTORIC DAY: In Wednesday's game, Phillip Glasser joined some rare air with his four hits, four RBIs and three stolen bases. The last time a hitter accomplished that in a single Major League Baseball game was when Joe Carter did it with the Cleveland Indians in 1986. Glasser is also just the fourth Minor League player at any level since 2005 to have four hits, four RBIs and three stolen bases in a single game.

BACK END BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the more solid units on the team. In 53.1 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the team ERA is 3.04, a much better number than the group had at this time last year. The Freddie's are also 2/2 in save opportunities (both by Thomas Schultz), and the team is 6-0 when holding a lead after both seven and eight innings this year.

SOLID STARTS: The FredNats have several hitters near the top of the Carolina League leaderboards through the first 12 games of the season. Brandon Pimentel leads the league in RBI (16), and he and Gavin Dugas are tied for the league lead in XBH (7). Dugas also leads the league in batting average (.419) and doubles (7), and Phillip Glasser is 2nd in average (.405), and hits (15).

ANOTHER TO THE SHOW: Monday night, 2021 FredNat Mitchell Parker became the sixth FredNat to make his Major League debut since the team moved to FXBG in 2020. Parker got the win for the Nats on the mound against the powerful Los Angeles Dodgers, pitching five innings of two-run ball with four strikeouts. He joins Amos Willingham ('21), Jackson Rutledge ('21 & '22), Jose A. Ferrer ('22), Jacob Young ('22) and Trey Lipscomb ('22) as former FredNats to debut in the Major Leagues. All made their debuts with Washington.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 148-125 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Jarlin Susana is set to make his third start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a fading changeup and a sharp slider that will touch the low 90's.

EARLY-SEASON HIGHS: After an up-and-down April, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

LATE-SEASON LULL: Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

LAST TIME OUT: Susana got roughed up a bit in Lynchburg last week, scattering six base hits across three innings. He walked a man and hit one other, but overall limited the damage to three earned runs.
