(ALMOST) HALFWAY THERE: The FredNats finish the first half of the Carolina League season this week surrounded by the Blue Ridge Mountains in Salem. The two teams were unable to play the first game of the series yesterday because of unplayable wet field conditions, but they will play a doubleheader today to make up for May 3rd's rainout in Salem. These three games - two today and one tomorrow - are the final ones for the FredNats and Red Sox in the first half, with Friday's game marking the start of the second half campaign. The second half is a clean slate as the team with the best second half record will join the Lynchburg Hillcats in the Carolina League playoffs.

ON RAINBOW ROAD: This week's series continues Fredericksburg's first two-week road trip of the season, as the FredNats travel to Carilion Clinic Field at Salem Memorial Ballpark after a six-game set at Segra Stadium in Fayetteville. The first stop of the trip was very productive for the FredNats, who won four of six over the Woodpeckers to claim their first road series win of the season. Fredericksburg swept Fayetteville in a Sunday doubleheader, winning 2-1 and 8-4 to seal the series. Davian Garcia and the FredNats pitched seven innings of one-hit and one-run ball, scoring twice in the seventh to win game one and then piled on in game two, scoring in six of the seven innings.

CLOSE IS THE ONLY WAY: To start June, the FredNats played 10 straight games decided by two runs or fewer and have played 11 such games in the month as a whole. In total, well over half of Fredericksburg's games this season have been decided by two or fewer runs and the FredNats have played 25 one-run games with an 12-13 record.

FOR THE PEOPLES: Nick Peoples had by far his best week of the season in Fayetteville last week, posting some of the best numbers of any Carolina League hitter. The right fielder started all six games for the FredNats in Fayetteville, notching eight hits (second most in the Carolina League) in just 18 at-bats. Four of those hits went for extra bases, including the game-winning home run on Thursday, which left the bat at 115 miles per hour in an 0-2 count with two outs in the top of the ninth inning. His .444 batting average was the best among all Carolina League hitters who played over three games in the week and he also walked four times for a .565 on-base percentage.

HE'S BEEN UNHITTABLE: FredNat closer Robert Cranz extended his Carolina League lead with his seventh save of the season on Sunday, his second of the series and fifth in the last two weeks. Cranz currently has a 18.1 inning scoreless streak, which is tied for the longest active streak in the Carolina League and third-longest in Minor League Baseball with Jack Young from Kannapolis. The Oklahoma State product has not allowed a run since April 26 and has 29 strikeouts to only six walks in that span.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach has been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers this season. Bazzell ranks second among all MiLB catchers with 28 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 300 innings this year, throwing out 39% of would-be base stealers. Rombach has 19 caught stealings himself, a top-10 mark in the Carolina League, and is throwing out 34% of potential base stealers this year.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014.

NEW OWNERSHIP: On Monday, June 9, it was announced that the Silber family sold the majority stake in the Fredericksburg Nationals to Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH), becoming the 44th MiLB team DBH has purchased since its founding in 2021. The FredNats will remain the Nationals' Single-A affiliate in the Carolina League. Seth Silber has kept a minority ownership stake and will take on the President/CEO role overseeing day-to-day operations moving forward, and DBH has retained the entire front office staff.

THE STAFF: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

MEET HIM: Brayan David Romero...(pronounced: Bryan) was activated from the injured list and returned to Fredericksburg on 6/7 after completing a rehab assignment with the FCL Nationals.

NOT THE FIRST TIME: Romero is making his second stint with the FredNats after making seven regular season starts in FXBG last year. The righty posted a 5.52 ERA across 29.1 IP with 13 strikeouts to five walks. This is his third season in the Nationals organization.

LAST TIME OUT: Romero made his first of the season last week in Fayetteville, getting a no decision after 4.2 scoreless innings. The right allowed just two hits, walking three to two strikeouts. No Woodpecker reached scoring position after the second inning in an eventual 1-0 win.

FIRESTARTER: Romero started game one of the Carolina League Championship series in 2024 at Kannapolis. In an eventual FredNat win, he threw 4.1 innings, giving up three earned runs to the Cannon Ballers.

LUKE WARM: Lucas Emanuel Johnson...was promoted to FXBG on 6/18 to make his Single-A debut after starting 2025 in the FCL. The Nationals selected Johnson in the 10th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC).

PALM BALL: Johnson excelled in the Florida Complex League to begin his professional career this year. The righty made nine appearances and one start, posting a 1.17 ERA across 23.0 IP. He allowed only three earned runs, tallying 24 strikeouts to just six walks. He won the FCL's Pitcher of the Week award at the end of May.

GOLDEN RETRIEVER: Johnson pitched four seasons for the UMBC Retrievers, completing his career as UMBC's all-time program leader in strikeouts. He won the America East Pitcher of the Year award twice, becoming the only player in the award's 34-year history to win it outright twice. He posted a career 4.61 ERA in 288.2 IP with 279 K's. As a Junior in 2023, he had an ERA of 2.96 in just under 80 innings. His selection marked the first time a Retriever was selected in the MLB Draft since 2016.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
