✦ **HOMERIN' YAKS:** Salem's bats have come alive as of late. The RidgeYaks slugged 16 home runs during their 12-game road trip, and after **Louis Andujar** went yard in the ninth inning Friday night, Salem has now hit 17 home runs over its last 13 games. The RidgeYaks have homered in each of their last five games, launching nine long balls during that span. Salem's nine home runs since July 9 are tied with the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes for the most in Single-A over that stretch. The RidgeYaks' longest home run streak of the season came from April 10-18, when they homered in eight consecutive games

✦ **11 GAME SUCCESS:** Salem has won seven of its last 11 games dating back to July 2. Over that span, the RidgeYaks rank second in the Carolina League with a .294 batting average and lead all of Single-A baseball with 117 hits. Salem has also scored 85 runs during that stretch, the second-most in Single-A, while its 44 extra-base hits lead the Carolina League over the last 11 games

✦ **ANDUJAR BREAKS THROUGH:** After recording just one RBI, one stolen base, and batting .095 through his first 20 games in Single-A Salem, INF **Louis Andujar** has flipped it into gear over the last three weeks. Over his last 13 games since June 27, Andujar is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with 15 RBI, three homers, and a .995 OPS. Andujar has recorded a hit in 10 of his last 13 games after collecting hits in just five of his first 20 games

✦ **WELCOME TO SALEM:** Last night, catcher **Franklin Primera** made his home debut in Salem and put on a show. The young backstop went 4-for-4 with four runs scores. The four hits was just the third time in his career Primera has recorded four hits in a game, and just the second time this season a RidgeYak recorded four hits (Enddy Azocar, April 12, vs. Wilson)

✦ **FERMIN FINDING HIS WAYS:** **Anderson Fermin** is another Salem bat that's been on fire as of late. The outfielder from Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic, is hitting .533 (8-for-15) over his last six games since July 6, collecting seven RBI, three extra-base hits, and a team-leading 1.432 OPS during that span. The switch-hitter is back for his first full season of Single-A ball and has recorded a hit in each of his last four games

✦ **SALAZAR STAYING HOT:** Catcher **Kleyver Salazar** has recorded a hit in 12 of his last 16 games dating back to June 19. Over his last five games since July 6, he's batting an impressive .381 with five RBI and an .861 OPS. The recent surge comes after Salazar hit a season-best .281 across 13 games during the month of June

✦ **PINTO'S STREAK:** Infielder **Avinson Pinto** has reached base safely in each of his last 14 games dating back to June 23. During that stretch, Pinto is batting .314 (16-for-51) with six RBI, nine walks, and a team-leading .426 on-base percentage. Overall, since May 29, Pinto has reached base in 28 of his last 32 games played

✦ **GUZMAN GOES YARD AGAIN:** Catcher **Adonys Guzman** went yard three times over the roadtrip. Through 28 Single-A games, Guzman has recorded a hit in 21 contests. Over his last 11 games since June 24, he's batting a team best .364 (12-for-33) with seven extra-base hits, four home runs, 11 RBI, and a team leading 1.270 OPS since June 24

✦ **THE STRIKEOUT STAFF:** After 87 games this season, Salem pitchers have combined to strike out 891 batters, good for the most in the Carolina League and fifth-most in all of Single-A baseball. In total, Salem is averaging 10.24 strikeouts per game

✦ **MAGIC NUMBER TEN:** The pitching staff has struck out double-digit batters on 53 occasions this season (61% of all games), including 21 of the last 28 games since June 11

✦ **WALKER RETURNS:** Tonight, southpaw **Ethan Walker** gets the baseball as the starting pitcher. It marks the first time in 73 days that Walke takes the hill at Carilion Clinic Field. The Salem native hurled two innings in a losing decision (during his first ever pro start) on May 6 against Delmarva

✦ **COMEBACK KIDS:** Salem entered the ninth inning on Sunday against the Fireflies trailing 3-1, Salem entered play with a 0-44 record when trailing after nine innings, in fact, over the last two seasons Salem was 4-96 when trailing after eight innings. However, the Yaks tacked on a pair of runs in the top of the ninth and a five spot in the tenth inning to stun Columbia 8-4

✦ **COLUMBIA KID HITS FOR THE CYCLE:** OF **Skylar King** was born and raised in Columbia, South Carolina. With family in attendance, King hit for Salem's first cycle since Mike Floyd on August 28, 2005 at Winston-Salem. King did it in reverse order with a leadoff solo home run, triple in the second inning, double in the fifth inning and single to lead off the eighth inning. King finished his homecoming debut by going 4-for-6 with three RBI

✦ **STARTING STRONG:** Salem's success this season has often started on the mound. The RidgeYaks are 16-9 when their starting pitcher records at least 14 outs (4.2 innings). Over the 22 games of the second half, Salem is 4-1 when its starter pitches more than four innings

✦ **SCHEDULE OUTLOOK:** Salem's schedule becomes significantly more favorable in the second half. After facing the league's top four clubs, Fredericksburg, Charleston, Hickory, and Wilson, a combined 45 times during the first half (69% of games), the RidgeYaks will see those teams just six more times the rest of the season (all against Wilson, August 18-23). Salem will also play 12 of its next 14 games against South Division opponents and 26 of its final 44 contests against teams at or below .500 after facing only 20 such opponents in the first half

✦ **MULTI-HOMER GAMES:** On Sunday, **Ilan Fernandez** blasted two home runs marked the fifth time this season Salem has seen a multi-home run effort from a guy. Last season, Salem only had three players record multi-home run games through 130 games

WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

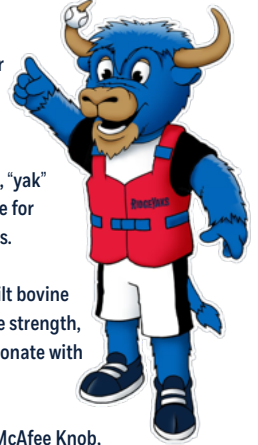
The name "**RidgeYaks**" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

Ridge: A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

Yak: The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named **Mac the Yak**, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Was born in Norfolk, Virginia, moved to Salem at a very young age, grew up in Salem. Originally attended Salem High School before transferring to IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida. His parents later moved to Richmond, Virginia
- Was selected in the 12th round (358th overall) of the 2025 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox out the University of Kentucky
- Started his college career at Longwood University (Farmville, VA, 107 miles east of Salem), where he earned Big South All-Freshman Team honors
- In 2023 was named to the Big South All-Freshman Team at Longwood, becoming the Lancers first ever selection to the All-Freshman Team in program history
- Transferred to the University of Kentucky for his junior season
- Alternated between starting and pitching in relief during all three college seasons
- In 2025 at Kentucky, posted a 2-1 record with a 4.08 ERA in 46.1 innings, appearing in 14 games including nine starts
- Began the 2025 season as Kentucky's Sunday starter but found a groove late in the year as a midweek starter and long reliever
- Makes his first Single-A appearance in 59 days after going on the injured list on May 16 with low back inflammation, missed over a month before he started his rehab assignment on June 26
- Pitched in two games in rehab with the FCL Red Sox, made one start, hurled 3.2 innings while allowing two earned runs and a 4.91 ERA to go with a 1.36 WHIP
- Hold's two nine strikeout games this season (4/10 vs Wilson and 4/30 @ Wilson)
- Last week at Columbia made the start and went three innings, striking out four off of 37 pitches
- Only his fourth professional start of his career tonight

- Reassigned to Single-A Salem on May 19 ahead of the six-game series in Hill City
- Made 16 appearances (11 starts) for Salem in 2025, posting a 3.88 ERA with 50 strikeouts across 67.1 innings while going 4-2
- Earned a promotion to High-A Greenville on July 25 and finished the season making his final seven appearances with the Drive
- Logged five or more innings in 10 of his 16 outings last season and worked at least six innings twice (June 18 vs. Fredericksburg and July 6 at Lynchburg)
- His 67.1 innings pitched ranked second on Salem last season behind Adam Bates (80.1 IP), while his four wins ranked third behind Griffin Kilander and Jay Allmer

- Enters his second season in the Red Sox organization after having his contract purchased from the Lake Country DockHounds of the independent American Association on April 30, 2025
- Opened the 2026 season on the High-A Greenville roster and also made one appearance with Double-A Portland before returning to Greenville on April 21
- Appeared in eight games with Greenville prior to being assigned to Salem on May 19
- Split the 2025 season between Salem and Greenville, combining to go 6-1 with four saves, a 53.2 innings pitched, and 30 strikeouts across 29 appearances
- Pitched in the Arizona Fall League with the Salt River Rafters, posting a 10.80 ERA and .211 batting average against over seven appearances while striking out three in five innings
- Went undrafted out of Seton Hall after recording a 2.73 ERA with 35 strikeouts across 29.1 innings in 25 relief appearances during his senior season

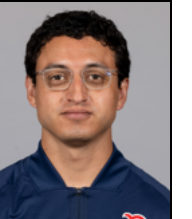

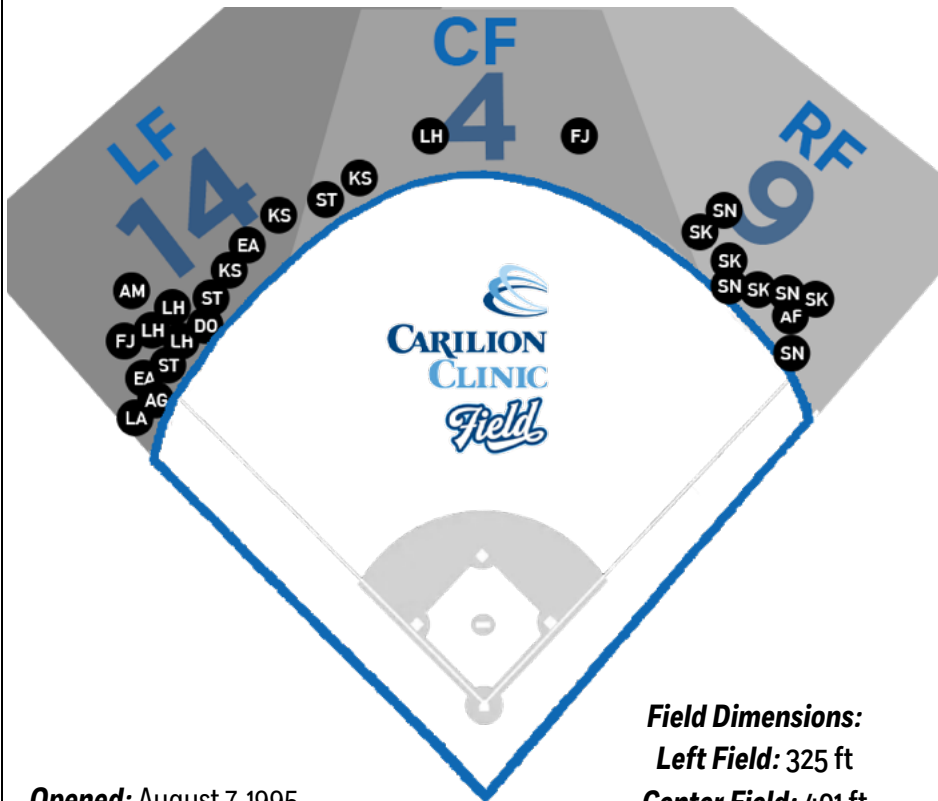

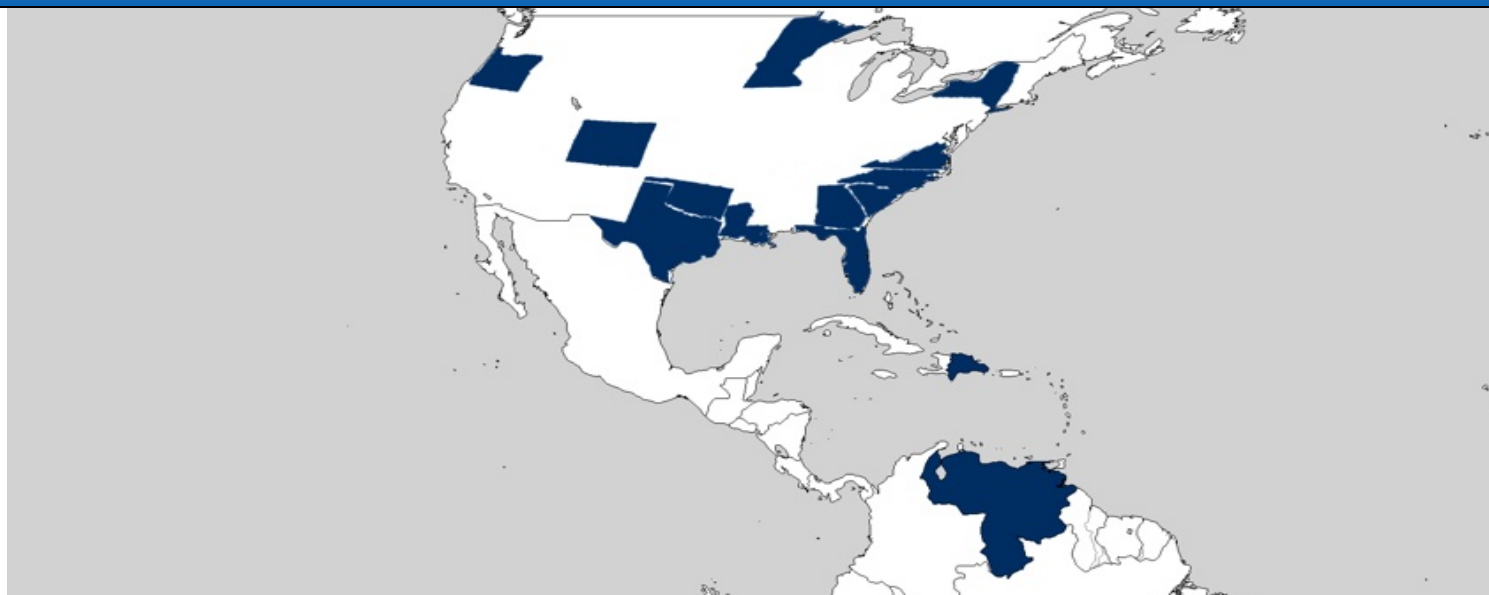
