## **COLUMBUS CLIPPERS CLINCH PLAYOFF BERTH !!!!!**


The 2024 Triple-A Baseball postseason is all set! On Wednesday, the Columbus Clippers clinched the International League's "Second Half" title, securing a trip to the playoffs.

After the regular season concludes this weekend in Toledo, the Clippers will travel west to Omaha for a best-of-three League Championship Series against the Storm Chasers beginning Tuesday.

If the Clippers prevail in Omaha, it will be the franchise's 12<sup>th</sup> International League championship. Omaha, which joined the IL in 2021, has never won the circuit's title.

The winner of the LCS in Omaha will earn the right to meet the Pacific Coast League champion in the one-game, winner-take-all Triple-A National Championship Game next Saturday in Las Vegas, live on MLB Network.

The Pacific Coast League Championship Series will take place in Sugar Land, Texas between the Reno Aces and Sugar Land Space Cowboys. Sugar Land won a division title in the franchise's first season in affiliated baseball in 2021 (no playoffs were held that season). Reno won its second PCL title in 2022 but was defeated in the National Championship Game by Durham.
