SMITH'S THREE-RUN BLAST GUIDES FRISCO TO WIN OVER TULSA:

Marcus Smith jolted a three-run home run to lift the Frisco RoughRiders to a 5-1 victory versus the Tulsa Drillers on Tuesday afternoon from Riders Field. The Riders (1-0, 39-30) struck first in the bottom of the second when Frainyer Chavez roped an RBI single to take a 1-0 lead. Smith's homer in the bottom of the seventh inning marked his first Double-A homer and expanded the RoughRiders lead to 5-0. In the top of the eighth, Drillers (0-1, 26-44) catcher Griffin Lockwood-Powell strolled an RBI single to cut Frisco's deficit to 5-1. Frisco reliever Ryan Lobus pitched a scoreless ninth inning to cap off the pitching staff's fifth one-run performance in the last eight games. Riders starter Ben Anderson (4-4) posted his second quality start of the season, pitching six shutout innings while striking out two on 85 pitches. Lobus and Larson Kindreich both worked a scoreless inning out of the bullpen. Drillers starter Patrick Copen (0-1) took the loss, allowing just one run while whiffing four over five frames.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES

RoughRiders starting pitchers are second in Double-A over the last 13 games with a 2.47 ERA. In addition to pitching well, they are also pitching deep into ballgames. They are averaging 5.1 innings per start, the most in the Texas League during that span and second in Double-A. **Josh Stephan** threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time in his career over the last two weeks while he and **Kohl Drake** threw back-to-back 7.0-inning starts for the first time since 2018 last week.

SECOND HALF, HERE WE COME:

The RoughRiders fell 0.5 games short of a playoff spot in the first half. After the Riders had a 1.5-game lead in the division on June 1st, they went 6-11 in their last 17 games before being eliminated on Saturday. Frisco last won the second half in 2022 before capturing the Texas League Title that same year.

OFFENSIVE WOES:

Frisco struggled in their series against San Antonio last week, hitting .228 (47-for-206)/.287/.325/.612 with only 15 runs scored, the second-fewest in the Texas League. Their 80 strikeouts were also the most last week in Minor League Baseball. Frisco went just 8-for-45 with runners in scoring position last week. On Wednesday, the Riders struck out 19 times, which is a franchise record for their most strikeouts in a nine-inning game. All three walk-off losses for Frisco have been at the hands of the Missions this season. On the two-week road trip, the Riders scored just 36 times (3.0 per game).

POWER OUTAGE:

After homering 15 times in their previous 12 games, the Riders have homered just five times in their last 13 games. Frisco has hit just four home runs in their 12-game road trip. They were 6-6 in those games because of a 2.45 ERA on the pitching side, which is second in the league. Their four home runs allowed in the last 13 games are tied for the fewest in the league.

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (six) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for third in the Texas League. Their 23 saves are tied for the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball, just trailing Triple-A Jacksonville's 25. Their 4.13 bullpen ERA is fourth in the league. In June, their 3.04 reliever ERA is third in the Texas League.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 35 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .257/.348/.449/.797 with eight doubles, 20 RBIs, 20 runs scored and 19 walks to 30 strikeouts. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.5 percent, a career low. His 16 doubles lead the league and his 24 extra-base hits are second in the league. In his last 11 games, he is hitting just .220 (9-for-41)/.313/.220/.533 with no extra-base hits, six walks, 13 strikeouts.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .285 (51-for-179)/.394/.441/.835 over his last 49 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (45) and is fifth in OBP (.392) while leading the league in walk rate (17.6 percent). In his last 23 games, he is hitting .272 (25-for-92)/.350/.413/.763 with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs. In his Frisco career, he has earned 201 walks over four seasons (302 games), which is second in franchise history. He is just six walks away from tying the franchise record for walks, held by **Guilder Rodriguez** with 206 from 2009-2015 (527 games).

ABOUT KOHL

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins.

2025 SEASON

-Entered 2025 as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

-Tied a career high with 10 strikeouts in third start against Corpus Christi on April 23rd.

-On May 7th at San Antonio, threw 6.0 innings of no-hit baseball, at one point retiring 16 batters in a row. **Ryan Lobus** and **Skylar Hales** then finished out the sixth no-hitter in RoughRiders franchise history.

2024 SEASON

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

-In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

2023 SEASON

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, $6.86\,\mathrm{ERA}$ (33 ER/46.2 IP), and $55\,\mathrm{strikeouts}$ (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
