The 21 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most in franchise history, only trailing Dylan Busby who racked up 22 in 2019 who also led the league in the category. > THEY SHOULD COME IN PAIRS: Jhonny Severino and Esmerlyn Valdez each belted a pair of home runs in an 8-6 Bradenton victory on Wednesday night. They became the first Marauders duo since 2021 to mash two home runs or more in a single game. Jase Bowen and Jack Herman each hit two on July 31, 2021 in a 13-10 victory at LECOM Park against the Dunedin Blue Jays.

> BEST FOR LAST: RHP Peyton Stumbo earned his fifth save of the season on Wednesday night after blanking the Tortugas in a career-high four innings while striking out a career-high seven. The seven strikeouts by a reliever are the second-most this year, only behind Carlos Jimenez who had eight.

> LOST AT SEA: After a 7-23 record on the road in the first half, the Marauders have an improved 13-19 mark in the second half. The .323 win percentage on the road is the third-worst in Minor League Baseball this season, with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (High-A, WAS) sporting a 18-44 record (.290) to lead the way.

> BOMBS AWAY: The Bradenton Marauders currently lead the Florida State League with 108 home runs on the season. The Clearwater Threshers are the next closest opponent, having blasted 100 of them. Last year, the Marauders finished second with 117, just behind the Tampa Tarpons who had 122. LECOM Park has also seen the most home runs in the league in 2024, 117, of which 65 of them have been hit by Bradenton.

> LET'S GO TO THE BEACH: This week, the Bradenton Marauders play their lone series of the year at Jackie Robinson Ballpark. Both sides haven't faced each other since April when the Tortugas took four out of six from the Marauders. Last year, the Marauders took five of six from Daytona on the road here.

A HISTORIC NIGHT: Last Tuesday against Tampa, Jhonny Severino went 4-for-4 at the plate and collected a single, a double, a triple, and a home run to become the first Marauders batter in franchise history to hit for the cycle. Severino has also been the only Marauder to record four or more hits in a game, last accomplishing that feat in early August in St. Lucie
