TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes open a six-game home stand against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). Tonight is a Healthy RC Recycle Tuesday, as fans can visit the website to learn how to score a FREE Club Seat Ticket for tonight's game. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 19th of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the seventh of 12 here at home. The Quakes have taken five of six in all three series so far against the 66ers, good for a 15-3 mark against the 66ers. In 2024, Rancho went 7-5 here at home vs Inland Empire, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: The Quakes mustered just two hits and fell to Visalia on Sunday afternoon by a final of 3-2 at Valley Strong Ballpark. Alexander Benua clubbed a tie-breaking homer in the bottom of the eighth against Rancho reliever Ryan Brown (1-3). Visalia's Alvin Guzman (1-0) earned the win in relief, while Jake Fitzgibbons earned his fourth save with a 1-2-3 ninth. The win for Visalia gives them two of three in the series, but the Quakes and Rawhide still split the home-and-home series, with each team taking two of three at home. The series-loss for Rancho is their first against the South this year, as they're now 7-1.

ROAD NOT SO FRIENDLY, LATELY: The Quakes have had a tough go of it recently on the road, as they've dropped seven of their last nine road games overall. The recent San Jose series finished poorly for Rancho, as they dropped decisions of 9-2, 12-4 and 20-2. With Friday night's 15-3 loss at Visalia, they had been outscored by 45 runs (56-11) over a four-game road losing streak. Sunday's loss in Visalia drops Rancho to just 23-22 on the road this year. **END OF JUNE:** The Quakes had a pretty inconsistent June and hope for a more stable month as the calendar turns to July. By record, June was Rancho's worst month at 11-14. The month of June literally started with game one of a sea son-worst eight-game losing streak, only to be followed by a season-high nine-game winning streak. As a team, they hit just .233 with an ERA of 5.55, easily their worst statistical months this season. Jaron Elkins had the best offensive month, hitting .316 with ten RBIs and 16 stolen bases in 23 games, but he didn't go deep all month. On the pitching side of things, reliever Cody Morse enjoyed a strong month, allowing just two earned runs over 12.1 innings.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a few roster moves over the last few days. LHP Myles Caba has been promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. C Angel Diaz has landed on the Injured List. Joining Rancho is LHP Justin Chambers from the ACL and C Carlos Avila, also from the ACL.

SAMUEL SANCHEZ: Right-hander Samuel Sanchez makes his seventh start and 11th appearance of 2025, as he'll face the 66ers for the third time, his second start against the 66ers. In two games against 1-0 and is unscored upon over eight innings, allowing just six h its. In his last appearance, he allowed a season-high seven runs on nine hits over just 3.1 innings in a loss to Visalia on July 2. Sanchez signed with the Dodgers in January of 2023 out of Venezuela and is ranked as the Dodgers 28th-best prospect, according to MLB Pipeline.

FRANCIS TEXIDO: Francis Texido makes his 17th start and his fourth against the Quakes. In three starts against the Quakes, he's 0-3, allowing 13 runs (11 earned) on 15 hits over 11.2 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed just one run on two hits over five innings, taking a no-decision at Lake Elsinore on July 2. Last year, Texido made 25 appearances (24 starts), going 4-7 with a 6.77 ERA for Inland Empire. Texido signed with the Angels in March of 2023 out of Havana, Cuba.
