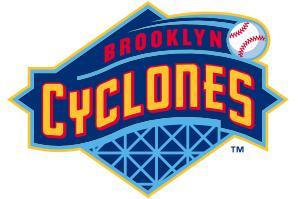

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn used a 9-run 2nd inning to help topple Wilmington, 11-7, on Thursday night...Cyclones scored 9 runs on 6 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate in the home 2nd...Trailing 1-0, Brooklyn tied it on a CF **Rhylan Thomas** single and took the lead on a bases-clearing, 3-run double from C **Drake Osborn**...DH **Stanley Consuegra** and 3B **Mateo Gil** capped the frame with a 2-run and 3-run home run, respectively...Cyclones added 2 more in the 3rd on a 2-RBI blast from SS **William Lugo**...Wilmington tallied 4 runs in the 9th to pull within 4...Consuegra and Gil registered multi-hit nights, while both, as well as Lugo and Osborn posted multi-RBI games...LF **Jared McKenzie**, 3B **Murphy Stehly**, and 1B **Branden Boissiere** composed multi-hit nights for Wilmington...RHP **Jordany Ventura** allowed 2 runs on 3 hits over 5.0 innings for his first Cyclones victory.

NINE TIMES! Brooklyn posted their best offensive inning of the season in the bottom of the 2nd on Thursday night vs. Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 9 runs on 6 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...8 of the 9 hitters in Brooklyn's lineup reached base safely in the 2nd inning...Brooklyn's previous season high came when they scored 6 times in the top of the 2nd on June 4 at Jersey Shore...The 9-run frame was the most by the Cyclones in a single frame since they scratched across 10 tallies in the top of the 6th on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green...Brooklyn went on to win that contest, 20-6...The 9-run inning was the largest for the Cyclones at home since an 8-tally bottom of the 7th on August 12, 2016, vs. West Virginia...Brooklyn won that affair, 14-7.

TURN IT UP TO ELEVEN: The Cyclones scored a season-high 11 runs in Thursday evening's rout of Wilmington...It marked the second time this season Brooklyn had registered double digits in runs scored with the previous high watermark coming in a 10-6 win at Jersey Shore on June 4...The 11-run outburst was the most for the 'Clones since they accrued 18 runs in an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Additionally, it was the most Brooklyn had scored at Maimonides Park since a 14-0 beatdown of Hudson Valley on May 19, 2021.

TOP OF THE CYCLONE: Brooklyn has won 14-of-19 (.737) and 20-of-28 (.714) going into Friday night...The Cyclones have won 5-consecutive series dating back to June 20-25 vs. Hudson Valley and have not dropped a set since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 19-8 in the second half and hold a 1.5-game lead in the North Division of the SAL over Aberdeen (17-9)...Brooklyn is a half-game ahead of Hickory (18-8) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

SUPER STAFF: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 2.94 ERA (174 ER in 533.0 IP) over their last 62 games, holding a 36-25 record in that span...The Cubs' Single-A Myrtle Beach (3.14) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 7 shutouts — which tied for 2nd-most in MiLB — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.8% and a walk rate of 11.5%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.621), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.86) in that time period...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (1.56) and **Tyler Stuart** (1.99) hold the 2nd and 3rd best ERA's in MiLB during that time (min. 60.0 IP).

RED HOT RELIEF: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.33) in the entire South Atlantic League and 3rd-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.12) leads MiLB, while Hudson Valley (3.46) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' bullpen is also 7th in batting average against (.214) and 9th in hits-per-9 innings (7.07).

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old hurled a quality start on Saturday at Hudson Valley and set a new career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 7 appearances (6 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 2-3 record, but a 3.82 ERA (13 ER in 30.2 IP), 12 walks (9.8 BB%), and 43 strikeouts (35.0 K%)....Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, to Cumaná, Venezuela native holds a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with 5 walks (7.7 BB%) and 24 strikeouts (36.9 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with an 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (231 K%).

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF **Rhylan Thomas** picked up a career-high 4 hits and scored a run on Tuesday, added an RBI on Wednesday and Thursday...He enters Friday on a 10-game hitting streak since July 8...Thomas is 16-for-35 (.457) at the plate with a 1.043 OPS, 7 runs scored, a home run, 6 RBI, 3 walks and a 190 wRC+...In 13 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is 19-for-46 (.413) at the dish with a .929 OPS and 157 wRC+, 7 runs scored, a home run, 8 RBI, and 4 walks to only 3 strikeouts...Among players with 50 or more plate appearances since the start of July, Thomas ranks 2nd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.388).

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF **Alex Ramírez** became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on July 21 at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B **Marcos Cabrera** of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Only two players in Major League history have accomplished the feat in the modern era (since 1901)...OF **Sammy Sosa** (Chicago-NL, 7/2/93 at Colorado) and OF **Max Carey** (Pittsburgh, 7/7/22 vs. New York-NL)... Since the start of June, Alex is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (34), 3rd in pitches-per-plate appearance (4,005), and tied for 5th in walks (25) (min. 190 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Friday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (76) and is 15 behind INF **José Perozo** (91) for the all-time mark and 4 behind INF **Luke Ritter** (80) for 2nd...He is 2nd in doubles (33) and total bases (206), 3rd in hits (141), and 4th in runs scored (74).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been scalding hot with the bat over the last few weeks... Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .286/.352/.538 with an .891 OPS and a 134 wRC+...In 24 games, Lugo is hitting .281 (27-96) with 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, 6 home runs, 23 RBI, and 9 walks (8.2 BB%) to only 16 strikeouts (14.5 K%)...In that time, the right-handed swinger has raised his batting average by 38 points (181 to .219)...Among SAL players, Lugo is 3rd in RBI (23), tied for 4th in home runs (6), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (13), 7th in total bases (53), and 10th in slugging percentage (.552) since that date.

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game homestand against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 6 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: LHP **Jake Bennett** (8), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (10), OF **Daylen Lile** (11), INF **T.J. White** (12), and RHP **Andry Lara** (15)...C **Israel Pineda** (19) is with the squad on a Minor League rehab assignment...Brooklyn and Wilmington are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd time in 2023...The Cyclones dropped 3-of-5 to the 'Rocks from April 18-23...The final game was postponed due to wet grounds...In the last meeting in Wilmington, Brooklyn won 5-of-6 contests from July 4-9...The Cyclones are 11-10 (.524) in 21 meetings against Wilmington in 2023...Overall, the 'Clones are 37-34 (.521) all-time against the Blue Rocks since their first meeting in 2021.

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn collected their 8th shutout win of the season with a 3-0 blanking of Wilmington on Wednesday...5 different pitchers combined on the 3-hit shutout...RHPs **Blade Tidwell** (5.0 IP), **Jace Beck** (1.0), **Brendan Hardy** (1.0), **Dylan Hall** (1.0), and LHP **Eli Ankeney** (1.0)...It was the Cyclones' first shutout since a 3-0 victory vs. Greensboro on July 15...Brooklyn has surpassed their shutout total from 2022 (7)...The last time Brooklyn accrued more than 8 shutouts in a season was when they tallied 10 in 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014.

CUTTING 'EM DOWN: With 4 strikeouts on July 20 at Hudson Valley, RHP **Blade Tidwell** set the Cyclones' single-season strikeout record (107)...The 22-year-old surpassed RHP **Junior Santos'** mark of 105 set in 2022...His 112 K's sit 4th overall in franchise history and is 1 behind RHP **Alec Kisena** (113) for 3rd...Tidwell has earned the win in 6 of his last 7 outings with Brooklyn winning all 7 games...He has permitted just 7 runs on 27 hits over 43.0 innings...He has walked only 13 (7.8 BB%) and struck out 52 (31.3 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after he tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 12 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 8-0 with a 1.56 ERA (11 ER in 63.1 IP) with just 37 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 33 and struck out 85 (33.2 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .167 batting average (37-221) against him...In that time, Tidwell is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League and is tied for 4th in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (85)...He is also 2nd in ERA (1.56) and batting average against (.167) since that date (min. 60.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (.190), 2nd in wins (8), 3rd in strikeouts (112), 4th in ERA (3.09), and 7th in innings pitched (81.2).

PARADA POWER: C **Kevin Parada** registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on July 15 vs. Greensboro, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif. native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair of multi-homer games in the same season...INF **Nick Evans** powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .301/.361/.524 with an .885 OPS and 137 wRC+ in 37 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 22 RBI, 11 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Friday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33), 6th in total bases (142), and tied for 6th in doubles (19) and hits (85)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), 6th in hits (43), and tied for 7th in total bases (75).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base last Friday night at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 34 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 104 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clase** (109), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (109), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (109), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (106), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (106) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 58 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 46.

THE .500 CLUB: With Brooklyn's victory on Thursday night, the Cyclones are a season-best 2 games over .500 on the season at 47-45...Prior to July 21's win at Hudson Valley, Brooklyn had not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season...The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 19th come-from-behind victory with a 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on Thursday...The Cyclones matched their largest comeback of the year on Sunday at Hudson Valley, erasing a 4-run, 4-0 deficit entering the 4th inning...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on July 4 vs. Wilmington and on Opening Day, April 7, vs. Jersey Shore...July 21 marked the 11th win in their final at-bat with an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley...It was also Brooklyn's second win in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...7 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Christian Scott** (9), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (16), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (24)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (20), RHP **José Butto** (25), RHP **Luis Moreno** (26), and OF **Rowley Jordan** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

COMEBACK TRAIL: Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
