ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The El Paso Chihuahuas hung on for a 4-3 victory over the Round Rock Express on Saturday night at Dell Diamond. El Paso scored first when CF Matthew Batten smacked a one-out solo home run in the first inning. The dinger was his seventh home run of the season. Round Rock CF Josh Smith got the offense going in bottom of the first with a leadoff single. LF Steele Walker doubled and, with nobody out, the Express had runners on second and third base. DH Willie Calhoun earned a sacrifice fly to score Smith and tie the game at one. Express C Meibrys Viloria received a one-out walk in the fourth inning before 3B Davis Wendzel belted a 359-foot home run to left field to give Round Rock a 3-1 advantage. El Paso battled back with two solo home runs in the seventh. C Luis Campusano hit the first of the inning while staring down a 3-0 count. 1B Aderlin Rodriguez hit the second and evened the score to three. The Chihuahuas reclaimed the lead in the eighth. SS C.J. Abrams doubled to score LF Shogo Akiyama and give El Paso a 4-3 lead. Chihuahuas RHP Tayler Scott came in and closed down the ninth to give El Paso a 4-3 victory.

ALEXY ON THE BUMP

Express RHP A.J. Alexy is set to start Sunday's series finale. He owns a 6.48 ERA (24 ER/33.1 IP) and has walked 24 while striking out 33 in eight starts this year for Round Rock. He earned his first Triple-A win in his last start at Sugar Land on May 17.

AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

The loss for Round Rock, combined with Oklahoma City's win over Sugar Land, puts the Express back in a tie for first place in the Pacific Coast League East Division. Round Rock has spent 33 days this season with at least a share of first place.

SCORELESS STREAK NO MORE

The Round Rock bullpen extended their scoreless inning streak to 14.0 frames in the seventh inning yesterday before it was broken up by a solo home run from El Paso C Luis Campusano. It was the first run scored off an E-Train reliever since Wednesday, May 18 when the team was in Sugar Land.

WINKLER GOING STRONG

RHP Dan Winkler threw a scoreless ninth inning last night and lowered his season ERA to 3.78. Winkler has appeared in 134 Minor League Baseball games going back as far as 2011. He sits at 491.0 innings for his MiLB career and has a career ERA of 3.39.

HUFF PLAYING WELL IN TEXAS

After terrorizing PCL pitchers for 19 games this year, C Sam Huff was recalled to the Texas Rangers on May 10. Huff has made the most of his opportunity. In five games, he has hit 7-for-16 (.438) at the plate with two RBI. He began the season on the Round Rock roster and slashed .260/.328/.481 to start the year. He also mashed seven home runs including a three-game stretch where he hit a combined four home runs from May 3-5 while playing against the Reno Aces.

ABS AT DELL DIAMOND

Friday night against El Paso was the Dell Diamond debut of ABS, also known as the Automated Ball-Strike system. ABS began being used throughout the Pacific Coast League on Tuesday, May 17 while Round Rock was facing the Sugar Land Space Cowboys. Home plate umpires will be relayed the ball or strike call through an earpiece. Those calls are determined by eight cameras located throughout Dell Diamond that locate whether or not the baseball touches the three-dimensional strike zone.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
