## LATE RUNS PUSH JACKSONVILLE TO 3-1 WIN

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were able to take a late lead and came away with a 3-1 win over the Memphis Redbirds Saturday night. With the game tied at one, Jacksonville (34-40) took the late lead in the top of the seventh. Marty Costes and Jonathan Guzman started the seventh with consecutive singles off Memphis (38-36) reliever Packy Naughton (L, 0-1). Xavier Edwards laid down a sacrifice advancing both runners to second and third. Javier Sanoja knocked a ground ball to first baseman Alfonso Rivas III but Costes was able to score the go-ahead run after a wild throw home. Guzman went to third on the wild throw and scored on a sac fly from Troy Johnston pushing the lead to 3-1.

## X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. Despite starting the season on the IL, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 14 of his first 19 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable eight multi-hit contests. In all, he is 24 -for-76, slashing $.316 / .366 / .408 / .774$ with five doubles, one triple, three RBls, four walks and six runs scored.

## LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6 -for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5 -foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 36 of his last 41 games, notching 18 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 58 -for- $163(.356 / .410 / .497 / .907)$ with 11 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 28 RBIs, 17 walks and 22 runs scored.

## STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed scoreless outings in six of the last 13 games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 16 runs, 14 earned, on 42 hits ( 7.2 H/9) in 52.2 innings for a 2.39 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 41 strikeouts against 20 walks during this stretch.

## FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 49 of Jacksonville's 74 games ( 66.2 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 31 of the club's last 43 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 24 of its last 34 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 22-27 (.449) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2 -for- $30(.067$ ) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 40 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 43 -for-his-last-135, slashing .319/.400/.652/1.052 with 10 doubles, 3B, 11 home runs, 30 RBls, 19 walks and 26 runs scored. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks T-11th in HR/ FB ( 26.9 percent). The 26 -year-old has has driven in at least one run in 20 of those 40 games.

## ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 14-25 (.359) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 20-15 (.571) road record is one of only eight winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 180 runs in 35 games ( 5.1 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (second-fewest in Triple-A) 149 runs in 39 games, 3.8 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 196 runs (13th-most) in 39 home games ( 5.0 per game) compared to 151 (T-fourth-fewest) on the road (4.3 per game).

## WALKIN' IN MEMPHIS

Jacksonville returns to Memphis for the first time since taking four-of-six from April 23-28. Since joining the International League in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have had a lot of success playing in the friendly confines of AutoZone Park. Since that inaugural 2021 Triple-A season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .287/.354/.475/.829 with 55 home runs, 232 RBIs at AutoZone Park. Those 55 homers since 2021 are the third-most in an opposing team's ballpark, trailing Durham Bulls Athletic Park (Durham, 60) and Truist Field (Charlotte, 58).
