RIDERS DROP SERIES FINALE, OVERALL SERIES AGAINST TRAVS:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped their series finale against the Arkansas Travelers 5-1 on Sunday afternoon from Dickey-Stephens Park. Arkansas (8-4, 43-38) struck first in the bottom of the first when Connor Charming clipped a two-run double and Lazaro Montes lined an RBI single, giving the Travelers a 3-0 lead. Charming then ripped a two-run single in the bottom of the second, extending the lead to 5-0. In the top of the seventh, Frisco (4-8, 42-38) answered when **Keith Jones II** stroled an RBI single, trimming Arkansas' lead 5-1. Travelers reliever Nick Davila then struck out **Abimelec Ortiz** with the bases loaded, ending the threat. Davila retired all seven Riders faced to secure the victory. Arkansas starter Marcelo Perez (2-0) notched the victory, pitching five shutout innings. Frisco starter **Trey Supak** (5-3) took the loss, allowing five runs across six innings but retiring 13 of his final 14 batters.

ARMS COME ALIVE:

In their last three games, Frisco allowed just eight runs on 17 total hits against Arkansas. Their 2.88 ERA is fourth in the league the last three games while their .187 opponent batting average is second.

EVERY DAY SHOULD BE BRATT-URDAY:

Starting pitcher Mitch Bratt has been one of the best in the Texas League this season and was dominant on Saturday against Arkansas, going six innings on one-run baseball. He is second in the league in ERA (2.55) while leading the league with 91 strikeouts this season. He is also sixth in innings (74.0), first in WHIP (1.08), first in strikeout rate (30.5 percent), first in walk rate (4.0 percent), second in left on base rate (83.1 percent) and first in swinging strike rate (14.0). Among full-season pitchers, his strikeout to walk ratio of 7.58 is third in all of Minor League Baseball.

SWIPE CITY:

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 12 of their last 13 games. Over those 13 games, they have stolen 25 total bases, which is second in the league to Wichita's 29. **Sebastian Walcott** is third in the league with seven steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is fourth with six.

MR. JONES AND ME:

In his Double-A debut on Tuesday, **Keith Jones II** hit his first career Double-A home run in his second at-bat and his dad was able to track the baseball down in left field! He also added an RBI single in the bottom of the 10th inning for his 18th multi-hit game of the season. In his first six games, he is hitting .240 (6-for-26) with a .749 OPS, a double, triple, home run and five RBIs. The 2024 draft pick out of New Mexico State hit .270/.406/.451/.857 with 10 home runs and 35 RBIs over 68 games with High-A Hub City before his promotion.

JUNE GLOOM:

The RoughRiders struggled in the month of June, going 10-15 overall. Their 3.4 runs per game in the month marked their single worst month in runs per game since June of 2019, when they scored just 3.1 runs per game (and went 6-18). Their 10-15 record was their worst month since they went 9-16 in May of 2023. On the positive side, the Riders owned a 3.96 ERA in June, which was sixth in the Texas League. Frisco played 10 one-run games in the month, going just 3-7 in those games.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league overall with 54. They also have just committed just 34 errors in their last 57 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 51 double plays turned since May 1st are also second in the league. Their 55 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball. Against the best stolen base team in the league in Arkansas, Frisco allowed seven stolen bases over the six games, below the Travelers' season-average of 11 per series.

SAVE TONIGHT:

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (seven) for the Riders, a mark that is tied for fourth in the Texas League. Their 25 saves are tied for the second-most in Double-A. Their 4.12 bullpen ERA is sixth in the league. In June, their 3.62 reliever ERA was fourth in the Texas League. In July, their 2.63 bullpen ERA is second in the league.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239. but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.7 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 130 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22).

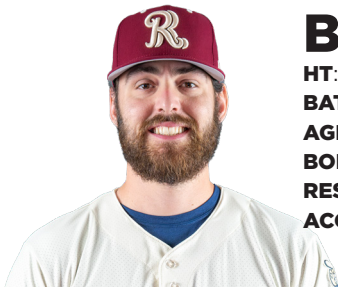

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

-Finished May with a 3-0 record and 1.37 ERA over 5G/4GS, 26.1 IP, 21 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 12 BB, 11 K. His 1.37 ERA was second among Texas League starters with at least four games started.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.
