Lake County starters have pounded the strike zone in 2024. leading MiLB (Single-A through Triple-A) with an average of 2.25 walks per 9 innings. Captains starters have also won 23 games, the most in MiLB.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: 3B Jose Devers, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, hit a go-ahead home run in the bottom of the 7th inning to guide Lake County to a 1-0 victory in the series opener versus Fort Wayne.

RHP Austin Peterson, RHP Jake Miller (3-2), RHP Jay Driver, and RHP Zane Morehouse combined for Lake County's 6th shutout of 2024.

Peterson pitched 5.2 shutout innings, striking out 6 in his 12th start. Miller earned the win in relief, tossing 1.1 scoreless frames.

After Miller pitched the final out of the 6th and then a scoreless 7th, **Devers** blasted his 5th home run of the season on an 0-2, 2-out pitch.

Driver blanked the TinCaps in the 8th for his 13th-straight scoreless outing, and Morehouse entered to close out the 9th. Fort Wayne SS Jay Beshears reached on an error, C Ethan Salas walked, LF Alain Camou sac bunted them over, and 2B Anthony Vilar was intentionally walked. With the bases loaded, 2B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, SS Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, and 1B Maick Collado turned a game-ending double play for Morehouse's 5th save.

SHUTOUT SHOW: Tuesday marked Lake County's 6th shutout in its 1st 58 games of the season. It marks the most through Lake County's 1st 58 games since they posted 8 shutouts in 2008.

HEY DRIVER: RHP Jay Driver pitched 1 shutout inning Tuesday to extend his scoreless appearance streak to 13 games, the longest in the MWL this season, and tied for the 3rd-longest active streak in Mil.B. Driver has tossed 16.1 consecutive scoreless innings during this span.

PROSPECTING: Captains INF Angel Genao was ranked Baseball America's No. 65 overall prospect on their updated Top 100 Prospects list. Other Cleveland minor leaguers on the list: OF Chase DeLauter (#31, Double-A), 1B Kyle Manzardo (#61, MLB), OF Jaison Chourio (#82, Single-A), and 1B Ralphy Velazquez (#85, Single-A).

LAKE COUNTY-FORT WAYNE CONNECTIONS: Lake County Acting Pitching Coach Shane McCarthy pitched in the Cleveland organization from 2018-23, going 4-3 with a 4.14 ERA in 11 starts for Lake County in 2019. Fort Wayne manager Mike Daly worked in the Cleveland Baseball Operations Department from 2000-01 and as an Area Scout from 2003-06. Lake County INF Alex Mooney and Fort Wayne INF Jay Beshears were 2023 college teammates at Duke and drafted 28 picks apart in the 6th and 7th rounds of the 2023 MLB Draft.

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,792 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,408-1,384 (.504).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last 4 campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

OH, OH, OH, IT'S MAGIC: <u>Lake County's magic number to clinch the</u> <u>Midwest League East First Half Division title is 5</u> with 8 games left in the 1st half. In 21 seasons, the Captains have won 8 First Half titles, most recently in 2019.

PARKER MESSICK NAMED TO TEAM OF THE WEEK: For the 2nd time in the last 3 weeks, LHP Parker Messick was named to MLB Pipeline's MiLB Prospect Team of the Week, being recognized as the top left-handed starting pitcher in Minor League Baseball during the week of 6/3-6/9. On June 6 at Beloit, Messick struck out professional high-tying 11 batters in 5.2 shufout frames, his most since 8/9/2023 versus South Bend.

WELCOME TO RAKE COUNTY: Through 58 games, the Captains have scored 304 runs, their most through 58 games since 2007 (330). <u>Lake</u>
<u>County leads the Midwest League in batting average (.264)</u>, hits (510), and OBP (.356).

TO THE MOON: Through 57 team games, INF Alex Mooney has recorded 19 stolen bases, 31 RBI, and 38 runs scored. <u>The 4 Midwest League</u> players to do this since at least 2005 are: Mooney (2024), Henry Bolte (LAN, 2024), Byron Buxton (CR, 2013), and Mike Trout (CR, 2010).

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson has struck out 8+ batters in each of his first 3 High-A starts. Wilkinson leads MiLB with 96 strikeouts in 55.1 innings, which amounts to an astounding 1.74 strikeouts per inning. For comparison, RHP Dwight "Doc" Gooden set the Minor League single-season record with 300 strikeouts in 191 innings for the Lynchburg Mets in 1983, which makes for an average of 1.57 strikeouts per inning.

NO SURRENDER: The Captains own 3 of the top 4 spots on the Midwest League batting average leaderboard. INF Nate Furman (.338, T-1st), 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus (.338, T-1st), and OF Guy Lipscomb (.324, 4th) are Lake County's 3 qualified hitters batting over .300. INF Alex Mooney (.291, 15th), also ranks in top-15. Additionally, C Cooper Ingle's .328 AVG ranks 6th among MWL hitters with 120+ ABs this season.

TOP QUALITY: Through 58 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 18 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are tied for the 3rd-most in High-A, and tied for the 9th-most in Mil.B. RHPs Austin Peterson (6), Carter Spivey (5), Trenton Denholm (4), and LHP Parker Messick (3), MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, have all recorded quality starts for the Capitains this year.

CAN'T START A FIRE WITHOUT A SPARK: The Lake County starting rotation is among the best in the Midwest League, leading the MWL in wins (23), innings pitched (292.1), strikeouts (300), and WHIP (1.19, tied for 1st) while ranking 2nd in fewest walks (73). Captains starters have only walked 2.25 batters per 9 innings, the lowest rate in MiLB (Single-A through Triple-A).

HE COULD THROW THAT SPEEDBALL BY YOU: RHP Austin Peterson is the only pitcher in Minor and Major League Baseball to have 70+ strikeouts and 6-or-fewer walks in 2024. The right-hander leads the Midwest League in strikeouts (77), quality starts (6), innings pitched (70.1), and WHIP (0.90), while ranking 2nd in ERA (2.69).

LAST TIME OUT: For the 2nd time in the last 3 weeks, Parker Messick (4-4) was named to MLB Pipeline's MiLB Prospect Team of the Week after picking up the win in Game 1 of the June 6 doubleheader at Beloit. Messick fanned 11 batters in 5.2 shutout innings, tving a Minor League best first set on 8/9/2023 vs. South Bend. The former Florida State Seminole allowed just 4 hits and hit a batter, throwing 61 of 94 pitches for strikes (64.9%) in the 4-0 win.

MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Messick ranks 2nd in the Midwest League in strikeouts (69), 2nd in swinging strike percentage (15.4%), 4th in innings pitched (57.1), 7th in ERA (3.30) and 7th in WHIP (.233). Since his High-A debut on 6/29/2023 vs. Fort Wayne, Messick's 144 strikeouts are the most at the High-A level.

TEAM OF THE WEEK: Messick has been recognized as MiLB's top LHP twice in 2024, 1st for his performance on May 24 against West Michigan and next for his most recent start on June 6 at Beloit. Messick is 2-0 with zero earned runs allowed, 6 hits allowed, 21 strikeouts and 1 walk in those starts.

OPENING DAY STARTER: Messick was Lake County's 2024 Opening Day starter, getting the ball for Game 1 of a doubleheader against the West Michigan Whitecaps on April 6. This marked his 4th consecutive Opening Day start across Minor League and collegiate baseball. The left-hander was the 2023 Opening Day starter for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats, and served the same role for the Florida State Seminoles in both 2021 and 2022.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Messick is Cleveland's No. 21 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Per Baseball America, "He throws from a low release point, which helps him get swings and misses on his fastball. His tumbling changeup is his best pitch and gives him a strong weapon against right-handed hitters."

2023 IN REVIEW: Messick started his first career 13 games with Single-A Lynchburg from April 7 to June 10 before starting 11 of 13 games with High-A Lake County from June 29 to September 9. Messick finished second in the Cleveland player development system with 136 strikeouts and a 3.77 ERA. In his final seven starts for the Captains, he posted a 2.52 ERA, 48 strikeouts, 12 walks and a .211 opposing average in 35.2 innings of work.

FLORIDA STATE PHENOM: Messick had a stellar college career at Florida State. In 2020, as a true freshman, he was named a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American. Then, in 2021, as a redshirt freshman, **Messick** became just the second-ever player to be named ACC Pitcher & Freshman of the Year in the same season. He was also named a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, as he finished with a .225 batting average, 9 hits, one home run, and 5 RBI on the season as a hitter. Messick's 2021 performance led to him being named a 3rd Team All-American by four different publications, as well as pitching for the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Finally, in 2022, he led Florida State with 144 strikeouts, as he was the only ACC pitcher named a finalist for both the 2022 Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy. Messick was also named a 2022 1st Team NCBWA All-American. When his collegiate career ended, Messick was FSU's all-time leader with a 6.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

4 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut at home for the Cleveland Guardians against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut at home for the San Francisco Giants against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut at home for the Cleveland Guardians against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
