Tonight's Game: The finale of the short three game series is tonight at Louisville Slugger Field, with the first pitch scheduled for 5:05 p.m. CDT. Nashville sends Milwaukee's No. 7 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Robert Gasser to the hill against Louisville right-hander Brett Kennedy.

Robert Gasser: 24-year-old Robert Gasser starts for Nashville. The left-hander is 5-1 with a 3.94 ERA (80.0 IP/35 ER) in 16 appearances (15 starts). The southpaw had an extremely brief start last time out, throwing just one pitch vs. Columbus on July 7. It was the first one pitch start in the full-season minor leagues since May 20, 2021, when Brett Kennedy did it for El Paso. Toted as the No. 7 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB Pipeline, Gasser leads the International League in strikeouts with 95. He also ranks among league leaders in opponent batting average (2nd, .220), WHIP (3rd, 1.23), ERA (4th) and innings pitched (10th). He was named the Milwaukee Brewers' Minor League Co-Pitcher of the Month for June. A California native, Gasser was acquired by the Brewers in the trade that sent LHP Josh Hader to the Padres on August 1, 2022. He was taken by San Diego in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Houston.

Brett Kennedy: 28-year-old Brett Kennedy makes his 10th appearance (9th start) for Louisville tonight. The right-hander is 3-2 with a 3.40 ERA (47.2 IP/18 ER) this season for Louisville. Kennedy is coming off a win out of the bullpen, allowing just one hit over 4.0 innings on July 9 at Toledo. On July 4, he was selected to Cincinnati and made the start that night in Washington. It was his first MLB game since September 7, 2018 for San Diego. Kennedy started the campaign with the Long Island Ducks of the independent Atlantic League, where he posted a 3.03 ERA (32.2 IP/11 ER) in six starts before his contract was purchased by Cincinnati on May 13. He pitched for Long Island at the start of the 2022 season before signing with Boston and appearing for Double-A Portland (23 G) and Triple-A Worcester (2 G). The New Jersey native was originally selected by San Diego in the 11th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Fordham.

Pat Slugs the Bats: Infielder Patrick Dorrian built upon his two-homer performance on Friday by ripping two hits and driving in Nashville's sole run last night. In his career against Louisville (7 G), Dorrian is hitting .333 (9-for-27) with two doubles, four homers, eight RBI and a 1.252 OPS. Over his last nine games, Dorrian is batting .367 (11-for-30) with three homers, seven RBI, five runs, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.124 OPS.

The Bull on Parade: Infielder Abraham Toro reached four times in last night's loss, lining two singles and drawing two walks. It was the third such game by Toro this season. He, Andruw Monasterio (5x), Eddy Alvarez (5x), Jon Singleton (3x) and Alex Jackson (3x) are the only sounds to accomplish the feat three times so far in 2023.

Claudio Clamps: Reliever Alex Claudio entered last night's contest with the bases loaded and two outs in the eighth inning. After walking in a run, the southpaw induced a flyout to get out of the frame. Claudio has inherited 20 runners with Nashville this season, tied for ninth-most in the International League. He's stranded 75% of inherited runners, tied for eighth highest in the IL (min. 15 inherited runners).

Roster Moves: Today, INF Jahmai Jones was recalled by Milwaukee for the Brew Crew's afternoon contest in Cincinnati. Jones whacked a two-run homer and stole a base in his Nashville debut on Friday. OF Monte Harrison was reinstated to the Sounds active roster from the development list. Harrison last appeared for Nashville on June 11. He's batting .206 (27-for-131) in 39 games and leads all current Sounds with 11 stolen bases. Harrison has the hardest-hit ball by Nashville this season (116.2 mph, 5/3 at St. Paul) and has put six balls in play with an exit velocity over 110 mph this season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect (No. 17 in baseball), left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect, who is on the injured list, and newcomer right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 648-557 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Gasser turned in one of the most bizarre starts in recent history last time out, tossing one pitch on July 7 vs. Columbus before getting ejected from the contest. He hit Columbus leadoff man Brayan Rocchio with the offering. It was the shortest start in the full-season minor leagues this season and just one of 26 one-pitch starts in the full-season minors since 2005.

AGAINST OPPONENT: In Gasser's only start against Louisville on September 22, 2022, he spun 6.0 innings of one-run ball (1.50 ERA) in a win at Louisville Slugger Field. He allowed three hits, five walks and struck out eight.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career
- Did not allow a run in 4.0+ innings in first start of season against Memphis
- Was first Nashville starter to pitch into the sixth in a start this season with 5.1 frames on April 12
- Allowed a career-high three home runs on April 30 vs. Omaha - one each in the third, fourth and fifth innings
- After posting 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP/4 ER) over first three starts, had 6.52 ERA (29.0 IP/21 ER) in next six games
- Spun a 6.2-inning gem in a convincing win on May 19 at Durham...was the longest outing this season by a Sounds pitcher at the time
- Tossed 7.0 scoreless inning gem on June 1 at Charlotte with no walks and nine strikeouts... followed it up with a 7.0-inning complete game on June 7 at Jacksonville, his first career complete game
- In bizarre outing on July 7 vs. Columbus, ejected after throwing one pitch (HBP, Brayan Rocchio)... is currently sole one-pitch start in full-season minors in 2023 and only one by a Nashville starter since at least 2000.
- After walking 25 hitters in first eight appearances (5.92 per 9 IP, 14.7%), has issued just six free passes in last eight starts (1.29 per 9 IP, 3.4%)
- As of July 16, is the only starter in the minor leagues with 15 starts and a 0.00 ERA in the first inning... also has the lowest first-inning opponent batting average (.043) in minors (min. 12 starts)

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 7-12 with a 3.94 ERA in 27 starts between Nashville, Biloxi, and Fort Wayne...ranked fifth in Minor League Baseball with 172 strikeouts
- Recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts on 6/8 vs. Lake County
- Tossed 7.0 no-hit innings with 8 strikeouts at Lansing on June 19
- Traded from San Diego to Milwaukee along with Esteury Ruiz, Taylor Rogers and Dinelson Lamet for Josh Hader on August 1
