# RHP Casey Lawrence (0-1, 5.86) vs. LHP Mason Albright (NR)

**TODAY'S GAME**: Tacoma holds a 2-0 series lead after claiming a 6-3 come-from-behind victory last night after the Rainiers scored six unanswered runs ... Mason Albright is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes and make his Triple-A debut while Casey Lawrence is expected to start for the Rainiers.

**FIRST TWO**: The Isotopes have lost the first two games of a series for the third time on the year (also: at Sacramento, March 28-29 and at Sugar Land, April 8-9).

**HOME SWEET HOME?**: Albuquerque has dropped three-straight contests at home, a season-high (since May 3 vs. Salt Lake).

**TOVAR TIME:** In his fourth rehab game with the Isotopes Wednesday, Ezequiel Tovar went 1-for-5 with a strikeout ... Over four rehab games with Albuquerque this season, is 2-for-15 with a walk and five strikeouts.

ERROR 404: The Isotopes committed three errors last night, tied for the most on the season (four times) ... Albuquerque tallied 11 errors over the club's first 21 games. Since April 21 (19 games), the Isotopes have been charged with 23 miscues.

**RUNS SCORED**: The Isotopes have plated three runs or fewer in three of their last four games.

**XBH**: Albuquerque pitching limited the Rainiers to two extra-base hits last night, the fifth time in the last eight contests the club has held their opponent to two or fewer.

HITS ALLOWED: The Isotopes have permitted double-digit hits in two-straight games for the first time since April 29-May 1 (three games).

**TAKE YOUR BASE**: The Isotopes pitching staff allowed just two walks last night, tied for the fewest on the year (six times; last: May 13 vs. Tacoma).

**RISP**: Albuquerque has gone 2-for-16 with runners in scoring position over the first two games of the set.

**ISOTOPES RBI RECORD:** Sam Hilliard has 231 RBI with Albuquerque, second all-time in Isotopes history ... Jason Wood (2003-06, 08) holds the record with 328 RBI.

**BEHIND THE DISH**: Albuquerque catchers (**Braxton Fulford**, **Austin Nola** and **Ronaiker Palma**) have combined to slash .371/.422/.593 with 52 hits, 13 doubles, six homers and 23 RBI on the year, leading the PCL in hits, doubles, average, OBP and slugging percentage.

**SAM I AM:** Sam Hilliard singled and walked yesterday and has reached base in 29 of 30 games played on the year ... Five of his nine doubles have come in May (10 games) ... Has drew a walk in four of his last five contests.

 $\mbox{ON-BASE STREAK}:$  Sam Hilliards 24-game on-base streak from April 3-May 6 is still the longest in the PCL.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson doubled twice yesterday for the second time this year (also: April 17 vs. El Paso) ... Has a fourgame hit streak, slashing .538/.600/.769 with three doubles and two RBI. Drove in two runs for the third time this year (also: April 25 at Reno and April 10 at Sugar Land).

**BRAX**: Braxton Fulford produced his sixth multi-hit contest on the year last night and first April 11, the tail end of a five-game multi-hit streak ... Eleven of Fulford's 23 hits with Albuquerque this season have gone for extra bases ... Has a hit in 14 of his last 16 contests.

**KESTDADDY**: Keston Hiura doubled last night and has a hit in eight of nine games played in May ... During the month, is slashing .333/.389/.606 with a triple, double, two homers and four RBI after hitting .141 over his first 24 games.

**RIT**: Ryan Ritter recorded an RBI single last night, ending a three-game hitless streak ... Has four extra-base hits (one double and three homers) over his last 15 games.

**VEEN**: Zac Veen singled Tuesday, ending a two-game streak without reaching base ... Since being sent back down to Albuquerque April 24 (12 games), Veen is 14-for-52 with four doubles, one triple, one homer and five RBI.

**COOLING OFF?:** From April 10-30 (15 games), Warming Bernabel slashed .362/.403/.621 with nine doubles, two homers and 17 RBI ... Over his last 10 games, however, is 4-for-33 with one homer and four RBI.

**BOONIE:** Trevor Boone connected on his third clout with the lsotopes in 13 contest this season Sunday to tie the game in the eighth inning.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is T-6th in walks (26) ... Sam Hilliard is T-1st in triples (4) and T-5th in XBH (17).

**AVERAGE:** Albuquerque's .234 team batting average in May is tied for the second-lowest in the Pacific Coast League this month (lowest: Sacramento, .220).

## NUCLEI NOTES

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

**SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT**: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
