REDMOND'S RECORD-TYING BLAST LIFTS CARDINALS TO 7-6 WIN:

Chandler Redmond hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the 8th inning to give the Cardinals a one-run lead as Springfield came back from an early five-run deficit to defeat the Arkansas Travelers 7-6 on Tuesday night at Hammons Field. It was the 59th home run in **Redmond's** Springfield career, lifting him into a tie with **Xavier Scruggs** for the franchise career record. **RJ Yeager** also homered for the Cards, and **Jacob Buchberger** collected two hits. With a seventh-inning double **Nathan Church** extended his hitting streak to eight games.



OPPOSING STARTER:

Left-hander **Reid VanScoter** makes his fourth start of the season for the Travelers...Last pitched on Thursday, April 18 against the RoughRiders and got the win allowing just 1 R on 1 H with a strikeout and a walk over a season-high 6.0 IP...Surrendered 3 R on 6 H with 3 K in 4.1 IP against the Cardinals on Saturday, April 6 at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock...Did not factor in the decision, a 6-5 Springfield win...Went 10-6 with a 3.27 ERA in 25 starts in his first full season last year with High-A Everett...Racked up 157 K to just 35 BB in 143.1 IP...Finished the season tied for 7th in all MiLB in IP...Selected by the Mariners in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Coastal Carolina...2022 Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and named 2nd team All-American by Collegiate Baseball after going 9-4 with a 3.65 ERA, striking out 85 and allowing 84 hits in 88.2 IP...Went 2-1 with a 4.60 ERA in 12 appearances (31.1 IP) as a junior in 2021...Spent his first two collegiate seasons at Binghamton...Struck out 21 batters in a no-hitter in the section finals as a senior in high school, one of three no-hitters in his high school career...25 years old

CARDINALS, TRAVELERS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN FOUR WEEKS:

The Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) make their first of two trips this season to Hammons Field for a six-game series. The Cardinals swept a three-game series in North Little Rock to start the 2024 campaign and went 7-5 against the Travelers at home last season.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS OFF TO BEST 16-GAME START SINCE AT LEAST 2005:

With a 13-3 record over their first 15 games, the Cardinals are off to the Texas League's best 16-game start since at least 2005, before which the day-by-day standings are no longer kept..

TAKE ME TO CHURCH:

Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week after a big series in Amarillo. The UC Irvine product went 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB. Church leads the Texas league in hits (22) and RBIs (15), and also ranks in the top 10 in batting average, OBP, SLG, OPS, total bases, and runs scored. In 75 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just 5 times.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS:

With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on Tuesday night, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 204.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!:

Although Noah Mendlinger's 0-for-4 outing on Tuesday night snapped his 10-game hitting streak, there is a pair of Cardinals who are riding sizeable streaks. With a seventh-inning double on Tuesday night, **Nathan Church** extended his hitting streak to 8 games, and has hit safely in 14 of the 15 games he has played in so far this season. Jacob Buchberger's two-hit night Tuesday extended his hitting streak to six games.

TORRES ATOP OF LEADER BOARD IN HITTING, BAGS:

After going 1-for-3 on Friday night and leaving the game early with an apparent injury, Cardinals OF **Bryan Torres** is leads the Texas League in batting average among qualified hitters with a mark of .381. His 7 SB is tied for 3rd in the league lead behind Jakob Marsee of the San Antonio Missions and Emmanuel Rodriguez of the Wichita Wind Surge. **Torres** racked up 71 bags for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association in 2023. **Torres** also leads the league among active Texas League players in OBP after the promotion of Emmanuel Rodriguez from Wichita to Triple-A St. Paul at .462.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE:

Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 15 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .287 batting average, a mark that also leads all of Double-A; the Bowie Baysox are next with a .275 average. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.382), OPS (.798), RBIs (93) and runs scored (101). Springfield has also been particularly productive hitting situationally, with a league-high 10 sacrifice flies this season. The Cards' OBP is ahead of the next-best mark by 27 points (Tulsa Drillers, .355)

GRINDIN':

Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cardinals have struck out just 118 times in 16 games, the fewest in the Texas League, just one ahead of the Frisco RoughRiders. Springfield's total is the 4th-fewest total in MiLB, but the 2nd-fewest of clubs that have played 16 games, behind the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (High-A, Milwaukee Brewers) who have struck out 114 times. The Cards are averaging just 7.4 K's per game.

VICTIMS OF THE LONG BALL:

Despite an overall solid season so far in which the Cardinal pitching staff has posted a 4.09 ERA, the Birds have fallen victim to the home run ball early in the 2024 season. Springfield pitchers have allowed 20 HR so far this year, tied for the most in the Texas League with the Amarillo Sod Poodles.

FAMILIAR FACES:

Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, **Bryan Torres** (Richmond, 2021) and **Matt Lloyd** (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs.

Cardinals skipper **Jose Leger** is back for his fourth year as manager in Springfield.
