FRISCO WINS THIRD STRAIGHT, BEST NORTHWEST ARKANSAS 6-5: The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 6-5 on Wednesday evening from Arvest Ballpark. Northwest Arkansas (25-27, 60-61) opened the scoring against Frisco (30-23, 74-48) starter Winston Santos. After picking up the first two outs, the righty issued back-to-back walks before a two-run triple by Carter Jensen gave the Naturals their first lead of the series. **Abimelec Ortiz** led off the top of the second inning with a 421-foot blast to right against William Fleming, cutting the Northwest Arkansas lead to 2-1. In the top of the fourth inning, Frisco tied the game on an RBI groundout from **Aaron Zavala** that plated Ortiz. **Luis** Mieses launched his fourth homer of the season, a two-run shot that pushed the Riders ahead at 4-2. **Cooper Johnson** torched an RBI double to left in the top of the fifth inning, scoring **Cody Freeman** from first to make it a 5-2 game. In the home half of the fifth, Tyler Tolbert brought the Naturals back within a run on a two-run double. A balk and a wild pitch allowed Tolbert to cross the plate, evening the game at 5-5. Santos finished after 5.0 innings, surrendering five runs on six hits and three walks while striking out six. Alejandro Osuna gave the Riders the lead with an eighth inning RBI single, driving in Tucker Mitchell to give Frisco a 6-5 advan-tage. Dane Acker (5-4) worked 2.0 scoreless, on-hit frames before handing the ball to Jackson Kelley. The righty tossed 2.0 innings, allowing just one baserunner while striking out on his way to a six out save. The Riders collected 10 hits as Osuna and Johnson each poured in two hits.

#### ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 34 games, Ortiz is hitting .323/.419/.567/.986 with seven doubles, eight home runs, 23 RBIs, 25 runs scored and 20 walks. Ortiz has reached in 15 games in a row, batting .415 (22-for-53)/.537/.755/1.292 with three doubles, five home runs, 15 RBIs, 13 walks, 13 strikeouts and 15 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .304 with an .919 OPS, raising his batting average to .232 and a .714 OPS.

#### DOUBLE-A RON TAKING DOUBLE-A:

Aaron Zavala has been swinging the bat well as of late, hitting in eight games in a row. Over that streak, he is batting .414 (12-for-29)/.471/.483/.954 with two doubles and 11 RBIs. Over his last 24 games, he is hitting .282/.380/.353/.733 in August.

#### PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strenghth this season, but they have struggled over their last 14 games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit .282 (138-for-497) with 28 doubles, nine home runs and averaging 5.5 runs per game on the offensive side, taking seven of 14 games. Frisco's bullpen had a 6.68 ERA (45ER/60.2 IP) and has allowed 76 hits over 60.2 innings while blowing leads in five of their seven losses. The Riders lost back-to-back series for the first time all season before taking their last series against San Antonio. They are now 9-11 in their last 20 games, but 6-1 in their last seven games.

#### HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with Luis Mieses capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 15 home runs in the last 11 games, with those 15 home runs being second in the Texas League over the last 11 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 89 across their 121 games (on pace for 103, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

#### **RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:**

Over the last 32 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .742 OPS, second with a .260 batting average and are sixth with 4.7 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .217 (65-for-300) with runners in scoring position over their last 31 games.

#### HOME COOKING:

HOME COOKING: The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 40-22 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +69 run differential, a 4.12 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .763 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 34-26 with a 3.21 ERA, but a +27 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .644 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 13 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .314/.406/.543/.949 at home as opposed to .144/.214/.241/.455 on the road.

#### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

WERE GOING DANCING: The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Of-fensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

**ABOUT MITCH** 

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft.

-Committed to play baseball at Florida State

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and IT Realmuto.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com.

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-Dominated with Hickory while ahead in the count, allowing a .163 average and .240 slugging (as opposed to .298 average and .638 slugging when behind in the count).

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

#### **2023 SEASON**

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

#### 2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

#### **2021 SEASON**

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
