Tonight: The Lugnuts play the fifth game in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, the 11th meeting of 24 between the two Michigan-based High-A clubs this season. The Loons have won six of 10 games against the Lugnuts this year, with the two teams splitting the first four games of this series.

Michigan Baseball Hall of Fame: This evening marks the last of three consecutive Michigan Baseball Hall of Fame inductions. Tonight is the induction of the the Page Fence Giants, a legendary traveling black baseball team of 1895-1898 based out of Adrian, with the Lugnuts wearing the black and burgundy uniforms worn by the Giants in 1895. These uniforms will be auctioned off during and after the game to benefit the Hamtramck Stadium restoration. Last night saw the induction of the Class of 2020: Brighton H.S. great Drew Henson and the late Bob Miller, who pitched for the Phillies and coached at the University of Detroit. Thursday, the first of the ceremonies, saw the induction of longtime Greater Lansing baseball coach Javier Cavazos.

On the Air: Tonight's game is on Mil.B.TV and via streaming online audio at <a href="http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing">http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing</a>, with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call of the game.

Last Night: Loons 9, Lugnuts 3. Ryan Ward hit three-run homers in each of the first two innings, leading the Loons to the easy victory.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

# Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

A Saucy Debut: 2016-2017 Lugnuts left-hander Tayler Saucedo tossed a scoreless inning in relief for the Toronto Blue Jays Thursday night, becoming the 157th Nut to reach the Major Leagues all-time and the third this season (joining Josh Palacios and Ty Tice).

**Welcome Back:** Center fielder **Michael Guldberg** was back in the starting lineup today for the first time since May 29. The Athletics' third-round selection in 2020 from Georgia Tech is hitting .286/.346/.481 with six doubles, three homers and six stolen bases. He has reached base in 20 of the 21 games he has played.

Streaking: Center fielder Michael Guldberg enters tonight on a 19-game on-base streak. The Lugnuts' longest streak this season is 24 games, set by Max Schuemann from May 8-June 6.

Man of Steal: Infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) leads Minor League Baseball with 28 steals, three more than former Lugnut Tanner Kirwer, playing in Vancouver, and ten more than the Major League leader, Kansas City's Whit Merrifield. Schuemann is tied for second in the Minors with 12 HBPs and is second in the High-A Central with 33 runs scored.

Double Your Pleasure: The Lugnuts' offense tops the High-A Central with 84 doubles. Nine different hitters have notched at least six doubles.

**Alumni Report:** 2021 Lugnut **Jake Suddleson** went 1-for-3 last night for the Double-A Midland RockHounds. After opening 0-for-15 in Midland, Suddleson has six hits and a walk in his last 13 plate appearances. He had batted .284/.346/.526 with nine doubles, a triple and four homers before receiving a promotion to the RockHounds.

Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.66 earned run average with the second fewest walks in the league (126), third fewest home runs (28) and third most strikeouts (414).

Key to Success: When the Nuts outhit the opposition, they are 14-1 this season. When they get outhit, they are 2-19.

# **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

**2016:** Ryan Hissey's game-winning RBI double in the bottom of the 11th ended the first half with a 5-4 Father's Day victory over the West Michigan Whitecaps. The win also ensured that Whitecaps lost out on home-field advantage to the South Bend Cubs in the playoffs, denying West Michigan the division title.

2018: The Lugnuts hosted their fourth Midwest League All-Star Game, drawing 9,396. In the pre-game Home Run Derby, Bowling Green Hot Rods catcher Ronaldo Hernandez put on an impressive power display to capture the title. Then the Eastern Division beat the West, 3-2, in ten innings, thanks to a two-out game-winning RBI single from Dayton Dragons first baseman Montrell Marshall, driving in teammate Stuart Fairchild from second base.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Familiar Settings: 13 of the 30 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Full Complement of Starters: The Lugnuts have used 11 starting pitchers this year, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Colin Peluse, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

**Fly Like an Eagle: Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University.

Finally: Pitchers Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**Clubhouse of Higher Learning:** The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. Reid Birlingmair and Charlie Cerny pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons; though William Simoneit played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing Colin Peluse by a year, Peluse hosted Simoneit on his visit and convinced him to attend Wake.







Last Outing: Started June 12 at West Michigan, charged with loss after allowing five runs on seven hits and two walks in 4 2/3 innings, striking out three... Lugnuts lost, 9-0... held the 'Caps scoreless for the first four innings before allowing five hits and five runs in the 5th.

#### 2021 in Lansing: Celebrated his 23rd birthday yesterday!

- Made 2021 debut by piggybacking Jeff Criswell and Shohei Tomioka on the fifth day of the season, Saturday, May 8th vs. Lake County, tossing three scoreless innings in the Lugnuts' 2-0 four-hit shutout victory... worked with catcher William Simoneit, a fellow Demon Deacon, to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base in the 6th inning... opened the ninth with two walks and was taken out in favor of Aiden McIntyre, who sewed up the win with two strikeouts and a comebacker. - Pitched at Dayton, Saturday, May 15th... after Seth Shuman started and fired two perfect innings, twirled five strong innings of relief, allowing two hits and one run, one walk and seven strikeouts... gave up a Brian Rey solo homer while striking out the side in the 6th... departed with a 2-1 lead, but Michael Danielak gave up a two-run homer to Spillane in the 8th, leading to a 3-2 Lugnuts loss... Made first start of the season, May 22nd - heavily anticipated prospect match-up vs. Fort Wayne southpaw Ethan Elliott never materialized, as Lugnuts hammered Elliott for three solo home runs while Peluse gave up 10 hits and eight runs in 3 1/3 innings, en route to 12-7 Lugnuts loss... allowed two hits but stranded the bases loaded in a scoreless 1st inning... gave up three runs on four hits in the 2nd, including a Grant Little two-run double... allowed a Jonny Homza solo home run in the 3rd... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, with new reliever Bryce Nightengale allowing all three inherited runners to score in a six-run TinCaps rally.

- Made his second start of the year and earned the win at home vs. Great Lakes on Saturday, May 29... pitched five innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits and no walks, striking out three... gave up solo home run to Andy Pages in the 1st... exited after allowing first two batters to reach base in the 6th, one of whom scored against reliever Bryce Nightengale... Lugnuts won the game, 7-3, with Jake Suddleson crunching a three-run homer in the 8th for insurance.

- Started June 5 vs. South Bend and overwhelmed the Cubs with 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings, allowing four hits, one walk and one run... struck out the side in the 1st... allowed only run in the 2nd inning on a Bryce Windham RBI single... struck out two more around a Josue Huma double in the 3rd... whiffed two in a perfect 4th... struck out two in a perfect 5th... departed after allowing a two-out single to Nelson Velazquez in the 6th... relievers Bryce Nightengale (2 1/3) and Aiden McIntyre (1 IP) combined for six more strikeouts in a 9-3 Lugnuts win.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 28 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing. His command has always been solid going back to his days at Wake Forest, and it showed up in his debut season in the Class A Short Season New York-Penn League, walking just six batters across 24 innings. Approaching his first full season in the Minors in 2021, Peluse will get a chance to show what he can do with his improved repertoire. His repeatable delivery projects him to stick as a starter."

Draft Day: Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of 10 Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 20th round (Jack Weisenburger), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 36 GS, 10.4 F), 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).

High School: At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team... was also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... in second start, junior year, on the Middletown Cavaliers baseball team, tossed no-hitter with 11 strikeouts at Wilmington Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, and then woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm... the injury led to Tommy John surgery, causing Peluse to miss entire senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.

Hometown: Middletown, Delaware, is in New Castle County, located in the northern part of the state just across from the Maryland border... it hosts the Olde Tyme Peach Festival each August and the Big Ball Marathon every Labor Day (a 24-hour baseballi marathon for charity played with an oversized softball, the "big ball")... St. Andrew's School in Middletown was the site for the filming of Dead Poets Society (1989), starring Robin Williams, with the theater scene in the movie filmed at Middletown's Everett Theatre... there was also an episode of The West Wing filmed at St. Andrew's School... Tampa Bay wide receiver Chris Godwin is from Middletown and attended Middletown H.S.
