## History vs. Peoria

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster includes four MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 27) and southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 30). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and Johnston at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization.

Roster Movement: Yesterday, the Lugnuts transferred infielders Dereck Salom and Jose Escorche and catcher Carlos Amaya to Class-A Stockton, receiving catcher Cole Conn, infielders Luke Mann and Casey Yamauchi, and starting pitcher Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang from the Ports. Conn (1-for-3, sac fly) and Mann (1-for-3, walk) made their Midwest League debuts yesterday, becoming the 940th and 941st all-time Lugnuts.

**Dramtic Open:** The Nuts won the opening game of this series on **Brayan Buelvas'** two-out, two-run triple in the bottom of the ninth, Lansing's third walk-off win of the season.

**Three's a Charm:** The Lugnuts lead the Midwest League in triples (21), five behind the MiLB-leading Albuquerque Isotopes and four in front of the MLB-leading Detroit Tigers.

**Team Effort:** The Nuts also lead the Midwest League with 229 walks drawn and are tied for 1st in the MWL with 255 runs scored, ranking 3rd in hits (397), 2nd in on-base percentage (.354), 3rd in slugging percentage (.390) and 2nd in team OPS (.744).

Individual Efforts: Colton Johnson is tied for 1st in appearances (17) and tied for 3rd in saves (5). Euribiel Angeles is tied for 1st in RBIs. Henry Bolte ranks 1st in the league in runs scored (42), tied for 2nd in total bases (86), 3rd in steals (20), 3rd in extra-base hits (21), tied for 5th in triples (3), tied for 6th in walks (30), 6th in RBIs (32), 9th in OPS (.907) and 10th in OBP (.407). Colby Halter is also tied for 6th in walks (30). Brayan Buelvas is 2nd in extra-base hits (22), tied for 3rd in doubles (12), tied for 2nd in triples (4), tied for 6th in walks (30), 4th in runs (35) and tied for 7th in RBIs (32). Will Simpson is 4th in walks (33) and 5th in OBP (.434).

Teenage starter Maximo Castillo struck out nine in five innings in a no-decision.

**Home Cooking:** Born in Barquisimeto in the state of Lara, where former Lugnut and current Diamondbacks catcher Gabby Moreno was also born... cousin is Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco, in his 15th year in the Major Leagues and a current member of the Cleveland Guardians rotation; Carlos Carrasco led the Majors in victories (18) in 2017 and finished 4th in A.L. Cy Young voting.

Minor League Path: Signed at age 16 by Ruben Barradas in 2018... debuted on June 19, 2019, in the Arizona League... following the canceled season of 2020, split 2021 between the Arizona Complex League and the California League, working out of the Stockton bullpen... repeated in the AzCL and Cal League in 2022... spent all of 2023 pitching for Stockton... tossed six innings for the Ports on four different occasions, finishing the season with six shutout five-hit innings on September 7 at San Jose, with no walks and nine strikeouts... posted 6.57 home ERA in Stockton, 3.12 ERA on the road.
