At the time of his promotion to NH on August 15, Robbins had an 0-2 record and 3.08 on the season across two levels. Had 72 Ks in 52.2 innings. Started the season with Single-A Dunedin, where he had a 1.56 ERA in six outings (one start). Struck out 26 batters in 17.1 innings with the D-Jays. Promoted to High-A Vancouver on June 7. Was primarily a start with the C's (10 outings, 9 starts). Had a 3.82 ERA and 0-2 record with Vancouver, throwing a careerhigh 1 strikeouts vs. Everett on July 31.
