



# SCRANTON/WILKES-BARRE RAILRIDERS GAME NOTES

## Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (71-52) vs. Rochester Red Wings (49-73)

### LRST TIME OUT...

**ROCHESTER, N.Y. (September 29, 2021)** – A four-run first inning led the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders to a 10-6 victory over the Rochester Red Wings on Wednesday night at Frontier Field.

The RailRiders made a statement in the top of the first, sending nine batters to the plate and scoring four runs while chasing Red Wings starter Cade Cavalli after only seven hitters. Consecutive singles by Ryan LaMarre, Greg Allen and Max McDowell plated the runs. Rochester struck back with a run against Matt Krook in the bottom of the first on an RBI single by Jake Noll. Krook (6-5) allowed three runs, all unearned, in 5.0 innings of work, striking out seven and walking two while allowing three hits. The left-hander's ERA dropped to a staff-leading 3.17 (min. 75.0 IP).

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre scored four more to take an 8-1 lead in the top of the third against Mario Sanchez, with a Kyle Holder three-run double sparking the outburst. The Red Wings answered with two in the bottom of the frame thanks to three RailRiders errors. In the bottom of the sixth, the Red Wings plated two more runs against Braden Bristo to cut the deficit to 8-5. Rochester brought the tying run to the plate with two outs in the inning, but Greg Weissert stranded the bases loaded.

Allen blasted a two-run home run off Carson Teel in the top of the seventh to extend the RailRiders lead to 10-5. It was part of a huge night for the outfielder, who finished 2-for-4 with a home run, four RBIs and two runs scored. Rochester stranded the bases loaded in the bottom of the seventh, and in the bottom of the ninth the Red Wings tallied another unearned run against Nick Nelson to narrow the gap to 10-6. However, the rally ended there as Nelson settled down to secure the victory.

### NEWS & NOTES

**RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN:** When **Greg Allen** stole second base in the sixth inning of game one of the doubleheader on September 25 with Syracuse, he recorded the 140th stolen base of the season for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, setting a new franchise record. In only 120 games, the team surpassed the previous record of 139 held by the 2000 SWB Red Barons, who needed 145 games to set the mark. Through 122 games, the RailRiders have stolen 143 bases in 180 attempts in the 2021 season (79.4% success). The pace of thievery has ticked up in September, with SWB currently 36-for-41 in steal attempts in 22 games during the month (1.64 steals/game). **Andrew Velazquez** leads the team with 29 stolen bases in 77 games, and **Socrates Brito** (23) and **Greg Allen** (23) have also recorded 20-or-more steals. With one more steal, Velazquez can become the first SWB player with 30 steals in a season since **Brett Gardner** stole 37 with the 2008 SWB Yankees.

**RECORD BREAKING SEASON:** In the most unusual season in modern minor league baseball history, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders have done their part to re-write the franchise record book, breaking seven team single game or season-long records despite the shortened schedule. Here is a list of the known team records broken:

**STOP HITTING ME!** A prevailing trend around professional baseball has been an uptick in hit batsmen this year, and the RailRiders hitters have not been immune. SWB batters have been plunked 96 times this season, the most of any Triple-A or Double-A team this year. **Greg Allen** leads the team with 18 HBP in 256 PA, while **Rob Brantly** and **Derek Dietrich** are tied for second with 14 each (in 252 and 160 PA, respectively). **Max McDowell** has been plunked 11 times in only 152 PA. An individual RailRiders batter has been hit by a pitch twice in a game six times this season, including Allen twice, a feat which ties a franchise record and had not been accomplished since 2016 (Cesar Puello, 4/27 vs Lehigh Valley).

**OFFENSIVE MARKS:** At the end of the 2021 regular season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders had a combined team on-base percentage of .352, which is the best mark in franchise history. It narrowly beats out the .351 OBP posted by the 2019 RailRiders, despite the team's batting average being 23-points lower in 2021. This is only the fourth time in the 31-year history of the franchise that SWB has posted a team OBP of greater than .345.

**HOMERS THAT HELP:** As part of *The Final Stretch™*, Minor League Baseball has announced that it will be donating \$50 for each home run hit by each club to a charity within that club's local community. The RailRiders are hitting home runs to benefit the Wyoming Valley Challenger Baseball. Through five *Final Stretch™* games, the RailRiders have hit seven home runs for a total donation thus far of \$350. The Triple-A team which hits the most home runs during the final stretch will receive a \$5,000 bonus for their designated organization.

**CLOSE CALLS & BLOWOUTS:** The RailRiders have played an extraordinary number of close games this season, with 58 of SWB's 123 games being decided by one or two runs (47.1%). Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has performed approximately average in these close contests, going 15-16 (.484) in one-run games and 15-12 (.555) in two-run games. However, the RailRiders have also participated in their share of extreme blowout games, decided by eight-or-more runs. In 13 such contests, SWB is 11-2 (.846) on the season, and is part of the reason why the team is +137 in run differential this season, the third-best mark in Triple-A East.

**EYES ON THE FINAL STRETCH™ PRIZE... WHATEVER IT IS:** Unlike all other classifications, Triple-A does not have playoffs this year, with instead every team playing 10 extra games in the *Triple-A Final Stretch*. The *Triple-A Final Stretch* is a 10-game, 2-week "postseason tournament" which has already seen SWB host Syracuse for five games and concludes with the current series at Rochester. The team with the best overall record over the 10-game period will be dubbed the *Final Stretch* Champion and receive a prize that MLB has unbelievably still not announced despite the fact that *Triple-A's Final Stretch* ends on Sunday. Team and individual statistics achieved during the *Triple-A Final Stretch* will be counted toward regular season numbers, making *The Final Stretch* a Schrödinger's Cat paradox where it is both the postseason and the regular season at the same time.

**PROSPECT RANKINGS:** MLB Pipeline -- NYY #2, MLB #66; Baseball America -- NYY #8; Fangraphs -- NYY #4.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Schmidt made his first appearance with the RailRiders since early September and had mixed results. While on one hand he struck out a season-high eight batters and allowed only one earned run, the right-hander also walked three and was chased after 4.2 innings due to his pitch count. Schmidt allowed three unearned runs on a David Thompson home run following an Oswald Peraza error.

**INJURED WING:** Schmidt was initially shut down in February 2021 with a strain in his common extensor tendon in his right elbow. The injury is described as being similar to tennis elbow, but on the anterior (medical jargon for "inside part") of his elbow joint.

**2020 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Saw his first Major League action, going 0-1 with a 7.11 ERA (6.1IP, 5ER) in three games (one start) over two stints with the Yankees (9/4-13, 9/27).
- Was the Yankees' first-round pick (16th overall) in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft...is the first Yankees' firstround pick to make his Major League debut with the club since Aaron Judge on 8/13/16 (2013 draft, 32nd overall) and the first pitcher to do so since Andrew Brackman on 9/22/11 (2007 draft, 30th overall).
- Was signed to a Major League contract and selected to the active roster between games of a doubleheader on 9/4 at Baltimore.
- Made his Major League debut in Game 2 on 9/4 at Baltimore after never having pitched professionally above Double-A in his career...was the seventh Yankee to make his Major League debut in 2020.
- Made his first career start on 9/27 vs. Miami, recording his first career loss after allowing 3ER in 4.0IP (4H, 2BB, 4K, 1HP, 1WP).
- Was part of the Yankees' 40-man postseason player pool, but did not appear on a playoff roster
- Attended spring training as a non-roster invitee for the first time in 2020, posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0IP, 9H, 4R/2ER, 3BB, 8K, 1HR) in four games (one start)...was named the 2020 James P. Dawson Award winner, presented annually to the most outstanding rookie in spring training as voted on by Yankees beat writers...was reassigned to the Alternate Site on 7/21.
- Following the season, was tabbed by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 3 prospect and as having the "Best Curveball" among Yankees farmhands...was also named on the publication's Top 100 Prospects list as the No. 64 prospect in Baseball.

**PERSONAL:**

- Underwent "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow and did not pitch professionally after being drafted in 2017.
- In three seasons at South Carolina (2015-17), produced a 15-9 record and 3.21 ERA (229.2IP, 218H, 102R/82ER, 65BB, 254K, 17HR) in 45 games (36 starts)...as a junior in 2017, went 4-2 and ranked second in the nation with a 1.34 ERA (60.1IP, 41H, 15R/9ER, 18BB, 70K, 3HR) in nine starts, posting a 10.44 K/9 ratio and .194 (41-for-211) opponents' BA.
- Was named to USA Baseball's Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in both 2016 and 2017...was named to the 2017 NCBWA Pre-Season All-America First Team.
- Was Baseball America's No. 31 overall prospect (and No. 17 pitcher) in the 2017 draft...was tabbed by Baseball America as having the Best Control in the SEC.
- His older brother, Clate, pitched in both the Tigers and Reds organizations.
