GAME 3 DOMINATION: The Augusta GreenJackets took down the Columbia Fireflies for a fifth straight time in a 13-2 blowout win. Jordano Perez was a big story early as dealt a quality start for the GreenJackets and the offense spotted him runs early and often as the team broke through for a season-best four home runs.

TORCHING THE FIREFLIES: The home run ball has been a key theme for the Augusta offense versus Columbia as they've now hit 14 homers against the Fireflies in 6 games, representing over half of the 26 big flies Augusta has hit this. Mahki Backstrom with his two home runs joins Cal Conley as the second Augusta hitter to home twice in a game off Columbia.

OWNING THE RIVALS: The GreenJackets collected their fifth straight win versus Columbia on Thursday and have a chance to clinch their second series victory against thier I-20 Rivals with a win on Friday and have out scored them by 28 runs through six games.

EXTRA BASE KINGS: The Augusta bats lead the Carolina League in extra-base hits with 93 (50 2B, 17 3B, 26 HR). As a result, the GreenJackets are 2nd in the Carolina League in both SLG (.396) and OPS (.747).

ROLL OVER: Jordano Perez in his first start at SRP Park educed 11 of his 18 outs on the ground and Landon Leach will look to follow suit as the sinker-baller is averaging a near 3/1 ground/air ball ratio.

CURRENT NOTES: (4/29 vs DEL) Tossed 5.2 innings and came up one out short of back-to-back quality starts but earned his first win by allowing just two runs, leading Augusta to a 6-4 win. (4/24 vs FAY) Tossed the first Quality Start of the Season for Augusta by throwing 6, magnificent innings allowing just one batter over the minimum while striking out a season-best 8 batters. (4/12 @ MB) Made his first start of the season and impressed by pitching five, shutout innings with 7 strikeouts. Released by the Minnesota Twins on February 18, 2022. Agreed to a minor-league contract with the Atlanta Braves on March 16 and will begin season in Augusta.

2021: Began 2021 with the GCL Twins. Made 3 short starts before being promoted to the Fort Meyer Mighty Muscle (Twins Low-A). Made 6 starts for Fort Meyers but ran into problem with his command during the month of July and struggled to go deep into games. Was moved to the bullpen for the final month of the season and had 3 total outings where he allowed 6 earned runs in 8 innings. Leach finished the season with a 6.06 ERA in 12 total appearances between the FCL Twins and Fort Meyers with 33 strikeouts and 26 walks in 35.2 innings.

CAREER: Drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the 2nd round and 37th overall pick in the 2017 MLB Draft. Was assigned to the GCL Twins following his selection and pitched well during his brief season there. Made 5 appearances with 2 starts and finished with a 2-0 record with both of wins coming in relief. Showed his potential in his best outing when he struck out 5 in 3 innings of relief against the Red Sox affiliate on August 11. Pitched for the GCL Twins again in 2018 but missed most of the season due to a significant injury and was also out all of 2019. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19.

HIGH SCHOOL: Played at Pickering High School in Ajax, Ontario. Was regarded as one of the top amateur pitchers in Canada due to a dominate fastball that worked low-mid 90's and topping at 96 while complimenting that with a slider and change up. Had the attention of professional scouts as a high draft pick in 2017. He committed to the University of Texas but ultimately was drafted by the Twins and elected to go to the pros rather than college.



COLLEGE: Began college career at Panola College (TX) where he pitched two seasons, made 11 appearances as a freshman with a 2-0 record and 5.27 ERA, struck out 13 batters in 13.2 innings. As a sophomore, appeared in 15 games with 0-1 record and 5.40 ERA, struck out 27 in 25 innings. Transfered to Tennessee Wesleyan in 2019 and pitched one season, appeared in 7 games with 1-0 record and 6 strikeouts and 15 walks in 6.1 innings

Finished the season strong by not allowing any runs in his final 7 appearances and just once in his final 10.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 20th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Catawba College (NC). Started the 2019 after being drafted with the GCL Braves before being promoted to the Danville Braves (Rookie) for the rest of the season. Had an up-and-down first season in the Braves Organization as he posted a 6.23 ERA in 13 appearances with Danville. His first 4 outings were starts before transitioning to his more natural position as a bullpen arm where he settled in with a 3.55 ERA in 9 appearances and 15.2 innings. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

COLLEGE: Began college career at Pfeiffer University in Misenheimer, North Carolina. Finished his freshman season with a 2.08 ERA in 16 outings all in relief. He collected a team-best 7 saves with a .188 batting average against him. Transferred to Catawba College in Salisbury, North Carolina after one season at Pfeiffer and continued dominated. In his one season at Catawba, made 31 appearances for the Indians as he paced the pitching staff with a 2.43 ERA and 31 appearances that covered 37 innings. Struck out 55 batters with 17 walks while opponents hit just .181 against him. Williams became 28th player drafted in Catawba program history and 2nd player from the school that was drafted by the Braves joining Brian Boltz who was a 2nd round pick in 1989.

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 29th round of the 2019 MLB Draft. Did not pitch at all in 2019 due to injury and was on the 60-day IL all season. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 pandemic.

COLLEGE: Played two seasons at the University of Oregon for coach George Horton... As a sophomore in 2018, he finished with a 2-2 record, 6.65 earned runs average, and 31 strikeouts over 44.2 innings thrown... CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 13th round of the 2019 MLB Draft. Spent the ensuing season split between the GCL Braves and the Rookie affiliate Danville where he finished the season with a combined 0-3 record with a 4.23 ERA in 10 appearances and 9 starts that covered 27.1 innings. Collected 32 strikeouts throughout the course of the year with 12 walks while holding opponents to an impressive .184 batting average against him. Did not pitch in 2020 due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

HIGH SCHOOL: Played high school baseball at Trinity Catholic in Ocala, Florida. Was the No. 90 ranked recruit nationally by Perfect Game and the No. 31 overall right-handed pitcher.
