Today's Game: Nashville and Memphis conclude the six-game series this afternoon at AutoZone Park. The Redbirds clinched at least a series split with an 8-3 win yesterday. Right-hander Chad Patrick makes his second start of the season for Nashville. He'll face right-hander Victor Santos, who took the loss in the series opener on Tuesday night.

Chad Patrick: The 25-year-old makes his second start of the season this afternoon. He tossed three scoreless innings in his Sounds debut on April 7 vs. St. Paul. Patrick pitched for three teams last year, beginning the year with Double-A Amarillo before being traded to the Athletics and joining Double-A Midland and Las Vegas. He was acquired by Oakland from Arizona on July 31, 2023 in an exchange that sent former Sound Jace Peterson and cash to the eventual National League champions. Patrick totaled 26 starts last season, going 4-11 with a 5.59 ERA (124.0 IP/77 ER). He was the first player to be drafted out of Purdue University Northwest, being selected by Arizona in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft.

Victor Santos: The 23-year-old gets his third start with Memphis today. Santos was acquired by St. Louis from Boston along with RHP Nick Robertson in exchange for LF Tyler O'Neill on December 8, 2023. Born in Villa Tapia, Dominican Republic on July 12, 2000, Santos was forced out of the game early on Tuesday night after the Sounds put up eight runs (all earned) on six hits and three walks in 3.2 innings. It was the most runs allowed in a game by Santos since also giving up eight on August 9, 2022 at Scranton/W-B with Worcester. Santos broke into the Triple-A level in 2022 with Worcester in the Red Sox organization, going 3-4 with a 4.95 ERA in nine starts. He missed all of the 2023 season due to injury. Santos was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for May 29-June 4, 2022 with Portland and the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week for June 16-22 with Lakewood. He was originally signed as an international free agent on November 14, 2016 by the Phillies.

It's Miller Time: Owen Miller logged another multi-hit game, his team-leading fifth of the season, after going 3-for-5 in yesterday's loss. He is batting .406 (13-for-32) with a .429 on-base percentage and .898 OPS over the course of his eight-game hitting streak, the longest by a Sounds hitter this season. It's tied for the fourth-longest by any player in the International League in 2024. It's his longest hitting streak since reaching by hit in 13 consecutive games with the Brewers from May 3-21 last season.

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen continued to be the best at the Triple-A level after not allowing an earned run (1 R) yesterday, despite having to work 5.2 innings after Aaron Ashby's seven-out outing. They have yet to allow a run over the last 15.2 innings, dating back to the sixth inning vs. St. Paul last Sunday. Nashville relievers have four wins on the season and boast the best ERA (1.00), WHIP (0.93) and opponent batting average (.141) at the Triple-A level. Kevin Herget (5.1 IP), Enoli Paredes (6.0 IP), Harold Chirino (5.0 IP), Rob Zastryzny (4.2 IP) and Nick Bennett (4.0 IP) have yet to allow an earned run in multiple appearances this season. The next best ERA among Triple-A bullpens is St. Paul at 3.00 (66.0/22 ER) and the next closest opponent batting average is Syracuse and Worcester at .200. On the flip side, Nashville's starters rank 17th in the IL in ERA (6.08) and have allowed the third-most walks (32) among rotations in the league.

Francisco! Francisco Mejia added another RBI in a 1-for-4 with a walk and strikeout in yesterday's loss. Since joining the Sounds on April 5, Mejia is batting .350 (7-for-20) with six RBI, a .458 OBP and .958 OPS. He was signed as a free agent by Milwaukee on April 5 after being released by Tampa Bay on March 27.

Sunday Best: The Sounds are 2-0 with a +19-run differential (20-1) after their first two Sunday games of the season. They throttled Toledo 12-0 on March 31 before the 8-1 win over St. Paul in their last contest. The 20 runs are the most scored on Sunday in the league, while the 0.50 ERA (18.0 IP/1 ER) and .103 opponent batting average (6-for-58) are the best marks on Sunday.

Brewmaster: Brewer Hicklen tallied a hit to finish 1-for-5 on Saturday. He leads the Sounds in runs scored (10), stolen bases (6) and OPS (.954). He has reached base safely in 11 of the 13 games he has played this season and has the second-most multi-hit games on the club (4). Only five players in Triple-A have stolen more bases without being caught than Hicklen (6-for-6). He has nine straight steals without being caught dating back to July 4, 2023.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 689-591 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,281-2,111 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

LAST OUTING: Patrick made his Sounds and International League debut on April 7 vs. St. Paul, getting the start in the series finale. He went 3.0 innings and did not allow a run. Patrick was limited to 35 pitches (23 strikes) with a pair of strikeouts on the afternoon.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's first start against Memphis. He faced the Cardinals' Double-A affiliate, Springfield, three times last season. Patrick went 0-0 with a 6.75 ERA (14.2 IP/11 ER) in three starts against the Cardinals.
