**ABOUT LAST TIME...** The Vancouver Canadians lost to the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) 10-1 Sunday afternoon at Ron Tonkin Field. The loss was their fifth in six games this week and their tenth in their last 12 against the 'Sox.

A seven-run fourth did the Canadians in. Starter Paxton Schultz (L, 3-3) did not allow a hit through the first three and a third before a single off the first base bag started the Frogs offense. The game changed for good in the next at-bat. A fly ball to left-center that should have been caught for the second out instead clanged off the glove of the left fielder after a miscommunication with the centerfielder sent the play awry and allowed the first run of the game to score. From there, the wheels fell off. Everett proceeded to hit for the cycle - in order - as a team: they singled, doubled, tripled and homered over the next four at-bats to lead 5-0 before two more runs scored later in the frame on two walks, a dropped third strike and a rule book double to put them up 7-0.

Vancouver used a lead-off triple from Ryan Gold and an RBI double courtesy of Zac Cook in the bottom of the seventh to spoil the shutout, but that would be all for the offense. The 'Sox got a two-run homer in the eighth and a run on three hits in the ninth to finalize the rout.

Gold led the offense with a pair of extra base hits. On the mound, Willy Gaston was the only one of four pitchers to not allow a run; he worked 2.1 innings, gave up two hits, walked four and K'd one.

**THE TRIBE HAS SPOKANE:** The C's are back at Avista Stadium this week for their second and final trip to Eastern Washington this year. When they were last here in June, Vancouver won four games and outscored the Indians 41-31. These two teams last went head-to-head three weeks ago in Hillsboro, when they split a six-game set and the Canadians scored 28 runs to the Tribe's 23. All told, the C's lead the season series 12 games to six.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's games will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY:** July 27, 2018 - Vancouver scored four in the first to back six shutout innings from Jose Espada en route to a 5-1 win over Eugene at The Nat. A two-run single from Yorman Rodriguez started the scoring before a wild pitch and a Jesus Severino base hit brought in the other two runs in the opening frame. McGregor Contreras hit his seventh home run of the year and Tanner Kirwer had a pair of hits that included a double.

**BATTLE FOR THIRD-PREMACY:** Vancouver and Spokane enter this series tied for third place in the High-A West. It's the first time they've been tied in the standings since Opening Day.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Toronto Blue Jays announced yesterday that right-hander Connor Law has been transferred from Vancouver to Double-A New Hampshire. In a corresponding move, North Vancouver native Will McAffer returns to the C's for his second stint in Advanced-A this year.

**SINKING SHIP:** The Canadians are in the midst of their worst stretch of the season. After going 15-9 in May, they were 11-15 in June before sinking to 7-15 this month. Going back even further, the C's are 12-24 in their last 36 games and, coincidentally, have not won a series since their last visit to Spokane June 8-13 when they took four of six.

**WHAT HATH GOD WROUGHT:** A loss in the series finale against Everett two days ago was just the third time in 12 Sunday games where the C's were on the wrong end of the final score.

**ON THE HILL:** Nick Fraze is back on the bump as he continues to build up from his recent stint on the Injured List. His last turn came on July 21 against Everett, where he went a scheduled two innings and allowed a run on a hit with one walk and two K's. Fraze, 23, returned from over a month out of action on July 15 in Hillsboro, where he went two innings, gave up a hit without allowing a run, walked one and punched out three. Prior to the injury, he was terrific; through five games (three starts) in May, Fraze was 3-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings and limited opposing hitters to a .145 batting average while posting an 8:1 strikeout-to-walk ratio. The Dallas, TX native beat Spokane on May 14 in his only start against the Indians this year. That day, he allowed two runs on four hits, no walks and K'd six.

Right-hander Mitch Kilkeny gets the ball for Spokane. He last worked July 21 at Tri-City, when he earned the win with his second seven-inning outing of the year in which he allowed a single run - a solo homer - and three other hits with no walks and five strikeouts. Coincidentally, the first game of his career in which he went seven innings was against Vancouver on July 9, when he earned the win by scattering six hits while surrendering three runs (two earned) with a walk and two strikeouts. Those two turns, however, were separated by his worst outing of the year; he lasted a single inning on July 15 against Eugene and gave up five runs on three hits with a home run and three walks. Kilkeny, 24, began the year with Low-A Fresno, where he went 3-2 with a 1.45 ERA in six starts. He was the 76<sup>th</sup> overall pick in the 2018 draft out of Texas A&M.
