TONIGHT'S GAME

The Express and Isotopes get set for game four of the series on Friday night at Dell Diamond, with first pitch scheduled for 7:05 p.m. CT. Round Rock RHP Robert Dugger is slated to make the start up against Albuquerque Connor Seabold.

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone or on 91.1 FM from inside Dell Diamond. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties while former University of Texas All-American and retired MLB OF John Langerhans provides color commentary.

FIRST LOSS OF THE SERIES

The Express dropped game three of the series to the Isotopes on Thursday night by a final score of 8-3. Albuquerque plated three in the first on a combination of four singles, one hit-by-pitch and one sacrifice fly. The Express made it a 3-1 game in the second when 1B Blaine Crim scored on a single from 2B Davis Wendzel. 1B Elehuris Montero extended his team's lead to 4-2 on a solo homer. Round Rock scored twice to trim the gap to 4-3 in the fifth and sixth. CF J.P. Martinez scored in the fifth on an Elier Hernandez single before LF Rafael Ortega came home as Wendzel grounded out in the sixth. Montero kept things going for Albuquerque with his second solo dinger of the night in the eighth. The Isotopes extended their lead in the ninth when they loaded the bases. RF Michael Toglia singled to score two before DH C Jonathan Morales grounded out to score one more.

DUGGER'S TURN

Express RHP Robert Dugger gets the baseball for his fourth start of the year on Friday. In his last outing, Dugger turned in 5.0 innings of one-run baseball and allowed only three hits with two walks and six strikeouts. Despite giving up five runs in his first outing, he's allowed only four in his last three.

MORE MARTINEZ

Express CF J.P. Martinez finished 3-for-5 on Thursday with three singles, one run scored and one stolen base. Martinez leads the Express with seven multi-hit games including two games with three hits. He is eighth in the PCL in batting average (.338), fourth in OBP (.472) and first in stolen bases (12). He has been caught stealing only once.

FREE PASSES

The Express drew a total of seven walks yesterday, with a majority of the free bases coming from SS Jonathan Ornelas and LF Rafael Ortega, who each gathered three. 1B Blaine Crim worked one.

ORNELAS ON THE MOVE

Thursday was the third time this year Ornelas has worked three walks in a game. The righty is walking 22.4% of the time which is fourth most among PCL players. He has 19 walks this year. In 94 games while playing for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, Ornelas walked 21 times. His season-high is 45 which came in 123 games last year for Double-A Frisco.

BARNES BRINGING IT

Round Rock RHP Jacob Barnes has not allowed an earned run since his first outing of the season on March 31. The righty lowered his ERA to 0.82 (1 ER/11.0 IP) in seven outings and 11.0 innings. Yesterday, Barnes needed 19 pitches in his 1.0-inning of work with only one walk and one strikeout. He has eight strikeouts with four walks and a 1.36 WHIP.

SERIES WINS

After dropping the first series of the season to the Isotopes, the Express bounced back to win their next three series. Round Rock is two wins away over Albuquerque from making it four consecutive series victories.

WENDZEL AT SECOND

2B Davis Wendzel made his seventh start at second base yesterday and his first since the 2021 season while with the Express.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
