LAST OUTING: Alexander struggled in a 6-3 loss to the Tides last Sunday. He gave up six runs (5 ER) on 10 hits in 4.2 innings. Though he did not give up any free passes, he allowed two homers at Harbor Park.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Alexander has faced Durham twice, once in 2021 with Jacksonville and again last season with Nashville. He gave up three runs (1 ER) in 3.2 innings on May 14, 2021 with six strikeouts at DBAP. Alexander earned the win on April 8, 2022 vs. Durham for the Sounds, tossing 5.0 scoreless innings in the victory. Overall, he is 1-0 with a 1.04 ERA (8.2 IP/1 ER) against the Bulls.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Placed on Milwaukee's 60-day injured list with a strained right rotator cuff on February 18... started rehab assignment at Arizona complex on June 9, making two starts
- On June 30 at Memphis, earned win with 5.1 innings and one run allowed... was first since August 19, 2022 (G1) at Jacksonville
- Took no decision in Nashville's wild 15-14 walk-off win on July 5...was activated and optioned to Nashville on July 8... removed from Milwaukee's 40-man roster and outrighted to Nashville on July 24
- Did not allow a home run through first eight outings of season (33.0 IP total, 25.1 with Nashville), finally surrendering a blast in the third inning of the July 25 contest at Norfolk (solo to Coby Mayo)
